

Domestic & International Market Highlights:

- As of 13th December 2021, 351.27 lakh MT of paddy has been procured in KMS 2021-22 in the procuring states. Till now approximately, 30.60 lakh farmers have been benefitted from the procurement.
- In Tripura, the procurement for 20,000 metric tonnes paddy will commence from December 28 from 35 Paddy Procurement Centres (PPCs) across the state.
- In Sri Lanka, 90% - 95% of the total paddy lands to be cultivated during the Maha season have been cultivated so far. This year's paddy harvest will be between 70% - 75% of the last Maha season.
- In West Bengal, South Dinajpur district Food and Supplies department has started procuring paddy directly from the farmers at some pre-ordained prices fixed by the state government through Centralised Procurement Centres (CPCs) covering all eight blocks of the district.
- As of 17th December, rabi paddy sowing was done in 11.92 lakh hectares up by 0.479 lakh hectares from 11.43 lakh hectares the previous year during corresponding period. In Tamil Nadu, around 9.81 lakh hectares up by 1.12 lakh hectares from 8.69 lakh hectares the previous year.
- In Telangana, ignoring the huge row over procurement, and the government's warning against sowing the crop, a section of farmers has started planting paddy. As of now, farmers have cultivated paddy in around 25,000 acres in various districts
- The Ministry of Finance has suspended the trading in Futures and Options (F&O) contracts of as many as seven agricultural commodities for one year to combat the rising inflation. The commodities put under the ban list include wheat, paddy (non-basmati), chana, mustard seeds and their derivatives, soya bean, crude palm oil and moong.
- In Andhra Pradesh, 21.16 crore metric tonne rice scheduled to be distributed to the beneficiaries in December will now be distributed next month due to insufficient stock availability with Andhra Pradesh Civil Supplies Corporation.
- As per sources, 38,600 MT of rice vessel ORCHID is loading at Kakinada Port since 10th December 2021. Also, 21,000 MT of rice vessel ROAD RUNNER is loading at Kakinada Port since 10th December 2021. And 18,700 MT of rice vessel AMIS WISDOM 1 is expected to arrive at Kandla Port on 16th December 2021. Also, 45,000 MT of rice vessel MOONDANCE II is expected to arrive at Kakinada Port on 15th December 2021. And 49,000 MT of rice vessel SEA FORTRESS is expected to arrive at Kakinada Port on 18th December 2021.
