

Domestic & International Market Highlights:

- As of 22nd February 2022, around 701.41 lakh tonne (LMT) of paddy have been procured by state agencies and FCI benefitting 95.128 lakh farmers. In terms of rice, the aim for this Kharif season is 528.26 LMT (paddy equivalent to 788.45 LMT). In terms of rice, the current procurement is 470.73 LMT. The procurement has already been completed in important states like Bihar, Telangana, Chhattisgarh, Punjab, Haryana, and Madhya Pradesh, it will be completed in Andhra Pradesh, Odisha, and Tamil Nadu by March 31. The formal purchase in Uttar Pradesh, will be concluded this month, while it will continue in West Bengal until June 30. Purchases in Telangana, which started late due to issues between the State and the Centre over parboiled rice, exceeded the target by 1.56 LMT at 70.22 LMT, while in Chhattisgarh, purchases were suspended after attaining the target of 92.01 LMT. Telangana and Chhattisgarh have emerged as major rice providers to the Central Pool, and they may replace Punjab and Haryana as alternate suppliers if the government decides to abandon the Northern States due to groundwater depletion.
- The Chhattisgarh government has deposited over 22.12 LMT of quality rice in the Central Pool. This includes 12.11 LMT deposited in the FCI and 10 LMT in the Civil Supplies Corporation. The paddy procurement was followed by lifting for custom milling at a rapid pace across the state. A total of 79.82 LMT of paddy have been lifted by the millers till 21st February. The millers have lifted 59.12 LMT from the procurement centres. This year, a target has been set to deposit 61.65 LMT of Arva rice in the Central pool.
- In Bangladesh, despite good stocks of rice available, the prices are increasing. The food stock has reached a record 20 LMT and all the warehouses are full with rice and wheat. As of 9th February, the stocks of rice available with the government is 16.94 LMT and 0.49 LMT of paddy. The secure food stock of the country is 10 LMT but the food stocks have already crossed 20 LMT mark. Last year, the rice stocks available was 5.37 LMT way below the secure stocks which has led to huge price inflation. Despite satisfactory number of stocks and good yield of rabi and record production during kharif, the prices have risen. The government is strengthening the OMS activity to stabilize the price in the market.
- During the Gulfood that occurred in Dubai during 13th to 17th, around 1 LMT order was received for basmati white sella rice. The demand for 1121 white sella rice was also high. In coming days, good demand from Middle-East countries is expected which would support the rice market. It is highly unlikely that the rice market would weaken in coming days.
- Paddy arrivals in various mandis include, 3,000 bags in Raisen mandi, 10,000 bags in Kota mandi, 2,000 bags in Khair mandi. In Jahangirabad mandi, 10,000 bags have arrived and 10,000 bags in Kaithal mandi. In Kotkapura, 1200 bags have arrived, 2000 bags have arrived in Sirsa mandi.
- In Sri Lanka, during the ongoing maha paddy season, the government has purchased 50,000 MT of paddy from the farmers and intended to purchase around 3,00,000 MT of paddy. The country is

undergoing a major inflation issue due to lower production owing to country's policy for organic farming.

- As per trade source estimates, 42,000 MT of rice vessel MARVEL is loading at Kakinada Port since 19th February 2022. And 4,500 MT of rice vessel CAPT KHALDOUN is loading at Kandla Port since 19th February 2022. And 48,000 MT of rice vessel ACHILLEAS S is loading at Kakinada Port since 15th February 2022. And 42,000 MT of rice vessel ATHENA is loading at Kakinada Port since 13th February 2022. And 43,000 MT of rice vessel GENCO MARY is loading at Kakinada port since 15th February 2022. And 55,495 MT of rice vessel LIBERTY is loading at Kakianda Port since 12th February 2022. And 40,000 MT of rice vessel SEABOSS is loading at Kakinada since 10th February 2022. And 5,750 MT of rice vessel BEEK6 is loading at Kandla since 12th February 2022. And 50,000 MT of rice vessel GALINI is loading at Kandla Port since 13th February 2022. And 27,600 MT of rice vessel SUN BULK is loading at Kandla Port since 13th February 2022. And 40,000 MT of rice vessel BOZBURUN M is loading at Kakinada Port since 04th February 2022. And 50,000 MT of rice vessel CL CENTURY is loading at Kakinada Port since 01st February 2022. Also 11,000 MT of rice vessel TEACHER O is waiting for loading at Kakinada Port since 14th February 2022. And 23,000 MT of rice vessel DMC JUPITER is loading at Kandla Port since 19th February 2022. And 27,000 MT of rice vessel HALIT YILDIRIM is loading at Kandla Port since 19th February 2022. And 30,000 MT of rice vessel SINCERE is waiting for loading at Kandla Port since 06th February 2022. And 50,2000 MT of rice vessel PARVRAJ is loading at Krishnapatnam Port since 06th February 2022.
