

Domestic & International Market Highlights:

- As per trade source estimates, 48,000 MT or rice vessel ACHILLEAS S is loading at Kakinada Port since 15th February 2022. And 42,000 MT of rice vessel ATHENA is loading at Kakinada Port since 13th February 2022. And 43,000 MT of rice vessel GENCO MARY is loading at Kakinada port since 15th February 2022. And 55,495 MT of rice vessel LIBERTY is loading at Kakinada Port since 12th February 2022. And 40,000 MT of rice vessel SEABOSS is loading at Kakinada since 10th February 2022. And 5,750 MT of rice vessel BEEK6 is loading at Kandla since 12th February 2022. And 50,000 MT of rice vessel GALINI is loading at Kandla Port since 13th February 2022. And 27,600 MT of rice vessel BOZBURUN M is loading at Kakinada Port since 04th February 2022. And 50,000 MT of rice vessel CL CENTURY is loading at Kakinada Port since 01st February 2022. And 50,000 MT of rice vessel OCEAN BAO is loading at Kakinada Port since 01st February 2022. And 23,000 MT of rice vessel DMC JUPITER is waiting for loading at Kandla Port since 08th February 2022. And 27,000 MT of rice vessel HALIT YILDIRIM is waiting for loading at Kandla Port since 09th February 2022. And 30,000 MT of rice vessel SINCERE is waiting for loading at Kandla Port since 06th February 2022. And 50,2000 MT of rice vessel PARVRAJ is loading at Krishnapatnam Port since 06th February 2022.
- The opening stock in the central pool for the month of February stood at 263.36 LMT. During the
 previous month, the opening stock was 221.54 LMT. The stock is higher than previous year's stock
 of 243.62 LMT.
- As per ministry of agriculture's second advance estimate, the kharif rice production estimate stood at 109.54 MMT higher compared to 107.04 during the previous estimate for MY 2021-22. The rabi estimate stands at 18.39 MMT. Agriwatch has estimated the kharif production at 107.83 MMT while preliminary estimate for rabi rice stood at 15.02 MMT. The overall production has been estimated at 127.93 MMT on second advance estimate.
- Once again, the price of paddy has started increasing in the mandis. With the rise in prices, the arrivals have also increased. Although the prices had come down quite a while back, due to which the farmers had stocked up on paddy. Now due to the increase in the price again, the arrival of paddy has increased. In Kaithal grain market, the price of 1121 has reached near four thousand rupees per quintal, while the price of Basmati has reached Rs 3450 per quintal, 1718 to Rs 3800 per quintal. A month ago, the price of paddy had fallen by up to Rs 400 per quintal in the grain market. The price of Basmati had reached Rs 3200 per quintal, Rs 3600 per quintal of 1718.
- As of 16th February 2022, around 688.37 lakh tonnes of paddy have been procured by state agencies and FCI. In Punjab, around 186.86 lakh tonnes of paddy have been procured while from Haryana around 55.31 lakh tonnes of paddy have been procured. Also, approximately 92.76 farmers have been benefitted by the paddy procurement.



- In Chhattisgarh, over 19.64 lakh tonnes (LMT) of quality rice have been deposited in the central pool so far, a week before the completion of paddy procurement. This includes 10.80 lakh tonnes (LMT) of rice deposited in the FCI and 8.83 lakh tonnes (LMT) in the Civil Supplies Corporation. About 98 lakh tonnes (LMT) of paddy have been procured in a systematic manner from over 21.77 lakh farmers in Chhattisgarh this Kharif year. A record 72.81 lakh tonnes (LMT) of paddy have been lifted by the rice millers so far. This year, over 61.65 lakh tonnes (LMT) of Arva rice is to be deposited in the central pool, Verma said.
- In Ranchi district of Jharkhand, more than 10000 farmers are registered but till the paddy procurement center, only 1200 farmers have sold their paddy and due to not getting the amount of paddy purchase to the farmers on time, now the farmers are also not showing interest to sell their paddy till the paddy procurement center. This is the reason that in Ranchi district in two and a half months only one lakh quintals of paddy have been procured. A target has been set to purchase five lakh quintals of paddy.
- As per trade source estimates, India's rice exports for January month were estimated to be around 16.63 LMT down from 18.04 LMT during December month. The decrease in exports is due to low export demand from Bangladesh. China emerged as the largest importer of Indian rice with 2.34 LMT followed by Iran with 1.78 LMT and Nepal with 1.40 LMT.
