

Domestic Market Highlights:

- Mixed sentiment was noticed in major spot markets during the day.
- According to the latest data of FCI as of 31st July 22, the Centre has procured 878.96 lakh tonne (LMT) of paddy in the ongoing 2021-22 Marketing year so far at the Minimum Support Price (MSP). Till now, about 130.25 lakh farmers have been benefited with the MSP value.
- According to GOI's latest data India marked a decline in Rice area coverage by 17% till 15thJuly 22 as compared to same period last year. Till July 29th, Rice has been sown in 231.59 lakh Ha. of area compared to 267.05 lakh Ha, down by approximately 13% compared same period last year. Maximum area cover was in the state of U.P with area cover of around 46.58 lakh ha against 53.26 lakh ha during past year for same time period. The reason attributed for lag in paddy sowing is highly deficit rains over West Bengal, Jharkhand, Bihar, Chhattisgarh and Uttar Pradesh. As per the sources there is a suspicion regarding decline in the production output of Rice during upcoming season by around 1.5 million tonnes in upcoming season as the result of deficient and delayed rainfall.
- According to sources Exporters Association of Haryana has filed a plea to government requesting for the reduction in mandi fees along with other assorted fees. Current fees sustains at 6.5 percent.
- Export price of 5% Broken Parboiled Indian Rice were reported at \$362 to \$368 per Tonne same as past week.
- As per the sources there is a suspicion regarding decline in the exports of Rice by around 1.5 million tonnes in upcoming season as the result of deficient and delayed rainfall.
- Sources state that under PMJKY state government of A.P has made an announcement to start free Rice distribution in the state from 1 August 2022.
- According to sources prices of common Rice variety (Swarna) has increased in domestic market of India this year by around Rs. 2 per kg to Rs. 25-27 per kg this year as compared to Rs. 23-25 per kg during last year. A rise in the prices of premium minikiet variety was also seen by around Rs. 3-5 per kg to Rs 41-42 per kg as compared to last year's price of Rs. 37-38 per kg. This surge in the prices is mainly due to robust exports of Indian Rice to Bangladesh.
- As per the official sources in Andhra Pradesh till date Paddy has been sown in 3,01,971 hectares of area against 3,70,271 hectares of area last year for corresponding time period. Nellore, Chittoor, East Godavari, Eluru and West Godavari are leading districts till date in terms of area sown under Paddy crop in the state.
- As per the official sources in Telangana till date Paddy has been sown in 6,48,881 acres of area against 12,71,580 acers of area last year for corresponding time period. Maximum sowing has been done in the Nizamabad, Karimnagar, Mehabubnagar and Medak districts of the state.



Domestic Market Outlook (Non-Basmati):

• Foreseeing on going domestic and international demand, with little arrivals it is expected that domestic prices would remain range bound to firm in near term as per existing scenario.

International Market Highlights

- According to sources Vietnam's Rice exports for the time frame between Jan-July rose by 20% to 4.16 million tonnes as compared to last year. Also Rice export revenue generation rose by around 8.5% to 2.6 billion when compared to previous year.
- As per the sources Thailand's 5% broken rice prices were noted at \$400 per tonne which happens to be lower than last week's prices of \$420 per tonne due to supply pressure.
- Sources state that Vietnam's 5% broken rice prices dropped at \$395-\$413 per tonne which were reported at \$415-\$420 past week due to sluggish exports and arrival pressure of summer-autumn crop.
- As per the sources Pakistan's Rice export for fiscal year 2021-2022 have surged by around 32 % to 4.877 million tonnes as compared to the exports of 3.684 million tonnes for the fiscal year 2020-2021. Main reason behind this rise was hike of around 6 % in the area sown under Paddy in Pakistan as compared to previous year. Rice production in Pakistan also saw an increase of around 10.7 % during 2021-22 as compared to previous year.
- As per the sources Cambodia has exported 17.4 % more milled Rice to China as compared to previous year which was around 168,280 tons of milled rice . Also as per the sources during first half of this year 3,27,200 tonnes of milled Rice has been exported by Southeast Asian Countries to 51 countries around the world which also happens to be 16.6 % more than previous year.
- Sources point towards 2.06 million tonne of milled and Paddy Rice exports from Cambodia during the span of January to June 2022, which happens to be 19.18% more than that of last year for same time period, with the estimated value of around \$ 616 million. Out of which 1,733,157 tonne of Paddy with the value of around \$336,232,458 was exported to Vietnam.

Indian Weather/ Monsoon Highlights:

- As per the latest update so far ongoing monsoon has covered the entire Northern states and NCR part of the country, including most of the parts of Bihar. The monsoon showers have covered maximum parts of central and eastern parts of the country.
- Deficit rains in several states of North India, Bihar and Orissa has caused lag in Paddy sowing and transplanting across the country.
