

**Domestic & International Market Highlights:**

- Andhra Pradesh is planning to improve its export policy for better export potential of various commodities including Rice. The state is planning to develop three major ports to increase cargo handling capacity. From overall exports, 4.6% of the exports was for rice. Currently, Vizag, Kakinada and Krishnapatnam ports are the major ports in Andhra Pradesh.
- China has significantly increased the grain exports on monthly basis on April, as more countries has restricted food exports. Grain exports totaled 312,000 MT in April, up by 97.4 percent month-on-month. From January to April, grain exports totaled 916,000 MT.
- USDA has estimate record production for at record 515 MMT which is 2 MMT greater than previous year as larger crop in South and South East Asia including India, Indonesia, Bangladesh, Thailand and Pakistan. Global consumption is also expected to rise due to increase in consumption from India, China and Sub-Saharan countries.
- India's 5% broken rice was quoted at \$357 to \$361 per tonne FOB, which is down from last week's \$363-\$367, as the rupee touched a record low versus the dollar. Falling rupee is helping exporters to lower prices. Across all the parts, the demand for Indian rice is firm.
- Vietnam's 5% broken rice was quoted at \$415-\$420 per tonne FOB against \$420 a week ago. Trading activity is weak due to tight domestic supplies, but is expected to pick up from June with anticipated high demand from the Philippines, Africa, China and Bangladesh. Vietnam's rice exports are estimated at 6.0-6.2 MMT this year, compared to 6.24 MMT last year.
- Thailand's 5% broken rice prices rose to \$450 per tonne FOB from \$432-\$435 last week. There continues to be demand from Iraq and Iran which are buying in bulk with their own ships, driving prices up. Also contributing to rising prices, supplies have begun to gradually decrease.
- Due to the new regime of fixing the exchange rate in Myanmar is impacting the competitiveness of Myanmar rice. The orders from international market started becoming low. In January, exports of rice (including broken rice) hit 260,000 MT. Due to increase in prices, the 5 percent broken rice, which exporters in Pakistan are selling for \$350 per metric tonne, Myanmar exporters are offering \$370 to \$380 a tonne, up from \$330 to \$335 a tonne at the start of this year.
- As per sources, basmati rice exports for the month of March stood at 4.60 LMT while for non-basmati rice, the exports stood at 16.44 LMT.
- Thailand's organic rice is trying to cover markets in ASEAN countries. Currently USA, Hong Kong, Italy, Vietnam and China are major importers of organic rice from Thailand.

- As per sources, Cambodia has exported 221,138 MT of milled rice and 1,648,474 MT of un-milled rice, with a total value of \$516.21 million in the first four months of 2022. Cambodia has exported to 54 destinations of which Cambodia exported 115,255 MT or 52.12 %, worth \$62.74 million to China and Hong Kong. And exported 68,555 MT, or 31 percent, valued at \$51 million to Europe. The export to ASEAN countries amounted to 21,876 MT or 9.89 percent, with a value of \$13.90 million. The exports to other countries were valued at \$11.74 million, representing 15,452 MT or a share of 6.99 percent. Exports of all types of fragrant rice were 67.12 percent, white rice (30.13 percent), steamed rice (1.07 percent) and organic rice (1.68 percent).
- Taiwan's contribution for supply of rice for humanitarian purpose has increased by 150% from 22,000 MT to 33,000 MT. The rising donation for of rice for humanitarian purpose indicates highly increasing global poverty and worsening grain supply.
