Outlook and Review (Domestic Front)

- Price: Average monthly wholesale monthly rice prices in India stood at around Rs.3317 per quintal in March-2021, up by 5.87% from Rs.3256 per quintal in January-2021 and up by 6.40% from Rs.3115 per quintal a year ago.
- Telangana government to buy entire paddy produced during Rabi season: All the paddy produced during Yasangi (Rabi) season will be procured by the State government through 6,408 purchasing centres, as it was done during the intense COVID-19 pandemic last year. Purchasing centres will operate in villages this year as well. For purchasing the entire Rabi paddy, the State government will give a counter guarantee to the Civil Supplies Corporation for taking a loan of Rs 20,000 crore.
- Kharif Sowing: Kharif paddy sowing has just begun in some states of North-East India and as on 05th April, 2021 paddy area is reported reached to 71,526 hectares which is up by 31.33% from last year same period area of 54,444 hectares.
- Centre paddy procurement for Kharif 2020-21 is continuing smoothly with purchase of over 688.02 LMTs. This is an increase of 13.54 % against last year corresponding purchase of 605.94 LMT. Out of the total purchase of 688.02 LMT, Punjab alone has contributed 202.82 LMT which is 29.47% of total procurement.
- After record exports of around 12 million tonnes (mt) of non-basmati rice during 2020-21, exporters are
 confident of sustaining the trend this fiscal. However, exporters see a slower start to the shipments in current
 fiscal as buyers have turned cautious over the sharp increase in freight rates. As per second advance estimate
 by Agriculture Department of India, Indian rice production in MY-2020-21 is expected to reach to 120 Million
 tonnes which is a record till now.
- Rice procurement for Kharif 2020-21 is continuing smoothly in the procuring States & UTs of Punjab, Haryana,
 Uttar Pradesh, Telangana, Uttarakhand, Tamil Nadu, Chandigarh, Jammu & Kashmir, Kerala, Gujarat, Andhra
 Pradesh, Chhattisgarh, Odisha, Madhya Pradesh, Maharashtra, Bihar, Jharkhand, Assam, Karnataka, West
 Bengal and Tripura with purchase of over 651.07 LMTs of paddy up to 05.04.2021. Out of the total purchase of
 466.92 LMT, Punjab alone has contributed 135.89 LMT.

Weather Watch:

All-India level rainfall during the week, 18 February 2021 to 24 February 2021, has been 54% lower than the Long Period Average (LPA). Among the four broad geographical divisions of the country, against the LPA the rainfall has been:

- Higher by 275% in South Peninsula,
- Higher by 74% in Central India,
- Lower by 97% in North West India,
- Lower by 97% in East & North East India.

With favorable weather condition rabi paddy sowing is running smoothly. Farmers have planted 29.94 lakh hectares area so far against 25.99 lakh hectares same period last year. Except Tamil nadu and Assam acreage under paddy is up in all major rabi growing states.

Rice Production Estimates: Rice production estimate is raised to 119Million tons, based on higher planting and expectation of higher- yields of Kharif rice in India's northern and southern producing states. Field reports suggest that excellent monsoon rains supported the higher planting and improved yield prospects for Kharif rice in MY-2020-21, compared to last year. However, if weather is not conducive at the time of harvest, projections for Kharif production may change.



Fueled by record procurement, government rice stocks on April 1, 2021, were estimated at 50.4 MMT compared to 44.8 MMT at the same time last year, and four times the government's peak buffer stocks (13.5 MMT on April 1). Assuming higher monthly offtake in the remaining marketing season, MY 2020-2021 xgovernment ending stocks are estimated at 29.11 MMT, and private stocks at 3.5 million metric tons. There is no published data on privately held rice stocks, but these reportedly range of 2.0 to 4.0 MMT, depending on the market situation.

India has become the world's leading rice exporter following the government's 2011 removal of its export ban on coarse rice. Rice exports in MY 2020-2021 are estimated at a record 15.5 MMT (11.5 MMT coarse rice and 4 MMT Basmati rice), an increase of 24 percent over the previous year. MY 2020-2021 rice exports during October 2020 to February 2021 are pegged at 7.7 MMT, compared to 4.01 MMT during the same period last year, largely on strong exports of coarse grain rice to the traditional Middle East and African markets.



International Market:

- According to the Minister of Agriculture, 51 Cambodian exporters exported rice to 41 countries around the world
 during the period under review. It consists of 19 European Union countries, China, three ASEAN countries, and 18
 other countries. China was the country's largest buyer, importing over 85 thousand tonnes of rice, accounting for
 55.55 percent of Cambodia's total rice exports.
- The European Union received 35 thousand tons of rice, ASEAN countries received 12 thousand tons, and 18 other
 countries received 21 thousand tons of rice In 2019, China increased its annual rice import quota from Cambodia
 to 4 lakh tonnes.
- According to exporters, the cost of exporting rice in 20-foot containers has risen to \$ 4-5 thousand, up from \$ 800/1000 at the end of 2020. Last year, Cambodia exported 6.91 lakh tonnes of rice, generating \$ 53.90 million in revenue. This year's export was 11.40 percent higher than the previous year.
- Myanmar was expected to trigger some challenges to India in the global rice export market, but there has been tension since the February military takeover, making rice export shipments difficult. Since then, there has been an atmosphere of instability, making rice export shipments difficult. Total rice exports from India (normal + basmati) are expected to reach a new high of 150-160 lakh tonnes in the 2020-21 fiscal year (April-March).

Reflecting bigger crops in exporters, global rice production in 2020/21 is forecast 1% higher y/y, at a peak of 504m t. Including an expansion of feed use, uptake in China is seen edging up as world consumption rises further, while inventories are expected to be little-changed y/y. With firmer buying from importers in Asia and Africa, trade is anticipated to rise by 4% y/y in 2021. Outlooks for 2021/22 remain tentative, yet bigger sowings in Asia could boost global production, with total use and stocks also projected at new peaks. Trade in 2022 is predicted to stay high on African demand.
