

#### **Domestic & International Market Highlights:**

- 100% broken rice stocks are increasing with the new crop arrivals but the market remains muted as the buyers are staying away from the market for near term.
- As of 11<sup>th</sup> April 2022, the procurement of paddy stood at 752.68 LMT under KMS 2021-22. The procurement of rice stood at 505.50 LMT
- In Sri Lanka, the rice production fell by 13.9% for the period between 2020-21 and the average yield per hectare fell by 14.4%. The fall in yield and production is due to ban of inorganic fertilizers by the Sri Lankan government to support organic farming. The imports of rice by Sri Lanka is expected to rise from India as there is economic crisis and low production. And today 11,000 MT of rice from India has reached Sri Lankan Port, this is in addition to 16,000 MT of rice sent last week.
- Odisha government is urging center to allocate 100% rice against current 86% under NFSA scheme as Odisha is a large rice dependent state.
- India's rice activities have increased to West African countries, though the overall markets remain
  flat as traders expects lower prices in coming few weeks as the new crop arrivals will peak in
  Southern parts of India. For East African countries, the market demand remains normal to high.
- The basmati rice market start seeing upward trend again after downward trend for last few days.
   The sella rice prices have gained Rs.200-300 per quintal though steam rice prices still remain steady. As per trade sources, there is demand for basmati rice from Iran as a result good buying strength is seen.
- Iran and Pakistan have reached an agreement to use bilateral barter trade. This will help Pakistan with good exports of basmati rice to Iran. And this would also reduce the rice exports from India to Pakistan.
- Though India's agriculture exports have crossed over \$50 billion for FY 2022, the basmati exports have fallen for the third consecutive years. For 2021-22 FY, the basmati rice exports were \$3.53 billion, which lowest since 2019-20. The fall in exports id largely due to loss of Iran market, fungicide issue in Europe and drop in acreage. Our expectations are that the exports from Iran will continue to rise as sanctions have been removed, though the stocks available is still limited.
- As per trade sources, 54,400 MT of rice vessel PEACE is loading at Kakinada Port since 09<sup>th</sup> April 2022. And 39,200 MT of rice vessel IONIC STORM is loading at Kakinada Port since 05th April 2022. And 31,000 MT of NORD MAGGELLAN is loading at Kakinada Port since 29th March 2022. And 25,500 MT of rice vessel TRUE HARMONY is loading at Kakinada Port since 03rd April 2022. And



41,000 MT of rice vessel GLOBE CLEOPATRA was expected to arrive at Kakinada Port on 09th April 2022. And 12,500 MT of rice vessel ABDULLATIF is loading at Kandla Port since 03rd April 2022.


