

Domestic & International Market Highlights:

- Demand for rice from India has improved, but prices of 5% broken parboiled variety were unchanged at \$370-\$376 per tonne as the rupee weakened, leading to higher margins for traders from overseas sales. Demand for broken rice has improved as prices of corn are rising. Some buyers are looking for alternatives to corn.
- The Indian white rice market remains neutral in most cases as the Ukraine and Russia crisis has led to more uncertainty in the shipping line. The 100% broken rice remains flat to slightly bullish for near term. There is huge demand from all international markets and specially from Africa which can put pressure on the prices and we expect it to trade with firm trend for near future.
- In Tiruvarur district of Tamil Nadu, around 3.58 LMT of paddy has been procured from 500 DPC which was started from January 10th. The procurement is still going. Payment of Rs. 651.71 crore has been paid to 73,672 farmers through their bank accounts. Around 22 paddy storage facilities are available in the district and 1.12 LMT of paddy has been stored.
- In Vietnam the prices of rice rose this week as the trade routes to China has opened completely and many traders expect additional demand from buyers looking for alternate sources due to Ukraine and Russia crisis. Vietnam's 5% broken rice were offered at \$400 per tonne compared to \$395-\$400 a week ago. The ongoing Ukrainian war might prompt buyers to import more rice from Asia, including Vietnam.
- The prices of Thailand's 5% broken rice increased slightly to \$403-\$400 per tonne from \$400 last week, as there were currency fluctuations with the baht valued at 32.60 against the U.S. dollar. The Ukrainian crisis has increased the freight rates but many think that it hasn't impacted Thailand's export demand as neither Ukraine nor Russia were a main buyer of rice from Thailand.
- In Sri Lanka, the maha season harvesting is ongoing and will continue till March end. This year the planting area is estimated to be above average due to high prices and favorable climatic condition. However, due to shortage of chemical fertilizers resulting in lower application of it leads to lower yield this time. The aggregate rice production for 2021 is estimated to be 5.15 MMT which is almost similar to previous year's production of 5.12 MMT despite higher planting.
- In the first one and half months of the year, Vietnam has exported nearly 6.48 LMT of rice worth nearly US\$314 million, up by 36.2% in volume and 19.6% in value year-on-year. In January, the largest rice importer of Vietnam was the Philippines, with over 2.34 LMT of exports valued at US\$110 million. This was followed by Ivory Coast with nearly 0.60 LMT and China with 0.37 LMT. According to the Vietnam Food Association (VFA), Vietnam's rice exports this year were expected to reach 6-6.2 million tons, equivalent to the volume in 2020 and 2021 due to the increasing global rice demand.

- The yield of 1509 and 1121 varieties of basmati rice turned out to be around 12-13 quintal per hectare. The average yield of 1121 and 1509 varieties are respectively 24 quintal and 26 quintal per acre. They contribute around 70 percent of the total exports of Indian aromatic rice. During 2010-2019, annually, Basmati rice was grown in 18.34 lakh hectares on an average, out of which 1121 and 1509 was grown in 67% and 10% of the area, respectively.
- The CIF for 25% broken rice to Benin is \$440 per tonne and \$395 per tonne for Madagascar. The CIF for 100% broken rice includes \$388 per tonne for Djibouti and \$520 per tonne for Sierra Leone. The CIF for 5% broken rice to Benin is \$480 per tonne, \$462 per tonne to Djibouti, \$498 per tonne to Gambia and \$475 per tonne to Togo.
- In Mirzapur district, the farmers of the district have benefited a lot due to the extension of the time limit for buying paddy from the government. Till 01st March, 1.84 LMT of paddy has been purchased in the district. At the same time, the target of procurement of paddy this year was fixed at 1.80 LMT from the government. Around 102.30 percent of the target has been procured. Also, 95.61 percent farmers have also been paid the price of paddy purchased. But due to bad weather and other reasons, paddy could not be procured as per the target. On February 26, the state government extended the deadline for procurement of paddy to March 7.
- Cambodia exported nearly 2.073 MMT of agricultural products in the first two months of 2022, up by over 6.4 percent year-on-year from more than 1.947 MMT. Milled rice accounted for 1.03 LMT, surging by 0.27 LMT (35.21 percent) year-on-year, while paddy clocked in at 6.51 LMT, climbing by 0.92 LMT (16.47 percent) year-on-year.
- As per trade source estimates, 6,601 MT of rice vessel is loading at BMC ALPHA at Kakinada Port since 28th February 2022. And 50,000 MT of rice vessel CL CENTURY is loading at Kakinada Port since 01st March 2022. And 10,000 MT of rice vessel DOCTOR O is loading at Kandla Port since 02nd March 2022. And 11,000 MT of rice vessel TEACHER O is loading at Kandla Port since 28th February 2022. And 9,000 MT of rice vessel DELLA is loading at Mundra Port since 01st March. And 41,000 MT of rice vessel KEN COLON is loading at Kandla Port since 01st March 2022. And 30,000 MT of rice vessel MARYLAKI is loading at Kakinada Port since 01st March 2022.
