

Domestic & International Market Highlights:

- Though most of the production of paddy is in the Kharif season and hence 80-85 percent of its government procurement is also done in this season, but the Rabi carpet season is also growing rapidly in the southern states, especially in Telangana and Tamil Nadu. According to the official data, the production of paddy at the national level has increased to 35.25 lakh hectare in the current Rabi season, which is 5.05 lakh hectare more than the area of 30.20 lakh hectare last year, but 6.55 lakh hectare less than the average annual area of 41.80 lakh hectare.
- Thailand is expecting to ship 6 million tonnes of rice in 2021, 5% higher than last year, when it exported its lowest volume of the grain in two decades. About 5.27 million tonnes exported last year means the country has moved to number three in the world for rice exports, overtaken by Vietnam, which shipped 6.2 million tonnes of the grain. The baht will likely continue to appreciate, making Thai rice more expensive than competitors.
- Iraq's state grains buyer has issued an international tender to buy at least 30,000 tonnes of rice. The closing date for the tender is Feb. 3. The Middle Eastern country last year said it planned to buy U.S. rice under an agreement with the United States. But Iraq's purchases from its own rice farmers for the 2020-2021 season have declined.
- Even as the standoff between the farmers and the government continues to rage over the three farm laws, paddy procurement in UP has registered an increase of 14% till date in comparison to last year. Paddy procurement has risen from 56.7 lakh metric tonnes (MT) in 2019-20 to around 64 lakh MT till date.
- Robust demand from across Asia and Africa sent Indian rice export prices to a three-year peak this week, while Vietnamese exporters struggled to ship due to high freight prices fuelled by a container shortage.
- India's 5% broken parboiled variety were quoted at USD 402-USD 408 per tonne, its highest since May 2018. Along with traditional buyers, China and Vietnam are also buying from India. Andhra Pradesh will use a deep-water port to export rice for the first time in decades amid a global grain shortage.
- Neighbouring Bangladesh, which has been grappling with limited supply, also bought more than 110,000 tonnes from India with more on its way.
- On 1 January, FCI had a stock of 530 lakh tonnes of grain, while the buffer norm required 214 lakh tonnes. Stock of 187 lakh tonnes of milled rice available in the central pool on 1 January while buffer norms of 76 lakh tonnes. To reduce the stock, the government approved the purchase of rice for ethanol but distillers retreated due to the current prices. It was believed that about 100 lakh tonnes of rice stock would be reduced from the central pool. The ethanol manufacturers were given a purchase price of Rs 2000 per quintal by the centre. The cost price of rice purchased in 2020-21 has been 2727 rupees, which FCI wanted to sell on 2000. FCI is not willing to sell below 2000 price but this price seems to be high to distiller.

- Millers from Andhra Pradesh and Telangana have started exporting broken rice to China. China has started procuring Indian rice for the first time since December 2020 while it is also buying rice from traditional supply countries like Pakistan, Vietnam and Myanmar. China has selected 24 plants (mills) for importing rice from India including three units from Andhra-Telangana. An exporter from Nizamabad says that China is exporting broken rice at the rate of \$ 350 per tonne. Of the three mills selected, one is located in Telangana and two in Andhra Pradesh (East Godavari district). China has made a plan to ship 1 million tonnes of rice, which includes broken and whole grain rice. Of this, 30 percent of rice shipments are expected from Andhra-Telangana. There, broken rice is used for making noodles and floor.
