

**Domestic & International Market Highlights:**

- In Patiala district, the district administration has prohibited use of combine harvester after 7PM and before 10AM in order to maintain the moisture content within the limits. So far, 3.06 lakh MT of paddy has been procured while 93 percent of the purchased rice has been lifted.
- Farmers were protesting against Haryana government's decision not to let paddy from UP into Karnal grain market. The state has banned the arrival of PR paddy from UP in Haryana's grain market, causing dozens of tractors and trucks loaded with paddy to be halted at the border.
- Around 440 paddy procurement center is expected to set up in Khammam for KMS 2021-22. As per reports, about 6.50 lakh tonnes of paddy is expected to be procured in Khammam and kothagudem districts of Telangana. In Khammam district, paddy was cultivated in about 2.64 lakh acres in 21 mandals and 5.48 lakh metric tonnes yield was expected.
- The huge quantity of PR variety of rice from two godowns of the Karnal district has put the authority on high alert. The district administration suspects that rice meant for public distribution system from UP, Bihar and other neighboring states could be delivered as the custom milled rice (CMR).
- As per USDA's GAIN report on China's rice prices said Indian rice made up to 23 percent of total imports by Beijing during January-August this year. The reason for such huge increase in imports is due to competitive price of Indian rice which averaged at \$345 per tonne while the world average stood at \$454 per tonne. As per sources, during January – August China imported 7.3 lakh tonnes from India, 7.1 lakh tonnes from Vietnam and 6.4 lakh tonnes from Pakistan.
- In three months rice export price in India rose to their highest level this week as the rupee appreciated amid a shortfall in supply, while higher shipping costs and a weaker baht dragged Thai rates lower. India's 5% broken parboiled variety was quoted at \$362 to \$365 per tonne up from last week's \$360 to \$363 per tonne.
- As per sources, 33,000 MT of Rice Vessel DALARNIA is loading at Kakinada port since 20<sup>th</sup> October 2021. Also 25,000 MT of Rice Vessel OSPREY BULKER is loading at Kakinada port since 19<sup>th</sup> October 2021. Also 39,900 MT of Rice Vessel ANNI SELMER is loading at Kakinada Port since 15<sup>th</sup> October 2021. Also 22,000 MT of rice vessel ISLANDER is loading at Kakinada Port since 12<sup>th</sup> October 2021. And 49,000 MT of rice vessel ILIA loading at Kakinada Port since 18<sup>th</sup> October 2021. And 45,000 MT of rice vessel FROSSO K is loading at Kandla Port since 16<sup>th</sup> October 2021. And 34,000 MT of Rice Vessel KONSTANTINOS is waiting for loading at Kandla Port since 07<sup>th</sup> October 2021. Also, 5,000 MT OF Rice Vessel CAPT KHALDOUN is loading at Kandla Port since 19<sup>th</sup> October 2021. And 27,000 MT of Rice vessel LADY MARGARET is expected to arrive at Kandla Port on 20<sup>th</sup> October 2021. And 35,000 MT of Rice Vessel CEYLON BREEZE is expected to arrive at Kandla Port on 22<sup>nd</sup> October 2021. And 31,000 MT of Rice Vessel LIBERTY C is waiting

for loading at Krishnapatnam Port since 19<sup>th</sup> October 2021. Also 52,000 MT of rice vessel ESHIPS PROGRESS is waiting for loading at Vizag Port on 08<sup>th</sup> October 2021.

- The Government of India has stated that there is no possibility of genetically modified (GM) substances mixing with the rice exported because their production is prohibited. As France and other European countries have detected the content of genetically modified rice in the 500 MT of broken rice imported from India.
- The water level of some of the major rivers like Kosi have risen in Bihar. This forced authorities to release 2.69 lakh cusec of water from kosi barrage. This year till second week of October, Bihar has received only 3% surplus rainfall after the monsoon season. This is less than the last year when the state has received 25% surplus rainfall from June to September.
- Around 5.95 lakh tonnes of paddy were procured in Punjab on 21<sup>st</sup> October 2021 in KMS 2021-22. Government procurement agencies procured 5.19 lakh tonnes of paddy while 0.36 lakh tonnes were procured by private millers.
