

## **Domestic & International Market Highlights:**

- Procurement of paddy in ongoing KMS 2020-21 is continuing smoothly in the procuring States of India at MSP, as was done in previous seasons and till now (up-to 27.09.2021) a quantity of over 891.01 LMT of rice higher by 15.58% against last year. About 130.54 lakh farmers have already been benefitted with MSP value of Rs. 1,67,960.77 crore.
- As per Ministry of Consumer affairs, Food and Public Distribution, the procurement of paddy during KMS 2021-22 has been postponed to October 11<sup>th</sup> for the state of Punjab and Haryana. Due to recent heavy rainfall in the states of Punjab & Haryana, the maturity of paddy has been delayed and the moisture content in fresh arrival is beyond the permissible limit. The state government is requested to advise their agencies to dry the paddy already arrived.
- As per sources, 32,000 MT of Rice Vessel ALMERAY is loading at Kakinada port since 20<sup>th</sup> August 2021. And 47,500 MT of Rice Vessel ASIAN PEARL is waiting for arrival for arrival at Kakinada port since 24<sup>th</sup> September 2021. Also 50,000 MT of Rice Vessel HOPE 1 is expected to arrive at Kakinada Port on 30<sup>th</sup> September 2021. And 10,750 MT of rice vessel JUPITER is loading at Kandla Port since 18<sup>th</sup> September 2021. Also 5,500 MT of Rice Vessel GIBE is waiting for arrival at Kandla Port since 23<sup>rd</sup> September 2021. And 10,500 MT of Rice vessel SAROS B is loading at Krishnapatnam Port since 27<sup>th</sup> September 2021. And 30,000 MT of Rice vessel DESPINA K is expected to arrive at Krishnapatnam port on 01<sup>st</sup> October 2021. Also 52,590 MT of rice vessel STELIOS B is waiting for arrival at Vizag Port since 15<sup>th</sup> September 2021.
- FCI to start age test on grain to check mixing of old rice with new stock in Punjab. The system is
  expected to be operational in December when Punjab's procurement agencies will start handing
  over rice to the FCI. This system is introduced due to the fact that in last 4-5 years rice purchased
  from outside states at cheaper prices are mixed with newly shelled grains in Punjab and was sold
  to central procurement agencies to earn high profits.
- Ludhiana administration gearing up for the paddy procurement which was postponed to
  October 11. As per the officials, the paddy has been cultivated on around 2.57 lakh hectares in
  Ludhiana and around 17.53 lakh MT paddy is expected to reach the grain market this year. The
  previous season 17.28 lakh MT of paddy was procured. Apart from 108 regular grain markets, 94
  temporary yards and 203 mandi yards are marked to decongest the market in the district.
- In srikakulam district of Andhra Pradesh, paddy crop in several mandals is damaged due to effect
  of cyclone gulab. The water level in Thottapali barrage has reached at 103.80 metres which is
  allowed level while in Gotta barrage the water level reached at 34.36 metres which is permitted
  level. Paddy crops were damaged in several villages in Vangara, Jalumuru and other mandals
  due to inundation of paddy under floodwater.



- A record 78,000 MT of paddy was procured in Trichy during KMS 2020-21 which surpassed the previous year's target of 45,000 MT. This year the government has increased the price of both varieties of paddy from Rs. 1865 per quintal to Rs. 1918 in case of bold variety while in case of fine variety the price increased from Rs. 1905 per quintal to Rs. 1958 per quintal.
- In Telangana, the government is planned to cut down the paddy farming in the state by 10 lakh acres in the coming season. The government is focusing on five alternative crops of green gram, groundnut, sunflower, sesame and Bengal gram. The plan is to reduce the paddy cultivation by 20% and three zones are identified to press with alternative crops.
- The Jharkhand State cabinet has selected East Singhbhum (Jamshedpur) for project monitoring unit (PMU) to distribute and implement the central government fortified rice scheme on pilot basis. The distribution will take place through public distribution shops.
- As on 30<sup>th</sup> September, Export price of rice in Vietnam rose to a two and half month high due to rising domestic demand which drives procurement cost. Vietnam's 5% broken rice rose to range of \$425-\$430 per tonne, highest since mid-July from \$415-\$420 per tonne a week ago. Rice exports in September is expected to be at 530,000 tonnes. While in Thailand, 5% broken rice was quoted at \$385-\$386 per tonne compared to \$380-\$386 last week. High shipping cost is hampering exports of rice in Thailand.
