

Domestic & International Market Highlights:

- As of 30th January 2022, 637.86 lakh metric tonne (LMT) of paddy have been procured in KMS 2021-22 in the procuring states. Till now, approximately, 82.79 lakh farmers have been benefitted from the procurement with the MSP value of Rs. 1,25,020.85 crore.
- Rice exports from Vietnam in January are estimated to have risen 4.2 percent from a year earlier to 360,000 tonnes. Revenue from rice exports in the period was seen decreasing 4.3 percent to \$182 million. The high prices along with stiff competition from India is the reason for a decrease in the exports.
- In Ghazipur district of Uttar Pradesh, a target has been set to procure 2,31,200 metric tonnes of paddy in the district, but till now eighty percent i.e., 1,86,000 metric tonnes of paddy have been procured. This purchase has been done from more than 27,900 farmers. Paddy will be procured for one month now. And it is expected that the target will be achieved.
- As of January 1, FCI had a rice supply of 53.89 MMT, which was more than seven times the stocking norm of 7.61 MMT. Paddy procurement exceeds the official annual distribution requirement of 28 MMT under the National Food Security Act (NFSA). Government is likely to continue to offer rice from the Central Pool stock for ethanol at subsidized rates for the next five years, potentially reducing stock by 10 MMT over and above normal offtake.
- Rabi activities in the district of Koraput district of Odisha has been affected due to the ongoing polls. The Upper Kolab irrigation authorities released water for the rabi season to ayacut areas across 23,600-hectare land in Jeypore, Kotpad, Kundra and Borigumma blocks, in the first week of January. However, only 30-35 per cent work on paddy crops are complete till now, against more than 50 per cent around the same time last year. As per reports, nearly 13,000 ha in the region had been covered under rabi paddy last year while this time, work has begun only on around 8,200 ha.
- As of 28th January, Rabi paddy sowing was done in 28.160 lakh hectares down by 19.31% from 34.900 lakh hectares the previous year. Tamil Nadu has sown 11.38 lakh hectares of paddy so far up from 10.51 lakh hectares. The decrease in the acreage is mainly due to Telangana and Andhra Pradesh farmers opting out sowing of paddy due to the procurement issues with centre and government's crop diversification policies. Also, in West Bengal and Odisha, the sowing has been delayed due to unseasonal rainfalls.
- As per sources, 55,000 MT of rice vessel ELEFHEROTRIA is loading at Kandla Port since 29th January 2022.
- 22,000 MT of rice vessel ASTERAS is loading at Kakinada Port since 25th January 2022. And 38,000 MT of rice vessel ASTRA CENTAURUS is loading at Kakinada Port since 26th January 2022. And

44,000 MT of rice vessel CAPTAINYANNIS L is loading at Kakinada Port since 23rd January 2022. And 40,000 MT of rice vessel IOANNIS THEO is loading at Kakinada Port since 26th January 2022. And 30,000 MT of rice vessel RACOON is loading at Kandla Port since 23rd January 2022. Also, 13,250 MT of rice vessel NADEEN is waiting for loading at Kandla Port since 27th January 2022. And 18,000 MT of rice vessel STORM RIDER is waiting for loading at Kandla Port since 25th January 2022. And 27,600 MT of rice vessel SUN BULK is waiting for loading at Kandla Port since 28th January 2022.
