

Domestic & International Market Highlights:

- As of 09th January 2022, 532.86 lakh MT of paddy has been procured in KMS 2021-22 in the procuring states. Till now approximately, 64.07 lakh farmers have been benefitted from the procurement with MSP value of Rs. 1,04,441.45 crore.
- In Punjab, the highest paddy procurement was done with 186.86 LMT benefitting 9.24 lakh farmers at MSP value of Rs. 36,623.64 crores. Haryana follows next with 55.31 LMT of paddy procurement benefitting 3.10 lakh farmers at MSP value of Rs. 10,839.97 crores.
- In Tamil Nadu, with several spells of heavy rainfall during the northeast monsoon having damaged crops on thousands of hectares, policymakers are keeping their fingers crossed that the State will meet its rice production target of 75.5 lakh tonnes this time even though nearly 48,000 hectares of land was damaged in vaying degrees.
- Non-basmati rice exports from India is likely to be affected in the first quarter of this year as the rates of parboiled rice have increased due to central government's purchase of cereals for distribution under free ration scheme for poor families. The prices are up by \$20-30 per tonne due to higher consumption at home and also there is a panic buying by the procurement agencies. The panic buying is happeneing in Nagpur and Chattisgarh.
- In the Ganjam district of Odisha, paddy harvesting and procurement have been delayed due to the unseasonal rainfalls. Around 30 percent of the field is yet to be harvested, but due to the water lodging conditions and poor quality of crops.
- Sri Lanka has received approval to import nearly 300,000 MT of rice which includes 200,000 MT of nadu rice and 100,000 MT of GR-11 short grain rice. The stock of rice is to be imported as a substitute for Samba Rice to ensure the availability of required rice consignments in the open market.
- Assam government has decided to bring an end to middleman system so that farmers could be economically benefited. As to lack of proper procurement mechanism and committed efforts, majority of the paddy produced in the state is procured by middlemen depriving the farmers of fair price.
- In Pakistan, due to the lack of availability of containers and high fright costs, 250,000 tonnes of rice could not be exported last year and this quantity may increase to 500,000 tonnes this year due to the severity of the situation. The county is likely to lose \$400 million in export revenue if timely steps are not taken through policy measures by restricting the movement of empty containers. Container charges which were \$70 to \$80 last year have increased to over \$1,300 per container for their Chinese destination.

- As per sources, Vietnam's rice exports in December fell 13.4% from the previous month to 490,219 tonnes. The country's rice exports in 2021 fell 0.2% year on year to 6.24 million tonnes.
- As of 07th January, Rabi paddy sowing was done in 16.44 lakh hectares down by 12.02% from 18.69 lakh hectares the previous year. Tamil Nadu has sown 10.98 lakh hectares of paddy so far up by 12.31% from 9.78 lakh hectares.
- In Karnataka, recent rainfall and floods have massively damaged paddy in the districts of Bellary and Raichur. It is expected that more than 50 per cent of the crop was damaged in certain areas of the district due to the heavy rains during the North-East monsoon. Paddy was badly hit at the main stage.
- Karnataka is considering expanding Rashtriya e-Market Services (ReMS) platform to sell agriculture and horticulture products of Farmers Producer Organisations (FPOs). The ReMS electronic trading platform will connect markets with FPOs allowing the farmers' collectives to sell their produce in bulk. The platform has 44,000 traders registered across 160 markets in the state.
- As per sources, 51,000 MT of rice vessel AMIS STAR is loading at Kakinada Port since 03rd January 2022. And 40,000 MT of rice vessel OBSERVATOR is loading at Kakinada Port since 01st January 2022. And, 37,000 MT of rice vessel SPLIT is loading at Kakinada Port since 02nd January 2022. And 44,000 MT of rice vessel PANCARAN VICTORY is loading at Kandla Port since 02nd January 2022. And 15,000 MT of rice vessel KEMET STAR is waiting for loading at Kandla Port since 09th January 2022. Also, 29,000 MT of rice vessel PROPEL PROGRESS is waiting for loading at Kandla Port since 08th January 2022. Also, 22,000 MT of rice vessel MOMENTUM PHONIX is loading at Krishnapatnam Port since 06th January 2022. Also, 41,000 MT of rice vessel SUPRA ONIKI is loading at Krishnapatnam Port since 08th January 2022.
