

Domestic Market Highlights:

- Almost steady to mix sentiment was noticed in major spot markets during the day.
- As per the sources Paddy growing in the state of Kerala lags behind and crop cycle of Paddy happens to be getting disturbed during upcoming Kharif season, on the account of Southwest monsoon showers. This might give rise to the condition leading to reduced Rice yield in the region.
- Sources reveal that Manipur government is looking forward to procure Paddy during upcoming season to fulfil the requirement of National Food Security Act (NFSA). Concerned authorities as of now plans on procuring paddy from district officers and women stake holders.
- According to the sources India marked a decline in Rice area cover till date as compared to previous year sowing for same time period, on the account of deficit monsoon. As of now Rice has covered 8.73 lakh Ha of area compared to 12.52 lakh Ha in previous year, which is approximately 30.32 % less than last year.
- Sources say that in current year till date Telangana government has procured 55 million tonnes of paddy accounting for the value around 9,726 Crore Rupees against the 14.1 million tonnes of paddy procurement in past year, which valued around 26,610 Crore Rupees.
- As per the sources, area cultivation under paddy in Godavari Delta region of A.P is expected to decline on the account of delayed irrigation water supply through canals and as the result production of paddy in area is expected to decline by 12.50 lakh bags. Also in Odisha on the account of delayed and patchy monsoon showers paddy sowing seems to be declining, in Odisha as of now 16,000 hectares of area has been covered under paddy against 51,365 ha during the corresponding period last year.
- In order to curb the depletion of ground water levels and reduce power usage, Punjab government is trying to diversify crops where around 1 Mha of paddy grown areas would be gradually shifted to cotton, maize, oilseeds and pulses over next five years.

Domestic Market Outlook (Non-Basmati):

- Foreseeing on going sluggish domestic demand and restrained exports on the account of container shortage (even after fair export demand), it is expected that domestic prices would remain range bound in near term as per existing scenario.

International Market Highlights:

- According to sources there has been a cut down in Rice Bran Oil production or complete closure of the production amongst various Rice Bran oil industries in Bangladesh, after export ban by the Bangladesh government. This might lead to the reduction in Indian Broken Rice exports to Bangladesh and no imports of Rice Bran oil in India from the end of Bangladesh.
- Sri Lanka has decided to 50,000 MT of rice under Indian loan program. There is an economic crisis which is going in Sri Lanka as a result their dependency on rice has increased. India is a major source of rice for Sri Lanka.
- Thailand's 5% broken rice prices fell to \$430-\$440 per tonne from \$450-\$460 last week. The prices have dropped because the baht was weaker, and will fluctuate along with the exchange rate as demand dropped. The baht hit a more than five-year trough this week, translating into weaker export prices in U.S. dollar terms.

Indian Weather/ Monsoon Highlights:

- Monsoon has advance into more parts of Gujarat, far southern Madhya Pradesh and far southern Odisha. Currently conditions are favourable for advance into more of Odisha and parts of West Bengal in next couple of days.
