

Domestic & International Market Highlights:

- In KMS 2021-22, a quantity of 290.98 lakh metric tonne of paddy has been procured upto 30th November 2021 which is down by 67.46 percent against 894.19 lakh metric tonnes procured in KMS 2020-21 during the corresponding period. Till now about 18.17 lakh farmers have been benefitted with MSP value of Rs. 57,032.03 crores. Maximum procurement has been done in Punjab 186.86 lakh tonnes followed by Haryana with 55.31 lakh tonnes.
- With deteriorating air quality in Delhi and nearby NCR region, the officials have suspended all the industrial operations and processes in NCR not running on PNG or cleaner fuels beyond 8 hours a day from Monday to Friday. Also not allowed to operate anytime during Sunday and Saturday. The rice mills with parboiling activity is going to impacted by the decision as the rice parboiling is a continuous procedure which takes at least 20 hours for one batch of rice. This will affect the export commitments made by rice traders. As a result paddy prices can go down due to lower demand by the millers.
- Indian rice exports could reach 20 million tonnes the current season as India is expected to
 produce more than 100 million tonne during kharif 2021-22. Till October around 9 million
 tonnes of rice has been exported though the basmati rice exports remain low due to high prices.
- As of 03rd December, rabi paddy sowing was done in 9.74 lakh hectares up by 0.36 lakh hectares from 9.37 lakh hectares the previous year during corresponding period. In Tamil Nadu, around 8.74 lakh hectares up by 0.85 lakh hectares from 7.88 lakh hectares the previous year.
- In Telangana, banks are hesitant to grant agricultural loans for paddy in the upcoming season as
 the uncertainty over paddy procurement persists and possible shift to alternate crops is
 possible.
- The government has increased rice procurement to the extent of half of the production during 2020-21 season, as against 30 per cent in 2013-14 amid farmer's protest. This year, the procurement has also been progressing well with as much as 18.6 million tonnes being bought until November 25, even as the target is for 50 mt by March 31 as purchases will be completed by then in most States.
- The average mandi prices of paddy in Uttar Pradesh, stood four per cent below the MSP of ₹1,940 per quintal during October-November. It is mainly due to continuation of free ration under PMGKAY for next four months along with higher arrivals of paddy in the market.
- As per sources, 11,000 MT rice vessel SUPRA ONIKI is expected to arrive at Haldia Port on 04th December 2021. Also, 7,600 MT of Rice Vessel BMC ALPHA is loading at Kakinada Port on 25th November 2021. Also, 54,450 MT of Rice vessel ELINA B is loading at Kakinada Port since 20th November 2021. And 31,500 MT of Rice vessel MARYAM D is loading at Kakinada Port since 20th



November. And 38,000 MT of Rice Vessel COLUMBIA is loading at Kakinada Port since 20th November 2021. And 5,500 MT of Rice Vessel ABDULLATIF is waiting for loading at Kandla Port since 20th November 2021. Also 11,000 MT of Rice vessel GIBE is waiting for loading at Kandla Port since 18th November 2021. And 21,000 MT of Rice vessel OCEAN CROSS is waiting for loading at Kandla Port since 22nd November 2021. And 6,000 MT of rice vessel SEAWAY K is waiting for loading at Kandla Port since 26th November 2021. And 50,300 MT of Rice vessel VOKARIA is waiting for loading at Kandla Port on 22nd November 2021. And 5,500 MT of Rice vessel TUHINA is loading at Kolkata Port since 25th November 2021. And 5,000 MT of Rice Vessel TIVSHA is expected to arrive at Kolkata Port on 1st December. And 31,000 MT of Rice Vessel LIBERTY C is loading at Krishnapatnam Port since 21st October 2021. And 32,000 MT of rice vessel ALTUS is loading at Krishnapatnam Port since 24th November 2021. Also 24,000 MT of rice vessel GOLDEN LOTUS is waiting for loading since 24th November 2021. Also 52,000 MT of rice vessel ESHIPS PROGRESS is loading at Vizag Port since 28th October 2021.
