

Domestic & International Market Highlights:

- As of 30th January 2022, 637.86 lakh metric tonne (LMT) of paddy have been procured in KMS 2021-22 in the procuring states. Till now, approximately, 82.79 lakh farmers have been benefitted from the procurement with the MSP value of Rs. 1,25,020.85 crore.
- Finance Minister Nirmala Sitharaman on Tuesday said that the estimated procurement of wheat in Rabi 2021-22 and paddy in Kharif 2021-22 will cover 1,208 LMT of wheat and paddy from 163 lakh farmers. About ₹ 2.37 lakh crores will be direct payment of Minimum Support Price (MSP) to farmers accounts.
- Thailand became the world's third-largest rice exporter by shipping 6.12 million metric tonne (MMT) of rice last year, up 6.7 percent year-on-year. Though, the export volume has increased, the total value of exported rice in 2021 dropped 7.1 percent from the previous year i.e from \$3.7 billion to \$3.4 billion. Meanwhile, India still remains the top rice exporter for four consecutive years with 19.5 MMT of rice exported in 2021, up 33.9 percent year-on-year. Vietnam came in second with 6.24 MMT exported last year, dropping 5.2 percent year-on-year. Pakistan and the United States, meanwhile, are in fourth and fifth places, with 3.93 MMT and 2.85 MMT of rice exported in 2021.
- As of January 1, FCI had a rice supply of 53.89 MMT, which was more than seven times the stocking norm of 7.61 MMT. Paddy procurement exceeds the official annual distribution requirement of 28 MMT under the National Food Security Act (NFSA). Government is likely to continue to offer rice from the Central Pool stock for ethanol at subsidized rates for the next five years, potentially reducing stock by 10 MMT over and above normal offtake.
- Around 20 centres have been set up in the Polonnaruwa district of Sri Lanka to purchase paddy from farmers under the government guaranteed price this season. Accordingly, a guaranteed price of 92 Sri Lankan rupee for a kilo of Nadu paddy, 94 Sri Lankan rupee for a kilo of Samba paddy and 97 Sri Lankan rupee for a kilo of Keeri Samba paddy will be paid by the government. The government hopes to purchase 50,000 metric tonne of paddy from farmers.
- As of 28th January, Rabi paddy sowing was done in 28.160 lakh hectares down by 19.31% from 34.900 lakh hectares the previous year. Tamil Nadu has sown 11.38 lakh hectares of paddy so far up from 10.51 lakh hectares. The decrease in the acreage is mainly due to Telangana and Andhra Pradesh farmers opting out sowing of paddy due to the procurement issues with centre and government's crop diversification policies. Also, in West Bengal and Odisha, the sowing has been delayed due to unseasonal rainfalls.
- Supply chain issues hampered South Korean rice imports in the final quarter of 2021, leading to a 11% decrease in imports from the previous Marketing Year. The rice import forecast for 2021-22 has been revised upward to 490,000 tonne, a 19% increase, due to actual delivery of some 2021



tariff rate quota contacts moving to 2022. As per USDA, as in many Asian countries, rice consumption has been declining in South Korea in recent years, having fallen four consecutive years since a recent peak of 4.7 million tonne in 2017-18. Per capita rice consumption has declined from 59.2 kilograms in 2018-19 to a projected 55.3 kilograms in 2021-22.

- Thailand has set a rice export target at 7 MMT this year, 14.6% higher than in 2021. Thai rice exports benefit this year from a more stable baht which makes the prices more competitive and better weather conditions. Due to these factors, it is expected to produce 19.5 MMT of paddy this year, 18% up on last year's 16.5 MMT.
- As per sources, 39,000 MT of rice vessel AGGELOS B is loading at Kakinada Port since 30th January 2022. And 13,250 MT of rice vessel JOAHAR UK is waiting for loading at Kandla Port since 31st January 2021 55,000 MT of rice vessel ELEFTHEROTRIA is loading at Kandla Port since 29th January 2022. And 40,000 MT of rice vessel IOANNIS THEO is loading at Kakinada Port since 26th January 2022. Also, 13,250 MT of rice vessel NADEEN is waiting for loading at Kandla Port since 27th January 2022. And 18,000 MT of rice vessel STORM RIDER is waiting for loading at Kandla Port since 25th January 2022. And 27,600 MT of rice vessel SUN BULK is waiting for loading at Kandla Port since 28th January 2022.
