

## **Domestic & International Market Highlights:**

- As of 09<sup>th</sup> January 2022, 532.86 lakh MT of paddy has been procured in KMS 2021-22 in the procuring states. Till now approximately, 64.07 lakh farmers have been benefitted from the procurement with MSP value of Rs. 1,04,441.45 crore.
- In Punjab, the highest paddy procurement was done with 186.86 LMT benefitting 9.24 lakh farmers at MSP value of Rs. 36,623.64 crores. Haryana follows next with 55.31 LMT of paddy procurement benefitting 3.10 lakh farmers at MSP value of Rs. 10,839.97 crores.
- In Iran, a total of 709,000 tons of rice were imported during the first nine months of the current fiscal year (March-Dec), which shows slower than usual imports. This year, some 500,000 tons of the imports came before the seasonal annual ban was implemented and the remaining 209,000 tons came after it was lifted on November 8th.
- Non-basmati rice exports from India is likely to be affected in the first quarter of this year as the rates of parboiled rice have increased due to central government's purchase of cereals for distribution under free ration scheme for poor families. The prices are up by \$20-30 per tonne due to higher consumption at home and also there is a panic buying by the procurement agencies. The panic buying is happeneing in Nagpur and Chattisgarh.
- Rice export prices in India this week touched their highest levels since last June which is supported by tight supplies and a stronger rupee. India's 5% broken parboiled rice was quoted at \$367-\$375 per tonne up from last week's \$359-\$363. Mills are mainly focusing on milling white rice. Parboiled supplies are very limited which is supporting the prices.
- Sri Lanka has received approval to import nearly 300,000 MT of rice which includes 200,000 MT
  of nadu rice and 100,000 MT of GR-11 short grain rice. The stock of rice is to be imported as a
  substitute for Samba Rice to ensure the availability of required rice consignments in the open
  market.
- Assam government has decided to bring an end to middleman system so that farmers could be
  economically benefited. As to lack of proper procurement mechanism and committed efforts,
  majority of the paddy produced in the state is procured by middlemen depriving the farmers of
  fair price.
- In Pakistan, due to the lack of availability of containers and high fright costs, 250,000 tonnes of rice could not be exported last year and this quantity may increase to 500,000 tonnes this year due to the severity of the situation. The county is likely to lose \$400 million in export revenue if timely steps are not taken through policy measures by restricting the movement of empty containers. Container charges which were \$70 to \$80 last year have increased to over \$1,300 per container for their Chinese destination.



- Thailand's 5% broken prices rose to their highest since mid-July 2021 at \$404-\$405 per tonne from \$390-\$402 last week. An increase in demand among exporters who had to fulfil orders made before the New Year's holidays raised prices slightly. According to reports, Thailand exported 5.39 million tonnes of rice between January and November 2021, up 2.6% from the same period a year earlier.
- As of 14th January, Rabi paddy sowing was done in 19.82 lakh hectares down by 18.52% from 24.33 lakh hectares the previous year. Tamil Nadu has sown 11.19 lakh hectares of paddy so far up from 10.12 lakh hectares. The decrease in the acreage is mainly due to Telangana and Andhra Pradesh farmers opting out sowing of paddy due to the procurement issues with centre and government's crop diversification policies.
- Vietnam's 5% broken rice was offered at \$395-\$405 per tonne widening from a range of \$395-\$400 a week ago. Sales are slow, and local traders have scaled down their purchases from farmers due to which the prices are not moving. Government customs data showed Vietnam's rice exports in 2021 fell 0.2% to 6.24 million tonnes. Exports in December fell 13.4% from November to 490,219 tonnes.
- A very stable and high demand for specialty rice from Asia is making the European Union (EU) a
  highly potential market for rice exporters of Vietnam. In 2021, Vietnam shipped about 60,000
  tonnes of rice worth 41 million USD to the EU, up by nearly 1 percent in terms of volume and
  over 20 percent in value from the previous year. The EU Vietnam Free Trade Agreement
  (EVFTA), coming into force on August 1, 2020, has helped raise prices of the Vietnamese grain by
  10 20 USD per tonne.
- As per sources, 51,000 MT of rice vessel AMIS STAR is loading at Kakinada Port since 03<sup>rd</sup> January 2022. And 40,000 MT of rice vessel OBSERVATOR is loading at Kakinada Port since 01<sup>st</sup> January 2022. And, 37,000 MT of rice vessel SPLIT is loading at Kakinada Port since 02<sup>nd</sup> January 2022. And 44,000 MT of rice vessel PANCARAN VICTORY is loading at Kandla Port since 02<sup>nd</sup> January 2022. And 15,000 MT of rice vessel KEMET STAR is waiting for loading at Kandla Port since 09<sup>th</sup> January 2022. Also, 29,000 MT of rice vessel PROPEL PROGRESS is waiting for loading at Kandla Port since 08<sup>th</sup> January 2022. Also, 22,000 MT of rice vessel MOMENTUM PHONIX is loading at Krishnapatnam Port since 06<sup>th</sup> January 2022. Also, 41,000 MT of rice vessel SUPRA ONIKI is loading at Krishnapatnam Port since 08<sup>th</sup> January 2022.
