

**Domestic & International Market Highlights:**

- The latest Rice Kharif sowing data suggests 414.18 lakh hectares of sowing of rice as on September 17th, 2021, higher 0.20% from 413.34 lakh hectares the previous year at the same time. Telangana has sown 21.28 lakh hectares of rice up by 3.30% from 20.60 lakh hectares the previous year. While Odisha has sown 35.13 lakh hectare of rice down by 5.18% from 37.05 lakh hectares last year.
- Procurement of paddy in ongoing KMS 2020-21 is continuing smoothly in the procuring States of India at MSP, as was done in previous seasons and till now (up-to 20.09.2021) a quantity of over 890.41 LMT of rice higher by 15.50% against last year. About 130.47 lakh farmers have already been benefitted with MSP value of Rs. 1,67,960.77 crore.
- As on 15<sup>th</sup> September 2021, 56.53% of food grains have been lifted in the country under PMGKAY phase IV. A total 112.39 LMT of food grains is lifted against 198.78 LMT allocated, as per Ministry of consumer affairs, food & public distribution. In rice, 62.86 LMT is lifted against allocated 101.69 LMT making lifting percentage as 61.81%. Andaman & Nicobar tops the country for lifting highest percentage of food grains with 93%. The PMGKAY is extended till November 2021.
- In Japan's compound feed mix, the demand for rice increases as the price of corn and sorghum surge according to USDA. The project Japan's consumption in 2021-22 to increase slightly to 8.3 million tonnes as feed consumption is expected to be more than the decline in the table rice consumption.
- For the first time, Department of Food and Public Distribution (DFPD) has issued uniform specification for fortified rice kernel (FRK) for grade A and common rice in case of procurement, of which 1% of FRK (w/w) should be blended with normal rice stock. The department has issued the uniform specification of food grains for Central pool procurement with regard to Kharif marketing season 2020-21.
- Prices of both rice and paddy declined by Tk 3-4 per kg in last three days in the milling hubs of Bangladesh which traders attributed to notable rise in supply of imported grain. Release of large chunks of coarse hybrid paddy and rice by big millers, traders and rich farmers also helped cut rice prices.
- According to APEDA, the non-basmati rice export for April-July were up at 5.27 million tonnes, valued at Rs. 14,091 crores, against 3.03 million tonnes worth Rs. 8,982 crores a year ago. As per ACEA, the exports during August-September have slowed down due to increased price of 100 % broken rice. Currently it is delivered in Chennai for Rs 20,000 – 21,000 per tonne compared to Rs 17,000 per tonne last month.
- New arrivals in South East Asia, Vietnam's payment issues and surging freight rates has impacted rice shipments from India. Malaysia has started buying Thai rice where the arrivals has started.

The heavy discount bargaining has made exporters to not take consignments from Vietnam. As per TREA, the container charges make up to 10-15 % of the total cost of rice export which became 30-35 % currently making a surge in freight rates.

- Thailand is forecasted to export 13% less rice in the 2021-22 marketing year, as per USDA. The year-on-year decline to 5.8 million tonnes from 6.2 million tonnes is due to shipment container shortage and higher transportation costs. The freight cost to USA is five times higher than the pre covid times. The export of Thai rice to Singapore declined by 52% compared to previous years.
