

**Domestic & International Market Highlights:**

- As per trade source estimates, 48,000 MT of rice vessel ACHILLEAS S is loading at Kakinada Port since 15<sup>th</sup> February 2022. And 42,000 MT of rice vessel ATHENA is loading at Kakinada Port since 13<sup>th</sup> February 2022. And 43,000 MT of rice vessel GENCO MARY is loading at Kakinada port since 15<sup>th</sup> February 2022. And 55,495 MT of rice vessel LIBERTY is loading at Kakinada Port since 12<sup>th</sup> February 2022. And 40,000 MT of rice vessel SEABOSS is loading at Kakinada since 10<sup>th</sup> February 2022. And 5,750 MT of rice vessel BEEK6 is loading at Kandla since 12<sup>th</sup> February 2022. And 50,000 MT of rice vessel GALINI is loading at Kandla Port since 13<sup>th</sup> February 2022. And 27,600 MT of rice vessel SUN BULK is loading at Kandla Port since 13<sup>th</sup> February 2022. And 40,000 MT of rice vessel BOZBURUN M is loading at Kakinada Port since 04<sup>th</sup> February 2022. And 50,000 MT of rice vessel CL CENTURY is loading at Kakinada Port since 01<sup>st</sup> February 2022. Also 11,000 MT of rice vessel TEACHER O waiting for loading at Kakinada Port since 14<sup>th</sup> February 2022. And 23,000 MT of rice vessel DMC JUPITER is waiting for loading at Kandla Port since 08<sup>th</sup> February 2022. And 27,000 MT of rice vessel HALIT YILDIRIM is waiting for loading at Kandla Port since 09<sup>th</sup> February 2022. And 30,000 MT of rice vessel SINCERE is waiting for loading at Kandla Port since 06<sup>th</sup> February 2022. And 50,2000 MT of rice vessel PARVRAJ is loading at Krishnapatnam Port since 06<sup>th</sup> February 2022.
- India's 5% broken parboiled rice was unchanged at \$368-\$374 per tonne, holding near the lowest in more than a month as demand was muted from key buyers. White rice buyers are shifting to Myanmar and Pakistan because of lower prices. In current year, a record production of 127.93 million tonne, compared with 124.37 million tonne the year before is expected.
- Thailand's 5% broken rice prices were quoted at \$410-\$420 per tonne, up from \$407-\$415 last week, mainly due to a change in the exchange rate. But the prices could soon weaken as the off-season harvest begins.
- Vietnam's 5% broken rice was quoted at \$400 per tonne, the highest since mid-December and up from \$395 a week ago. Prices have increased slightly as trading activity is resuming following the Lunar New Year Holiday and demand is seen picking up. The traders were buying moderate amounts from farmers ahead of the upcoming winter-spring harvest. Also, there were reports of joining tender issued by South Korea for purchase of 72,200 MT of rice.
- China has set the minimum purchase prices for early indica, late indica and japonica rice at 124 yuan (USD 19.60), 129 yuan (USD 20.39) and 131 yuan (USD 20.71) per 50kg respectively. The prices are also higher than those set for 2021, signaling increasing support for production of the crop. The total volume of rice purchased at the minimum purchase price for 2022 will be limited to 50 million tonne (MMT), with 20 MMT for indica rice and 30 MMT for japonica rice.
- The opening stock in the Central Pool for the month of February stood at 263.36 lakh metric tonne (LMT). During the previous month, the opening stock was 221.54 LMT. The stock is higher than previous year's stock of 243.62 LMT.

- As per Ministry of Agriculture's second advance estimate, the kharif rice production estimate stood at 109.54 MMT higher compared to 107.04 during the previous estimate for MY 2021-22. The rabi estimate stands at 18.39 MMT. AgriWatch has estimated the kharif production at 107.83 MMT while preliminary estimate for rabi rice stood at 15.02 MMT. The overall production has been estimated at 127.93 MMT on second advance estimate.
- Once again, the price of paddy has started increasing in the mandis. With the rise in prices, the arrivals have also increased. Although, the prices had come down quite a while back, due to which the farmers had stocked up on paddy. Now, due to the increase in the price again, the arrival of paddy has increased. In Kaithal grain market, the price of 1121 has reached near Rs 4000 per quintal, while the price of Basmati has reached at Rs 3450 per quintal, 1718 to Rs 3800 per quintal. A month ago, the price of paddy had fallen by up to Rs 400 per quintal in the grain market. The price of Basmati had reached at Rs 3200 per quintal, Rs 3600 per quintal for 1121 and Rs 3600 per quintal for 1718.
- As of 16<sup>th</sup> February 2022, around 688.37 lakh tonne of paddy have been procured by state agencies and FCI. In Punjab, around 186.86 lakh tonne of paddy have been procured while from Haryana around 55.31 lakh tonne of paddy have been procured. Also, approximately 92.76 farmers have been benefitted by the paddy procurement.
