

## Domestic & International Market Highlights:

- As of 23<sup>rd</sup> January 2022, 606.19 lakh metric tonnes (LMT) of paddy have been procured in KMS 2021-22 in the procuring states. Till now, approximately, 77 lakh farmers have been benefitted from the procurement with the MSP value of Rs. 1,18,812.56 crore.
- India's rice export prices eased off a more than seven-month high this week as the rupee weakened, while activity in other hubs remained quiet ahead of key harvest and festival seasons. The rupee's depreciation is bringing down export prices. But still, new deals are not picking up due to railway wagon scarcity. India's 5% broken rice was quoted at \$372 to \$379 per tonne this week, down from the last week's 7-month peak of \$375 to \$382.
- Telangana government has procured 70 lakh tonnes of paddy for the KMS 2021-22 season which is about 44 per cent i.e., 21.21 lakh tonnes more than KMS 2020-21 season. The paddy procured by the Telangana government is around 1.31 lakh tonnes more than the official target of 68.69 lakh tonnes of paddy i.e., about 46 lakh tonnes of rice.
- Thailand's 5% broken rice prices edged higher to \$408-\$415 per tonne, from \$407-\$410 last week. Thailand exported 6.1 million tonnes of rice in 2021, up 6.7% from a year earlier, according to data from the country's commerce ministry. Overseas demand for Thai rice was largely still muted.
- Vietnam's 5% broken rice were offered at \$395-\$405 per tonne, unchanged from a week ago.
   Trading activity is slow as the Lunar New Year holiday is approaching. The main winter-spring harvest will begin over the next week, but won't peak until mid-March. Winter-spring productivity will likely fall 10%-20% from the same harvest a year earlier as many farmers had cut down on fertilization, which has become more expensive due to the pandemic.
- As of 21st January, Rabi paddy sowing was done in 23.606 lakh hectares down by 21.86% from 30.21 lakh hectares the previous year. Tamil Nadu has sown 11.30 lakh hectares of paddy so far up from 10.19 lakh hectares. The decrease in the acreage is mainly due to Telangana and Andhra Pradesh farmers opting out sowing of paddy due to the procurement issues with centre and government's crop diversification policies. Also, in West Bengal and Odisha, the sowing has been delayed due to unseasonal rainfalls.
- As per sources, 4,500 MT of rice vessel SUVARI KAPTAN is loading at Kandla Port since 21<sup>st</sup> January 2022. And 5,750 MT of rice vessel BEEK6 is expected to arrive at Kandla Port on 23<sup>rd</sup> January 2022. And 42,000 MT of rice vessel NPS MOSA is loading at Kakinada Port since 16<sup>th</sup> January 2022. Also, 39,900 MT of rice vessel STRANGE ATTRACTOR is loading at Kakinada Port since 17<sup>th</sup> January 2022. And,55,000 metric tonnes (MT) of rice vessel ELEFTHEROTRIA is waiting for loading at Kandla Port since 17<sup>th</sup> January 2022. Also, 35,640 MT of rice vessel PROPEL PROSPERITY is loading at Kandla Port since 18<sup>th</sup> January 2022. Also, 22,000 MT of rice vessel MOMENTUM PHONIX is loading at



Krishnapatnam Port since  $06^{th}$  January 2022. Also, 41,000 MT of rice vessel SUPRA ONIKI is loading at Krishnapatnam Port since  $08^{th}$  January 2022.
