

Domestic & International Market Highlights:

- As of 26th December 2021, 443.49 lakh MT of paddy has been procured in KMS 2021-22 in the
 procuring states. Till now approximately, 47.03 lakh farmers have been benefitted from the
 procurement with MSP value of Rs. 86,924.46 crore.
- In Punjab, the highest paddy procurement was done with 186.86 LMT benefitting 9.24 lakh farmers at MSP value of Rs. 36,623.64 crores. Haryana follows next with 55.30 LMT of paddy procurement benefitting 3.10 lakh farmers at MSP value of Rs. 10,839.97 crores.
- In Pakistan, surplus stock of rice would be exported and new markets were being explored globally. The country has stock of over eight million tonnes of rice; however, local consumption is nearly 3.5 million tonnes.
- South Korea government will buy 200,000 tons of locally produced rice this year to help stabilize the market price of the staple grain. The move comes after this year's rice production reached 3.88 million tons, up by 10.7 percent from a year earlier, and matched expected demand of 3.61 million tons, which resulted in a surplus of 270,000 tons.
- Cambodia is set to enjoy a considerable boost in milled-rice exports to the EU next year after safeguard measures imposed by the European Commission (EC) expire on January 18. The safeguard regulations demands Cambodia to pay import duty of €175 (\$200) per tonne in the first year, €150 per tonne in the second, and €125 per tonne in the third.
- The Centre has decided to purchase more rice from Telangana government during the ongoing kharif season. It increased the procurement target by 6 lakh metric tonnes (LMT), from 40 LMT to 46 LMT. The Centre has extended the deadline for the state to supply boiled rice from the previous rabi season to the Food Corporation of India by one month till January 31, 2022. The Centre has been extending the deadline one month at a time since September.
- In Nalgonda district of Telangana, majority of the farmers in the district appear to have decided to go in for paddy cultivation in Yasangi despite the State government's categorical stand that it would not procure paddy following the Centre's refusal to buy rice.
- As per sources, till now 1,97,604 tonnes of rice has been deposited with FCI and 92,683 tonnes of rice with State Civil Supplies Corporation godowns in Chhattisgarh. The government said that custom milling should be done in full capacity as per agreement with rice millers. It should then be transported to Rake Point of the Food Corporation of India (FCI) at the earliest. Every day 15,000 tonnes of rice must be deposited with FCI godowns.
- Pakistan has decided to grant industry status to rice processing mills to boost the commodity's exports and solve other problems. Giving industry status to rice would help the industry get



financing facilities from banks while other issues, including energy supply to the sector, would also be resolved. In addition, the industrialization of rice is expected to increase rice exports as well as its production in Pakistan.

- As of 24th December, rabi paddy sowing was done in 12.922 lakh hectares up by 0.202 lakh hectares from 12.720 lakh hectares the previous year during corresponding period. In Tamil Nadu, around 10.035 lakh hectares up by 1.062 lakh hectares from 8.973 lakh hectares the previous year.
- December rice exports from Vietnam totalled at 470,000 tonnes, worth \$242 million. Rice exports in 2021 from Vietnam were forecast to drop 0.5% earlier to 6.2 million tonnes. Revenue from rice exports in the year was expected to rise 5% to \$3.3 billion.
- As per sources, 18,700 MT of rice vessel AMIS WISDOM 1 is loading at Kakinada Port since 16th December 2021. Also, 46,000 MT of rice vessel HACI ALI SARI is loading at Kakinada Port since 24th December 2021. Also, 30,100 MT of rice vessel MISS SIMONA is loading at Kakinada Port since 20th December 2021. Also, 49,000 MT of rice vessel SEA FORTRESS is loading at Kakinada Port since 20th December 2021. Also, 18,000 MT of rice vessel MONEGASQUEE EPEE is loading at Kandla Port since 20th December 2021. And, 5,000 MT of rice vessel TUHINA is expected to arrive at Kolkata Port on 29th December 2021. And, 50,000 MT of rice vessel AQUARIUS is loading at Vizag Port since 24th December 2021. Also, 48,000 MT of rice vessel FANEROMENI is waiting for birth since 13th December 2021. Also, 28,500 MT of rice vessel PATRONUS is loading at Krishnapatnam Port since 25th December 2021.
