

### Domestic & International Market Highlights:

- According to the latest Paddy Kharif sowing data, sowing in India reached 24,566 hectares on June 28, 2021, up 2.95 percent from 18,401 hectares the previous year at the same time. As of June 30, 2021, Telangana has a total area of 95,999 hectares, lower from 125,502 hectares the previous year at the same time. It is 16,090 hectares in Rajasthan as of 2-07-2021, lower from 51,500 hectares the previous year, and 24,566 hectares in Gujarat as of 28-06-2021, up from 18,401 hectares the year before. Paddy sowing in Odisha has reduced by 30 thousand hectares from the previous year, reaching 1.42 hectare as of 19-06-2021, down from 1.75 hectare the previous year.
- Procurement of Rice in ongoing RMS 2021-22 is continuing smoothly in the procuring States of India at MSP, as was done in previous seasons, and till now (up-to 4.07.2021) a quantity of over 862.01 LMT of rice. About 127.15 lakh farmers have already been benefitted with MSP value of Rs.1, 62,747.75 crore.
- In the face of rising rice prices in the country, the Sri Lankan government has reversed its decision to import 100,000 MT of rice, citing currency constraints, and instead stated that the price would be set locally.
- From June 1 to June 30, Telangana received 51 percent more rainfall at 194.5 mm against the average the normal 171.6 mm in last year in same period of time.
- PMGKAY-4 has been approved by the Center. From July to November, this scheme will be in effect. This program will provide 5 kg of food grains (wheat/rice) per person per month. In PMGKAY-3, 79 lakh tonnes of food grains were allocated for May and June, with 76 lakh tonnes procured in various states so far. In May, 35 lakh tonnes of food grains were distributed, followed by 23 lakh tonnes in June. The Center allocated 204 lakh tonnes of food grains for the fourth scheme from July to November.
- The monsoon may weaken by the first week of July, according to the Meteorological Department. The speed of the monsoon was good in the beginning, but it has now slowed.
- Sri Lanka has decided to purchase 100,000 metric tons of foreign rice in order to lower soaring domestic prices, as trade restrictions have strengthened a domestic oligopoly involved in rice collection and milling. The government intends to import 100,000 MT of Samba rice as a tool or method to relieve people's stress.
- The Centre has allocated approximately 78,000 tonnes of rice from FCI stocks to distilleries for ethanol production during the ethanol supply year (ESY) 2020-21 at a subsidised rate of Rs 20 per kg. By 2025, total ethanol production will be 740 million liters from grain and 760 million liters from sugar.
- This year, the Telangana government procured 30 million tonnes of paddy, which was more than what Punjab procured (20.2 million tonnes).
- The global rice production is estimated to be 514.5 million tonnes, with a final balance stock of 164.4 million tonnes. It is well known that India is the world's largest rice exporter and the world's second largest producer after China.
- Thailand facing trouble in its rice exports due to decreased production because of droughts, exports at 23-year lows due to the high baht, and higher shipping costs.
- With expectations that Thailand's rice exports will fall further this year, the government is stepping up efforts to reclaim that position by lowering export surcharges and improving rice breeds.
- The average unit export offer price of Indian non-basmati rice in June 2021 was \$391.73 per tonne, lower than Thailand \$ 436.63 per tonne, and Vietnam \$469.89 per tonne.
