

Domestic & International Market Highlights:

- **India's 5% broken parboiled slipped to \$376-\$382 per tonne from last week's \$379-\$385.** Domestic prices are softening due to the expected rise in production. Exports prices are not falling in the same proportion because of the rising rupee.
- **Thailand's benchmark 5% broken rice prices fell to \$472-\$477 from \$475-\$495 last week,** attributed largely due to the fluctuation in Thai Baht amid muted demand. New supplies are steadily entering the market, and this could gradually lead to a decline in prices over the next few weeks.
- **In Vietnam, rates for 5% broken rice were quoted at \$460-\$480 a tonne range versus \$470-\$475 last week,** as export activity was muted with the absence of buyers from the Philippines. Some exporters are only focusing on fulfilling their contracts signed with Cuba. Water levels in the rice bowl Mekong Delta are low this year and exporters are concerned about possible drought or salination during the upcoming crop season.
- **The central government has started purchasing Kharif crops from farmers at the minimum support price (MSP).** Its marketing season is generally considered to start from October 1, while this time in Punjab - Haryana, procurement started from September 26. Farmers are agitating against agriculture law in a big way in these two states, which contribute the most to rice in the central pool. Farmers fear that the government may stop buying agricultural products at the minimum support price, while the government has flatly denied this. By starting the paddy procurement early on the MSP, the government has also given a message and an indication that it has no intention of ending the MSP. The minimum support price of paddy has been fixed at Rs 1868 per quintal for general category and Rs 1888 per quintal for A grade. As per the available data, a record hardening of 513.50 lakh tonnes of rice was done by the Central Government during the entire marketing season of 2019-20.
- **In India, rates for 5% broken parboiled variety were quoted around \$379-\$385 per tonne,** down from last week's \$387-\$394, due to depreciation in the rupee and weak demand. Demand has been moderating. Buyers are taking a pause after buying aggressively in July and August.
- **Pressure on Paddy prices amid Hopes of Excellent Production in West Bengal: During the current Kharif season West Bengal is expected to have huge production of paddy,** while there is no proper export of rice to Bangladesh, hence there is pressure on prices. In comparison to the procurement target of 52 lakh tonnes in Bengal last year, 49 lakh tonnes of paddy was officially purchased in the season whereas during the current year it is expected to increase to 50-52 lakh tonnes. In Bengal, the price of paddy was Rs. 1615/1620 per quintal in April which jumped to Rs. 1770 per quintal in July-August and has now fallen back to the level of April, which is much lower than the support price declared by the Center of Rs. 1868 per quintal.
- **The government has pegged a record production of food grains at 144.52 million tonnes in the ongoing Kharif season;** the government has estimated the production of rice at 102.36 million tonnes in the current Kharif season, which is also a record.
