

Domestic & International Market Highlights:

- Like Punjab, Haryana has also decided to provide incentive of Rs. 4000 per acre to the farmers who will cultivate paddy by DSR method. The DSR method is likely to reduce the input cost increasing the farmer's return.
- International rice was trading last week with focus on supply demand report from USDA. The rice market's reaction to the May WASDE was favourable. As anticipated, long-grain ending stocks are expected to tighten in the 2022 marketing year.
- For the coming kharif season, the paddy acreage is likely to fall as cotton cultivation and red gram cultivation is likely to increase. Paddy sowing is likely to cross 50 lakh acres.
- Telangana has purchased 10.6 LMT of paddy against the target of 37 LMT. Most of the paddy has been cultivated in the Godavari delta region.
- Currently rice is trading at two years high globally due to strong demand from Asian markets. Rice prices have risen by 29 percent on a year-on-year basis and they are up 6 percent monthly and 3 percent weekly. The expectation of record production and higher consumption in 2022-2023 is also supporting the prices apart from the shift in focus to rice amid a shortage in wheat.
- After In Thailand, rice exporters are concerned about the shipment prospects in the second quarter, as there is a sharp rise in domestic prices. It is estimated that 5% white rice prices in the domestic market have risen by 25% to 15 baht per kilogram, up from 12 baht per kg at the beginning of this year, driven by high import demand, particularly from Iraq.
- Thailand has shipped 6.11 MMT of rice last year, up by 6.68% from 5.73 MMT in 2020, with exports Eid and Ramzan, the basmati rice start seeing an upward trend as the wedding season has started and demand from Iran and other middle east countries has increased. Also, the government has banned wheat exports. Earlier, the wheat exports were impacting the rice exports as most of the vessels and rakes were imposed for wheat. But with the export ban decision, we are expecting the prices to trade firm in coming days
- Andhra Pradesh is planning to improve its export policy for better export potential of various commodities including Rice. The state is planning to develop three major ports to increase cargo handling capacity. From overall exports, 4.6% of the exports was for rice. Currently, Vizag, Kakinada and Krishnapatnam ports are the major ports in Andhra Pradesh.
- China has significantly increased the grain exports on monthly basis on April, as more countries has restricted food exports. Grain exports totalled 312,000 MT in April, up by 97.4 percent month-on-month. From January to April, grain exports totalled 916,000 MT.

- USDA has estimate record production for at record 515 MMT which is 2 MMT greater than previous year as larger crop in South and South East Asia including India, Indonesia, Bangladesh, Thailand and Pakistan. Global consumption is also expected to rise due to increase in consumption from India, China and Sub-Saharan countries.
