

Domestic & International Market Highlights:

- As of 31st December 2021, 486.22 lakh MT of paddy has been procured in KMS 2021-22 in the
 procuring states. Till now approximately, 55.69 lakh farmers have been benefitted from the
 procurement.
- In Punjab, the highest paddy procurement was done with 186.86 LMT benefitting 9.24 lakh farmers at MSP value of Rs. 36,623.64 crores. Haryana follows next with 55.30 LMT of paddy procurement benefitting 3.10 lakh farmers at MSP value of Rs. 10,839.97 crores.
- As per reports, the Uttar Pradesh government has procured around 44 LMT of paddy from 6.64 lakh farmers till January 5 with MSP of Rs 8,227.37 crore.
- Export prices of rice from Thailand touched their highest level in nearly three months this week
 as traders anticipate increased overseas buying, Thailand's 5% broken rice prices rose to \$390\$402 per tonne compared to \$387-\$396 last week. The traders are expecting more demand
 from the overseas market this year and that some exporters have started to build stockpiles in
 anticipation.
- In Tirunelveli, paddy has been raised on 43,000 hectares against the target of 35,000 hectares.
 Against the required 13,000 tonnes of urea, the district has received only 8,000 tonnes of urea.
 Since the supply is so small and the demand is huge, the farmers have to buy urea, costing ₹
 266.50 a bag at the inflated price of ₹ 300 to 400.
- In Tamil Nadu, as the early harvest season begins, farmers in Thanjavur are facing a nearly 50% drop in samba yield due to the unseasonal rain. Samba and thalady paddy have been cultivated on 3,42,973 acres in the district which is nearly 30,500 acres more than the year's target of 3,12,500 acres.
- India's 5% broken parboiled rice price was quoted at \$359-\$363 per tonne this week, its highest level since Nov. 11, up from the last week's \$355-\$360. Demand is not good but still prices are moving higher because of strenghtening of rupee.
- Nepal's paddy production this year at 4.13 MMT is the lowest in the last five years and is down by 8.74% compared to last year. Far Western and Lumbini provinces recorded the highest decline at 31.49% and 18.38% owing to heavy pre-monsoon rains.
- In Chamarajanara district of Karnataka, farmers are opting for open market to sell paddy in the district as they are getting higher price than the MSP fixed by the government. The farmers are getting Rs 1,950 per quintal of paddy in the open market and even getting Rs 2,600-2,800 per quintal for Jyothi variety in the open market.



- Vietnam's 5% broken rice were quoted at \$395-\$400 per tonne, its lowest level since the week of Aug. 26 last year, unchanged from a week earlier. Many exporters are increasing their purchases from farmers to fulfil the export contracts they have signed earlier.
- The price of local rice has remained stable in major markets in Nigeria. The patronage had been
 massive for local rice as many residents could hardly afford foreign rice due to its high cost.
 Many rice dealers, especially farmers, flooded the market with local rice, which made the price
 stable.
- Sri Lanka has signed MoU with Myanmar for the purchase of 1 LMT of rice. The stock of rice will be purchased with immediate effect as a buffer stock.
- Bangladesh's state grains buyer has issued an international tender to purchase 50,000 tonnes of rice on 5th January 2022. The deadline for submission of price offers is January 16th 2022.
- In Pakistan, Rice exporters are facing trouble in obtaining Export Refinance Facility from their banks which are saying that due to lack of allocations from the State Bank, they are not able to enhance the current credit lines. Efforts to take rice exports up to \$2.5 billion from the current \$2.0bn mark may suffer badly despite a good production.
- As of 07th January, Rabi paddy sowing was done in 16.44 lakh hectares down by 12.02% from 18.69 lakh hectares the previous year. Tamil Nadu has sown 10.98 lakh hectares of paddy so far up by 12.31% from 9.78 lakh hectares.
- As per USDA, in Pakistan new higher-yielding hybrid rice varieties, improved agronomic practices
 and increased planting area, as farmers shift out of cotton, are factors driving the increased
 production of rice. Pakistan harvested a record rice crop of 8.9 million tonnes in the 2021-22
 marketing year, up from 8.4 million tonnes the previous year.
- As per sources, 46,000 MT of rice vessel HACI ALI SARI is loading at Kakinada Port since 24th December 2021. Also, 30,100 MT of rice vessel MISS SIMONA is loading at Kakinada Port since 20th December 2021. And 49,000 MT of rice vessel SEA FORTRESS is loading at Kakinada Port since 20th December 2021. Also, 5,000 MT of rice vessel RIDER is loading at Kandla Port since 29th December 2021. Also, 4,000 MT of rice vessel ABDULLATIF is waiting for loading at Kandla Port since 28th December 2021. Also, 35,640 MT of rice vessel PROPEL PROSPERITY is expected to arrive at Kandla Port on 31st December 2021. Also, 48,000 MT of rice vessel FANEROMENI is loading at Vizag Port since 30th December 2021.
