Domestic & International Market Highlights:

- As of 31st December 2021, 486.22 lakh MT of paddy has been procured in KMS 2021-22 in the procuring states. Till now approximately, 55.69 lakh farmers have been benefitted from the procurement.
- In Punjab, the highest paddy procurement was done with 186.86 LMT benefitting 9.24 lakh farmers at MSP value of Rs. 36,623.64 crores. Haryana follows next with 55.30 LMT of paddy procurement benefitting 3.10 lakh farmers at MSP value of Rs. 10,839.97 crores.
- Despite all the issues from Central Government, Telangana government has set a new record in paddy procurement in ongoing Kharif season. As per the Centre targets of 46 lakh quintals rice procurement, which is equivalent to 68.65 lakh quintals of paddy, till January 3, 65.20 lakh metric tonnes of paddy was procured by the government and is preparing to procure additional quantities of paddy stocks coming the procurement centers.
- In Tirunelveli, paddy has been raised on 43,000 hectares against the target of 35,000 hectares. Against the required 13,000 tonnes of urea, the district has received only 8,000 tonnes of urea. Since the supply is so small and the demand is huge, the farmers have to buy urea, costing ₹ 266.50 a bag at the inflated price of ₹ 300 to 400.
- Farmers from Tamil Nadu protested to commence procurement as more than 3,000 bags of paddy were waiting for more than 20 days due to technical problem in online registration. Sources said that more that 18 DPCs were functioning in Orathanadu region of Tamil Nadu, but, at present only one DPC at Karukadipatti village was functional where more than 800 farmers had completed harvest of paddy.
- Poor weather condition has affected Kuttanad farmers as they are witnessing a drop in paddy yield by 2.5 lakh quintal in the rabi season. Rains, floods and bund collapse have impacted the crop. With this, the farmers who were expecting a yield of 5.10 lakh quintal fetch only 2.86 lakh quintals.
- In Bihar, the officials have asked to ensure achieving the target of 45 lakh tonnes of paddy in current season. As per sources, around 34 lakh tonnes of paddy was procured in the last season against the target of 35 lakh tonnes.
- In Chamarajanara district of Karnataka, farmers are opting for open market to sell paddy in the district as they are getting higher price than the MSP fixed by the government. The farmers are getting Rs 1,950 per quintal of paddy in the open market and even getting Rs 2,600-2,800 per quintal for Jyothi variety in the open market.

- Districts of Thanjavur and Tiruvarur were impacted by the heavy rains that lashed at Tamil Nadu in the past days have led to a crop loss of around 20,000 acres of paddy. The officials also said that around 50,000 tonnes of paddy that was procured and stocked in an open stockyard of the TNSC at Kumbakona were also affected.
- In Kendrapara district of Odisha, millers and agents are purchasing paddy from farmers directly by paying less than the minimum support price (MSP) fixed by the government due to slow procurement process in the district. Farmers alleged that harvesting grounds and threshing floors are packed with paddy as the authorities are yet to procure their produce.
- In Rohtas district of Bihar, the state government agencies have procured 1.57 LMT of paddy in from farmers till January 5. It is nearly 26.5% of the target fixed for procurement. The government has set a target to procure 5.89 lakh tonnes of paddy on MSP.
- Bangladesh's state grains buyer has issued an international tender to purchase 50,000 tonnes of rice on 5th January 2022. The deadline for submission of price offers is January 16th 2022.
- As of 31st December, rabi paddy sowing was done in 14.052 lakh hectares down by 0.997 lakh hectares from 15.049 lakh hectares the previous year during corresponding period. In Tamil Nadu, around 10.219 lakh hectares up by 0.817 lakh hectares from 9.402 lakh hectares the previous year.
- As per sources, 46,000 MT of rice vessel HACI ALI SARI is loading at Kakinada Port since 24th December 2021. Also, 30,100 MT of rice vessel MISS SIMONA is loading at Kakinada Port since 20th December 2021. And 49,000 MT of rice vessel SEA FORTRESS is loading at Kakinada Port since 20th December 2021. Also, 5,000 MT of rice vessel RIDER is loading at Kandla Port since 29th December 2021. Also, 4,000 MT of rice vessel ABDULLATIF is waiting for loading at Kandla Port since 28th December 2021. Also, 35,640 MT of rice vessel PROPEL PROSPERITY is expected to arrive at Kandla Port on 31st December 2021. Also, 48,000 MT of rice vessel FANEROMENI is loading at Vizag Port since 30th December 2021.
