

Domestic & International Market Highlights:

- According to the latest Rice Kharif sowing data, sowing in India reached 374.03 lakh hectares on August 19th 2021, lower 4.04 percent from 378.07 lakh hectares the previous year at the same time. As of Aug 19, 2021, Telangana has a total area of 15.95 lakh hectares, lower from 18.06 lakh hectares the previous year at the same time. It is 1.94 lakh hectares in Rajasthan lower from 2.14 lakh hectares the previous year, and 7.90 lakh hectares in Gujarat up from 6.98 hectares the year before. Paddy sowing in Odisha has reduced by 14.23% from the previous year, reaching 28.50 lakh hectares down from 33.23 lakh hectare the previous year.
- As per Farmers, approx. 16000 hectares of land sown with high quality variety of basmati in Kasganj district of Uttar Pradesh has been adversely affected by the seed borne fungal disease, Bakanae, on account of continuous rainfall and poor sunshine over past few weeks. It is expected that 25 percent of the crop is infected by the disease.
- Rice output is expected to reach a new high of 122.27 million tonnes in 2020-21, according to the agriculture ministry's fourth advance estimate. It is 9.83 million tonnes higher than the average production estimates of 112.44 million tonnes over the previous five years. Due to higher output of rice, wheat, and pulses, India's foodgrain production is expected to rise by 3.74 percent to a new record of 308.65 million tonnes in the crop year 2020-21 compared to 297.5 million tonnes in 2019-20 due to good monsoon rains last year. From its third estimate of 305.43 million tonnes for the same year, the estimate has been revised higher by 3.22 million tonnes.
- Procurement of paddy in ongoing KMS 2020-21 is continuing smoothly in the procuring States of India at MSP, as was done in previous seasons, and till now (up-to 22.08.2021) a quantity of over 873.58 LMT of rice higher by 13.31% against last year. About 129.03 lakh farmers have already been benefitted with MSP value of Rs.1,62,348.83crore.
- Due to sluggish demand, Vietnam's 5% broken rice prices are hovering at \$ 390 per tonne. After India and Thailand, Vietnam is the world's third-largest exporter of the item. Vietnam lowered its rice-growing area by 5.4 percent this year, to 3.5 million hectares (8.6 million acres), with the goal of reducing it to 3.5 million hectares (8.6 million acres) by 2030. Farmers are having difficulty selling their newly harvested crop due to a lack of dealers. As Vietnam suffers its largest epidemic to date, farmers are finding it difficult to sell their newly harvested grain since traders are unable to make deals owing to COVID-19 mobility restrictions. Export activity was poor, due to weak demand and tough competition from Thailand and India. Rice exports from Vietnam plummeted 12.7 percent in the first seven months of this year.
- The Telangana government has started efforts to convince FCI to lift the rice grown this season in order to extent the ongoing cultivation of paddy so as to increase the area of cultivation from planned area of 42 lakh acres to 55 lakh acres. The production is expected to be about 1.48 crore tons at the rate of 27 quintal per acre.
- As per DGCIS report, Basmati rice exports were 7.29 lakh tonnes in the current fiscal year Apr to May 2021. In the fiscal year 2020-21, Basmati rice was exported total 46.30 lakh tonnes.
- In Pakistan, rice prices fell sharply by 8%, approaching Indian prices. Supply outlook are good in 2021 with production expected to be 1.5% higher than the record level of 2020. However,

Pakistani exports still lag 12% behind 2020 at the same time. In July, Pak 25% was quoted at \$ 339 compared to \$ 369 in June. Pakistan's rice export to China is expected to cross one million in the coming year. When compared to the previous year's Pakistan will see exponential growth in the export due to increased demand from Chinese market. Last year Vietnam, Thailand and Pakistan dominated Chinese markets with an export of 911,231 tons, 787,538 tons and 324,642 tons respectively.

- On 1 August, FCI had a stock of 29.10 million tonnes of rice in central pool while buffer norms of 7.6 million tonnes. To reduce the stock, the government approved the purchase of rice for ethanol but distillers retreated due to the current prices. It was believed that about 100 lakh tonnes of rice stock would be reduced from the central pool. The ethanol manufacturers were given a purchase price of Rs 2000 per quintal by the centre. The cost price of rice purchased in 2020-21 has been 2727 rupees, which FCI wanted to sell on Rs. 2000. FCI is not willing to sell below 2000 price but this price seems to be high to distiller.
