

### Domestic & International Market Highlights:

- As of 13<sup>th</sup> December 2021, 351.27 lakh MT of paddy has been procured in KMS 2021-22 in the procuring states. Till now approximately, 30.60 lakh farmers have been benefitted from the procurement.
- In Uttar Pradesh, according to Commissioner, Food and Civil Supplies, as on December 21, total paddy worth more than Rs 6077.91 crore has been purchased from the farmers, and the payment is being made within 72 hours of the purchase directly to their bank accounts.
- The second crop paddy cultivation started in the district is in crisis due to the skyrocketing price and shortage of fertilizers like potash and FACTAMFOS, without which it is not possible to cultivate paddy. In the last six months, FACTOMFOS price was increased by Rs 300. Now it costs Rs 1,390 per 50kg bag.
- In West Bengal, South Dinajpur district Food and Supplies department has started procuring paddy directly from the farmers at some pre-ordained prices fixed by the state government through Centralised Procurement Centres (CPCs) covering all eight blocks of the district.
- As of 17<sup>th</sup> December, rabi paddy sowing was done in 11.92 lakh hectares up by 0.479 lakh hectares from 11.43 lakh hectares the previous year during corresponding period. In Tamil Nadu, around 9.81 lakh hectares up by 1.12 lakh hectares from 8.69 lakh hectares the previous year.
- In Telangana, ignoring the huge row over procurement, and the government's warning against sowing the crop, a section of farmers has started planting paddy. As of now, farmers have cultivated paddy in around 25,000 acres in various districts
- The Ministry of Finance has suspended the trading in Futures and Options (F&O) contracts of as many as seven agricultural commodities for one year to combat the rising inflation. The commodities put under the ban list include wheat, paddy (non-basmati), chana, mustard seeds and their derivatives, soya bean, crude palm oil and moong.
- In Andhra Pradesh, 21.16 crore metric tonne rice scheduled to be distributed to the beneficiaries in December will now be distributed next month due to insufficient stock availability with Andhra Pradesh Civil Supplies Corporation.
- As per sources, 38,600 MT of rice vessel ORCHID is loading at Kakinada Port since 10<sup>th</sup> December 2021. Also, 21,000 MT of rice vessel ROAD RUNNER is loading at Kakinada Port since 10<sup>th</sup> December 2021. And 18,700 MT of rice vessel AMIS WISDOM 1 is expected to arrive at Kandla Port on 16<sup>th</sup> December 2021. Also, 45,000 MT of rice vessel MOONDANCE II is expected to arrive

at Kakinada Port on 15<sup>th</sup> December 2021. And 49,000 MT of rice vessel SEA FORTRESS is expected to arrive at Kakinada Port on 18<sup>th</sup> December 2021.
