

Domestic & International Market Highlights:

- **According to the Ministry of Commerce, non-basmati rice exports grew 112 percent in October. During April-September**, non-Basmati exports more than doubled. Indian non-basmati rice exports during the January-October period in 2020 have exceeded the shipments made in all of the previous year on favourable conditions and production problems in competing nations such as Thailand.
- **FCI and state procurement agencies have bought 26 per cent more paddy so far in this year's kharif** marketing season at 170.53 lakh tonne for Rs 32,196 crore. Paddy procurement for kharif 2020-21 is continuing at a good pace in Punjab, Haryana, Uttar Pradesh, Tamil Nadu, Uttarakhand, Chandigarh, Jammu & Kashmir, Kerala and Gujarat with purchase of over 170.53 lakh tonne of paddy against 134.85 lakh tonne in the same period last year. Out of the total purchase, Punjab alone has contributed 114.97 lakh tonne, which is around 67 per cent of the total procurement
- **As on 29 October, during KMS 2020-21, progressive procurement of Rice was 120.48 lakh MT** compared to 90.12 lakh MT during corresponding period of KMS 2019-20. Total procurement of rice in May-2019-20 has reached 516.49 lakh tonnes which was a record in the last decade.
- **Under the Central Government's Open Market Sale Scheme (OMSS), about 9.53 lakh tonnes of** rice were sold till the previous week during the current financial year. The government has set a target of selling 50 lakh tonnes of rice for the entire financial year under this scheme and has fixed the minimum reserve price (reserve price) of the sale of this rice at Rs 2250 per quintal. Since the market price of rice is running below this, private traders are showing little interest in purchasing government rice. During two initial weekly auctions of October 2020, private traders or bulk consumers did not buy government rice at all and in the third week also only 20 tonnes of rice has been bought. Earlier, private traders had purchased 170 tonnes in September, 160 tonnes in August and just 30 tonnes of government rice in July.
- **The central govt. may extend the time line for free distribution of grains under Pradhan Mantri Garib Kalyan Yojana (PMGKY), till March-2021.** The fresh measures would be a mix of demand stimulus and social safety measures. Under this Yojna Government provides 5 kg rice or wheat per person to 81 crore beneficiaries and 1 kg (chana) to 19.4 households free of cost under the National Food Security Act. It may continue to affect rice and wheat price in domestic market.
- **Madhya Pradesh is expected to start procurement of paddy harvested in the current Kharif season** from Oct 27, nearly a month before schedule. Procurement will happen initially in the northern parts of the state. Procurement drive would be carried out at centers in Gwalior division's Gwalior, Datia, Shivpuri, Guna and Ashoknagar districts and Chambal division's Morena, Bhind and Sheopur districts. Purchase in the other parts of the state would also begin soon. Procurement was rescheduled due to rising arrivals of the crop in the spot markets. If the state does not commence buying, the gathering pace of arrivals may weigh on prices and hurt the growers.
- **During Apr-Sep, the Centre has sold 732,540 tn rice, against 446,540 tn offloaded in the year-**ago period. The food ministry was not in favour of cutting the price as it is anyway selling rice at a much lower level than the carrying cost it incurs. For the current financial year, the carrying cost of rice is around 3,277 rupees per 100 kg.

- **Basmati rice output in the country is expected to rise by 10% on year to nearly 6.3 mln tn** in 2020-21 (Jul-Jun). The expected rise in production is largely due to an increase in acreage in the 2020-21 season. The area under basmati paddy is also estimated to have risen by 5% on year this season. In 2019-20, the area was pegged at 1.9 mln ha.
- **Rice procurement reached 28.10 lakh tonnes in this season of 2020-21, which** is up by 33% from the same period last year. Highest procurement from Punjab is recorded 17.4 lakh tonnes followed by Haryana 10.27 lakh tonnes.
- **Thailand's benchmark 5 percent broken rice prices eased slightly to \$470-\$475 per tonne** from \$472-\$477 last week, with traders expecting the slight dip to fluctuation in the currency exchange amid relatively flat demand. The prices may go lower if the harvest volume bigger than expected, which will be known around the end of the month.
