

Domestic & International Market Highlights:

- It is expected that Basmati rice market to trade firm in coming days. As Ramzan is going to end in coming few weeks, the demand from middle East countries is increasing. Iran and Yemen is increasing supply from India. Order from Iran for \$1250 per tonne is supporting the basmati market currently and Yemen is in talks to purchase 400,000 MT of basmati rice.
- India's 5% broken rice was quoted at \$364 to \$368 per tonne, down from last week's \$365-\$369 due to weak rupee and high supplies after extension of free grain supply to poor people.
 Supplies are rising from milling of the new season crop and the government releasing last year's harvest.
- Vietnam's 5% broken rice prices were offered at \$420-\$425 per tonne, against \$400-\$415 last week. Prices rose due to the general inflation situation in the world, especially food prices. And farmers have to pay more for fertilisers and pesticides. The trading activity remains quiet and the winter-spring harvest in the Mekong is expected to be completed by month-end.
- Thailand's 5% broken rice prices were unchanged at \$408-\$412 per tonne, as the market was closed for Songkran, the traditional New Year holiday.
- In the first quarter of 2022, Vietnam exported 1.14 MMT of rice worth 715 million USD up by 24% on volume and 10.5% on year on year. Large exports happened to Philippines. Since the EU-Vietnam trade agreement, the export prices of Vietnam have increased by 10-20 USD per tonne.
- The fertilizer prices are increasing on higher side. The urea fertilizer was up by 14% compared to March month prices. The average global prices of urea is trading at \$1031 per tonne which is all time high. DAP prices were 13% higher compared to March month and average prices are trading at \$1040 per tonne. The MAP prices were 11% expensive compared to previous month and average prices trading at \$1056 per tonne. As fertilizer prices are n higher side, most farmers are exempting fertilizer usage leading to lower yield. We also expect the sowing area in coming days to go down due to surging prices.
- IMD has released latest report suggesting normal monsoon to be expected in the coming season. This also suggest that rice crop to be benefitted from the normal rainfalls. If the acreage remains same compared to previous year, we can expect higher yield and production for 2022-23 MY.
- In several districts of Andhra Pradesh, the arrivals of rabi paddy have started. In Godavari region, government is targeting to procure 9.8 LMT. In Kakinada, 6.69 LMT of paddy is expected to arrive.
- In Khammam district of Telangana, procurement of paddy has started from 14th April in 236 centers while in Nizamabad district the procurement started in 457 centres.



- In Tamil Nadu, the production of rice for 2021-22 is estimated at 80.2 LMT which is 16.1 LMT higher than the 6-year average. The increase in production of rice is due to good amount of water released through Cauvery delta and mettur dam.
- As of 11th April 2022, the procurement of paddy stood at 752.68 LMT under KMS 2021-22. The procurement of rice stood at 505.50 LMT


