

## **Domestic & International Market Highlights:**

- After a halt in paddy procurement due to heavy rainfall, it is back on track in Punjab. All
  necessary arrangements have been made in all the mandis and paddy stocks are covered with
  tarpaulins. Waterlogging were reported in a few low lying mandis in Sangrur and Patiala where
  motors were used to drain out the water.
- Due to the current rains, the farmers have demanded government to allow procurement of paddy with 24 percent moisture and also demanded Rs 40,000 per acre compensation to farmers whose paddy were completely damaged in the rains.
- Himachal government has urged center to extend the purchase process of paddy by a month till December 30 as the procurement is moving in slow pace. As per reports, target of 19,000 MT in Sirmaur, 15,000 MT in Kangra, 10,000 MT in Solan and 10,000 in Una districts is expected during KMS 2021-22.
- After a delay of over 10-12 days caused by unseasonal rains this month, the harvest of non basmati rice crop has finally started gaining momentum in Southern Punjab.
- Paddy harvesting in Malwa, Majha and Doaba regions of Punjab is expected to be delayed due
  to heavy rainfall coupled with high velocities of wind and flattened the crop thus reducing the
  harvest. As pr government figures, around 70 lakh tonnes of paddy has reached grain market
  which is roughly one third of total yield expected this season.
- As per USDA's GAIN report on China's rice prices said Indian rice made up to 23 percent of total imports by Beijing during January-August this year. The reason for such huge increase in imports is due to competitive price of Indian rice which averaged at \$345 per tonne while the world average stood at \$454 per tonne. As per sources, during January August China imported 7.3 lakh tonnes from India, 7.1 lakh tonnes from Vietnam and 6.4 lakh tonnes from Pakistan.
- In Amritsar, agriculture officials has reported 30% loss to the standing crop. In Rupnagar, 10% of the standing crop has been flattened. The rains has expected to delay the pace of the current harvesting season. The harvesting is expected to resume in most parts of Bathinda and Mansa districts from next week.
- As per sources, 47,690 MT of Rice Vessel THEOTOKOS is waiting for loading at Kakinada port since 23<sup>rd</sup> October 2021. And 40,000 MT of rice vessel UNIVERSE 1 is waiting for loading at Kakinada Port since 24<sup>th</sup> October 2021. And 32,000 MT of rice vessel VIGOROUS is waiting for loading at Kakinada Port since 24<sup>th</sup> October 2021. Also 25,000 MT of Rice Vessel OSPREY BULKER is loading at Kakinada port since 19<sup>th</sup> October 2021. Also 39,900 MT of Rice Vessel ANNI SELMER is loading at Kakinada Port since 15<sup>th</sup> October 2021. Also 22,000 MT of rice vessel ISLANDER is loading at Kakinada Port since 12<sup>th</sup> October 2021. And 49,000 MT of rice vessel ILIA loading at



Kakinada Port since 22<sup>nd</sup> October 2021. And 45,000 MT of rice vessel FROSSO K is loading at Kandla Port since 16<sup>th</sup> October 2021. And 34,000 MT of Rice Vessel KONSTANTINOS is waiting for loading at Kandla Port since 07<sup>th</sup> October 2021. Also, 5,000 MT OF Rice Vessel CAPT KHALDOUN is loading at Kandla Port since 19<sup>th</sup> October 2021. And 27,000 MT of Rice vessel LADY MARGARET is waiting for loading at Kandla Port since 20<sup>th</sup> October 2021. And 35,000 MT of Rice Vessel CEYLON BREEZE is expected to arrive at Kandla Port on 22<sup>nd</sup> October 2021. Also 23,000 MT of Rice Vessel KEN MOONYS is expected arrive at Kandla Port on 23<sup>rd</sup> October 2021. And 31,000 MT of Rice Vessel LIBERTY C is waiting for loading at Krishnapatnam Port since 19<sup>th</sup> October 2021. Also 52,000 MT of rice vessel ESHIPS PROGRESS is waiting for loading at Vizag Port on 08<sup>th</sup> October 2021.

- In Uttarakhand, A crop loss worth Rs. 100 crore is expected in Udham sigh nagar district. The paddy in 45,000 hectares were in water logging condition. This year the harvesting was delayed from mid-October due to high moisture content which turns out to be costly for paddy growers.
- The live storage in 130 reservoirs monitored by central water commission stood at 141.9 BCM, accounting for 83 percent of total live storage capacity in these reservoirs. The current live storage is higher than 10 year average but lower than last year's levels.
