

Domestic & International Market Highlights:

- In KMS 2021-22, a quantity of 290.98 lakh metric tonne of paddy has been procured upto 30th November 2021 which is down by 67.46 percent against 894.19 lakh metric tonnes procured in KMS 2020-21 during the corresponding period. Till now about 18.17 lakh farmers have been benefitted with MSP value of Rs. 57,032.03 crores. Maximum procurement has been done in Punjab 186.86 lakh tonnes followed by Haryana with 55.31 lakh tonnes.
- Centre is planning to supply fortified rice through fair price shops in future, the union minister has suggested Maharashtra government to set up fortified rice manufacturing plants and rice bran oil processing unit around the paddy belt of Bhandara, Gondia and Chandrapur in Vidarbha.
- Telangana government has decided to withdraw additional 5 kg of rice they were providing as free ration along with centre's free ration since July 2020.
- Rice exporters association of Pakistan (REAP) is urging government to take immediate action to ensure timely availability of containers for the exports of rice. Also shipping companies are charging too high compared to the prevailing rates.
- As of 03rd December, rabi paddy sowing was done in 9.74 lakh hectares up by 0.36 lakh hectares from 9.37 lakh hectares the previous year during corresponding period. In Tamil Nadu, around 8.74 lakh hectares up by 0.85 lakh hectares from 7.88 lakh hectares the previous year.
- Chhattisgarh has started depositing custom milled rice to the central pool to FCI godowns in the state. The rice millers in the state have announced a support price of Rs. 120 for milling per quintal of rice. Chhattisgarh has set a target of depositing 61.65 lakh tonnes of rice under central pool.
- After Telangana, Andhra Pradesh asks farmers to shun paddy cultivation this rabi and shift the area to alternatives like millets. The state has earlier planned to increase paddy area by one lakh hectares to 8.50 lakh hectares from normal area of 7.50 lakh hectares. But the farmers have sown only 50,000 hectares as of now against 94,000 hectares the previous year.
- As per Thai rice exporter association (TREA) rice importing nations would pay approximately \$579.75 million to shipping line as freight charges by the end of the year. Nigeria would pay \$300 million for 2 million tonnes of rice, Benin pays \$81 million for 540,000 tonnes while Togo pays \$56.25 million for 375,000 tonnes and Ghana pays \$142.5 million for 950,000 tonnes. The shift from containers to bulk shipment have affected the cost of foreign rice importation to West Africa from Thailand and other Asian countries.

- Centre has targeted a distribution of around 35 LMT of fortified rice till March 2022 in Phase 1. While in Phase 2 around 175 LMT of fortified rice targeted to be distributed till March 2023.
- In Telangana, the conversion of paddy acreage is likely to happen only in 20-25 lakh acres against 45 lakh acres targeted. The diversion is expected to happen from paddy to pulses and groundnut.
- As per sources, 51,000 MT rice vessel AMIS STAR is loading at Kakinada Port since 03rd December 2021. Also 21,000 MT of Rice Vessel VTC PLANET is loading at Kakinada Port since 01st December 2021. And 7,600 MT of Rice Vessel BMC ALPHA is loading at Kakinada Port on 25th November 2021. Also, 54,450 MT of Rice vessel ELINA B is loading at Kakinada Port since 25th November 2021. And 31,500 MT of Rice vessel MARYAM D is loading at Kakinada Port since 20th November. And 38,000 MT of Rice Vessel COLUMBIA is loading at Kakinada Port since 20th November 2021. Also 11,000 MT rice vessel SUPRA ONIKI is loading at Haldia Port since 04th December 2021. And 3,500 MT of Rice Vessel VOYAGER is loading at Kandla Port since 03rd December 2021. And 21,000 MT of Rice vessel OCEAN CROSS is waiting for loading at Kandla Port since 22nd November 2021. And 6,000 MT of rice vessel SEAWAY K is waiting for loading at Kandla Port since 26th November 2021. And 50,300 MT of Rice vessel VOKARIA is loading at Kandla Port since 06th December 2021. And 5,000 MT of Rice Vessel TIVSHA is loading at Kolkata Port since 06th December. And 31,000 MT of Rice Vessel LIBERTY C is loading at Krishnapatnam Port since 21st October 2021. And 32,000 MT of rice vessel ALTUS is loading at Krishnapatnam Port since 24th November 2021. Also 24,000 MT of rice vessel GOLDEN LOTUS is waiting for loading since 24th November 2021. Also 52,000 MT of rice vessel ESHIPS PROGRESS is loading at Vizag Port since 28th October 2021.
