

Domestic Market Highlights:

- Mixed sentiment was noticed in major spot markets during the day.
- As per the official sources in Andhra Pradesh till date Paddy has been sown in 0.90 Lakh Ha of area against 1.14 Lakh Ha of area last year for corresponding time period. Nellore, Chittoor, East Godavari and West Godavari are leading districts till date in terms of area sown under Paddy crop in the state.
- As per the official sources in Telangana till date Paddy has been sown in 13,116 acers of area against 2,30,955 acers of area last year for corresponding time period. Maximum sowing has been done in the Nizamabad, Karimnagar and Medak districts of the state. Rainfall in the state has been good and 84.5 mm rainfall has been received against the normal of 41.9 mm till now.
- As per the latest update of Agriculture department, Gol, India marked a decline in Rice area coverage till 1st July 22 as compared to same period last year due to deficit and uneven distribution of monsoon rains over key states. Till last week Rice has been sown in 43.44 lakh Ha. compared to 59.55 lakh Ha. same period last year, which is approximately 27.04 % less. As per the report, largest area coverage under paddy was in Punjab at around 15.75 Lakh hectares as compared to 23.77 Lakh hectares during same period last year, followed by U.P with area coverage of around 5.47 Lakh hectares under paddy against total area coverage of around 4.82 Lakh hectares in 2021 for corresponding period last year.
- Export price of 5% Broken Parboiled Indian Rice were reported at \$355 -\$360 per tonne which happens to be same as that during last week, on the account of continued weak Rupee value against dollar, attracting foreign buyers towards Indian Rice as compared to that of its competitors like Thailand and Vietnam.
- Overall according to the sources a good export demand of 25 % and 100 % Broken White Rice variety was noticed, reason being lower prices of Indian Rice due to weak Rupee value against Dollar.
- As per the official sources in Andhra Pradesh till date Paddy has been sown in 0.45 lakh hectare of area against 0.79 lakh hectare of area last year for corresponding time period.
- As per the sources according to current monsoon circumstances it is expected that in Bihar Paddy transplanting would be completed by 15th July 2022.
- As of 26th June, the Centre has procured 860.82 lakh tonne (LMT) of paddy in the ongoing 2021-22 marketing year so far at the minimum support price (MSP). Till now, about 125.82 lakh farmers have been benefited with the MSP value.
- As per the sources All India Rice Exporters' Association has stated that around 9,14,000 tonne of Rice has been exported till now under ongoing 2021-22 season from India to Bangladesh against the exports of 4,91,000 tonne during last 2020-2021 for the corresponding time period. This demand was mainly after Bangladesh reduced import duty on Rice due to floods hitting the country.



Domestic Market Outlook (Non-Basmati):

• Foreseeing on going domestic and international demand, with little arrivals it is expected that domestic prices would remain range bound in near term as per existing scenario.

International Market Highlights:

- As per the sources during July 21-May 22 Pakistan exported around 4.4 MMT of Rice worth around \$2,276 Million, which happens to be 33 % more than as compared to previous year for same time period.
- As per the sources Myanmar exported around 322,650 MT of Rice in first three months of 2022-23 Fiscal year, which included 227,890 MT of Broken Rice. Out of these numbers 83,926 MT of rice was exported during June-22 out of which 62,168 MT of broken rice was exported to countries like China, the Philippines, Belgium and France. Whereas, during May-22 and April-22 58,815 MT of rice and 144,030 MT of Rice was exported respectively by Myanmar.
- Sources state that Malaysia has uplifted the ban on importing Rice flour from Thailand and would permit Thailand to export Rice flour to Western parts of the country. The ban was imposed before 20 years which now has been uplifted. Also sources say that in first five months of this year Rice and other Rice products exports of Thailand rose by around 12.5 percentage.
- As per the sources Thailand's 5% broken rice prices saw a decline for the consecutive week and fell to \$412-\$415 per tonne from \$420-\$425 last week, as the reaction towards good yield expectation of upcoming crop.
- Sources state that Vietnam's 5% broken rice prices were noted at\$415-\$420 per tonne compared to \$418-\$423 in past week due to supply pressure being created by harvesting of summer-autumn crop.
- Sources point towards 3.5 million tonne of Rice exports from Vietnam during the span of January to June 2022, which happens to be 16.2% more than that of last year for same time period, with the estimated increase of around 4.6 % in Value of the exports compared to that of last year for same time period.
- Sources say that around 14,700 MT of Rice as the part of humanitarian aid has been received at Colombo from the side of India.

Indian Weather/ Monsoon Highlights:

• As per the latest update so far ongoing monsoon has covered the entire Northern states and NCR part of the country, including most of the parts of Bihar. The monsoon showers have covered maximum parts of central and eastern parts of the country.
