

### Domestic & International Market Highlights:

- The latest Rice Kharif sowing data suggests 401.15 lakh hectares of sowing of rice on September 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2021, higher 0.15% from 400.54 lakh hectares the previous year at the same time. As of September 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2021, Telangana has a total area of 18.87 lakh hectares, lower from 19.49 lakh hectares the previous year at the same time. It is 1.94 lakh hectares in Rajasthan lower from 2.18 lakh hectares the previous year, and 8.09 lakh hectares in Gujarat lower from 8.16 hectares the year before. Paddy sowing in Odisha has reduced by 8.07% from the previous year, reaching 33.13 lakh hectares down from 36.04 lakh hectare the previous year.
- The agriculture ministry's fourth advance estimate suggests rice output to reach a new high of 122.27 million tonnes in 2020-21, 9.83 million tonnes higher than the average production estimates of 112.44 million tonnes over the previous five years. India's food grain production is expected to rise by 3.74 percent to a new record of 308.65 million tonnes in the crop year 2020-21 compared to 297.5 million tonnes in 2019-20 due to good monsoon rains last year.
- Procurement of paddy in ongoing KMS 2020-21 is continuing smoothly in the procuring States of India at MSP, as was done in previous seasons and till now (up-to 05.09.2021) a quantity of over 889.62 LMT of rice higher by 15.39% against last year. About 130.47 lakh farmers have already been benefitted with MSP value of Rs. 1,67,960.77 crore.
- Due to high demand of long grained rice in international market the traders are showing immense interest in buying early sown basmati varieties like Pusa basmati 1509 at the rate of Rs 2500 to Rs 2600 per quintal. For the farmers, the prices have improved compared to last year but still lower than Rs 3000 per quintal in 2019.
- Punjab government has asked RBI and other consortium of banks to provide cash credit limit (CCL) of Rs.42000 crore for the upcoming paddy procurement which is expected to start from 1<sup>st</sup> October. This time a total of 191 lakh tonnes is expected to arrive down from 203 lakh tonnes last year with an expenditure of Rs.46000 crores.
- Acute scarcity of Diammonium phosphate (DAP) fertilizers is likely to have an impact on paddy production in Andhra Pradesh. According to report, few days ago , DAP was offered for Rs. 50 to Rs. 70 more than MRP of Rs. 1200 due to demand supply disruption. The scarcity of DAP is anticipated to impair paddy cultivation, causing issues for farmers.
- Punjab has set to bring the acreage of rice below 2 million marks which includes both basmati and non basmati rice. The decision came up after water table that in 85 % of agricultural block has come up to dark zone. The area has been diverted to cotton and maize in order to stop overexploitation of ground water.
- The centre has mandated Punjab and other paddy growing states to link procurement to farmer's land and to the yield to check bogus billing and malpractice of adding previous season's procurement with current year's procurement. According to the officials, the paddy yield varies between 27 quintals per acre to 35 quintals per acre in Punjab. The season to season variation is

around 2-3%. According to state remote sensing centre, the paddy is sown over 72.5 lakh acre of which 12.5 acre is contributed by basmati rice..

- Cambodia earned \$685 million from rice export to international market in first eight months of the year as the volume of rice sold abroad doubled year to year. According to agriculture ministry 2.7 million tonnes of rice are shipped to international market. The rough grain made up of 57.39 % and 87.40 % of all rice exports in terms of value and volume.
- The export price of rice in Vietnam has rose this week from their lowest level after government topped up its reserves and buyers held off on importing rice from India in the hope that surging freight cost would ease. Vietnam's 5% broken rice rose to \$400 per tonne from \$385 two weeks earlier. India's 5% broken rice remain unchanged this week at \$385 to \$363 per tonne.
