

Domestic Market Highlights:

- Steady to Range bound sentiment was noticed in major spot markets during the day.
- According to trade sources, Golden Sella (1121) at Naaya Baazar, Delhi traded at Rs. 8,900 per quintal during the day.
- According to sources prices of common Rice variety (Swarna) has increased in domestic market of India this year by around Rs. 2 per kg to Rs. 25-27 per kg this year as compared to Rs. 23-25 per kg during last year. A rise in the prices of premium minikiet variety was also seen by around Rs. 3-5 per kg to Rs 41-42 per kg as compared to last year's price of Rs. 37-38 per kg. This surge in the prices is mainly due to robust exports of Indian Rice to Bangladesh.
- As per the official sources in Andhra Pradesh till date Paddy has been sown in 3,01,971 hectares of area against 3,70,271 hectares of area last year for corresponding time period. Nellore, Chittoor, East Godavari, Eluru and West Godavari are leading districts till date in terms of area sown under Paddy crop in the state.
- As per the official sources in Telangana till date Paddy has been sown in 6,48,881 acres of area against 12,71,580 acres of area last year for corresponding time period. Maximum sowing has been done in the Nizamabad, Karimnagar, Mehabubnagar and Medak districts of the state.
- Sources say that after shortage of Rice in Bangladesh along with lower stocks of Wheat till now during 2021-2022 year 16.23 lakh tonnes of Non-Basmati Rice has been exported to Bangladesh as compared to just 9.11 lakh tonnes in 2020-2021 for same time duration. These exports have led to rise in Rice prices across the country by rose by 10-15 % during past one month.
- Chances of Indian government banning Rice exports seems to be low due to sufficient buffer stocks with government. According to sources till 1st July 2022 government godowns kept Rice buffer stocks of around 47.2 million tonnes, which happens to be 3.5 times more than normal Rice buffer norms for the quarter.
- According to sources on the fear of rice price to increase by Rs. 3 – Rs. 5 per Kg in Tamil Nadu after implementation of 5 % GST on essential food commodities, Rice mill owner associations of state has filed petition to exclude state from this GST charges. They backed their petition saying state is not bound to follow GST recommendations as per the Supreme Court rulings.
- According to GOI's latest data India marked a decline in Rice area coverage till 15th July 22 as compared to same period last year. Till date Rice has been sown in 128.50 lakh Ha. Of area compared to 155.53 lakh Ha, approximately 17 % less compared to last year for same time period. As per the latest Kharif 2022 Sowing Report, largest area coverage under paddy was in Punjab at around 27.80 Lakh hectares as compared to 29.47 Lakh hectares during same period last year.
- As per the latest updates export price of Indian Rice is around \$ 320 per tonne to various international Rice markets as compared to the export price of \$ 420 per tonne for Thailand and Vietnam sourced Rice for same destinations. As per the estimates Thailand as well as Vietnam Rice crop yield is expected to decline in upcoming season.

Domestic Market Outlook (Non-Basmati):

- Foreseeing on going domestic and international demand, with little arrivals it is expected that domestic prices would remain range bound to firm in near term as per existing scenario.

International Market Highlights

- As per the sources Cambodia has exported 17.4 % more milled Rice to China as compared to previous year which was around 168,280 tons of milled rice. Also as per the sources during first half of this year 3,27,200 tonnes of milled Rice has been exported by Southeast Asian Countries to 51 countries around the world which also happens to be 16.6 % more than previous year.
- Sources point towards 2.06 million tonne of milled and Paddy Rice exports from Cambodia during the span of January to June 2022, which happens to be 19.18% more than that of last year for same time period, with the estimated value of around \$ 616 million. Out of which 1,733,157 tonne of Paddy with the value of around \$336,232,458 was exported to Vietnam.
- As per the sources, Myanmar's export price for broken rice to China rose by around 9 % 120 yuan for 50-kg broken rice bag in Muse, which was around 110 yuan for 50-kg broken rice bag in Muse in May. This hike was seen after Myanmar's truck and drivers were allowed to enter at China's side.
- Sources state that Vietnam's 5% broken rice prices were noted at \$415-\$420 per tonne which happens to be unchanged from past week due to supply pressure being created by harvesting of summer-autumn crop, also ongoing Ukraine-Russia conflict is expected to maintain the international demand of Vietnamese Rice.
- As per the sources Thailand's 5% broken rice prices saw a hike over past week after decline for two consecutive week. Prices rose to \$420 per tonne from \$412-\$415 last week, as the reaction towards good demand of Thai Rice in the international market.
- As per the sources during July 21-May 22 Pakistan exported around 4.4 MMT of Rice worth around \$2,276 Million, which happens to be 33 % more than as compared to previous year for same time period.
- As per the sources Myanmar exported around 322,650 MT of Rice in first three months of 2022-23 Fiscal year, which included 227,890 MT of Broken Rice. Out of these numbers 83,926 MT of rice was exported during June-22 out of which 62,168 MT of broken rice was exported to countries like China, the Philippines, Belgium and France. Whereas, during May-22 and April-22 58,815 MT of rice and 144,030 MT of Rice was exported respectively by Myanmar.
- Sources state that Malaysia has uplifted the ban on importing Rice flour from Thailand and would permit Thailand to export Rice flour to Western parts of the country. The ban was imposed before 20 years which now has been uplifted. Also sources say that in first five months of this year Rice and other Rice products exports of Thailand rose by around 12.5 percentage.

Indian Weather/ Monsoon Highlights:

- As per the latest update so far ongoing monsoon has covered the entire Northern states and NCR part of the country, including most of the parts of Bihar. The monsoon showers have covered maximum parts of central and eastern parts of the country.
