

Rice Monthly Research Report

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Outlook and Review (Domestic Front)

- Price: Average monthly wholesale monthly rice prices in India stood at around Rs. 3268 per quintal in June-2021, down by 1.92% from Rs. 3332 per quintal in May-2021 and down by 5.76% from Rs. 3493 per quintal a year ago.
- Lack of buyer in the local market; demand in all types of coarse rice has come to a standstill, due to which goods are being sold at their respective prices in the mandis.
- The reality is that the rice that is being given to the ration shops for distribution, it is discussed that 50% of the quota holders are selling it to the mandis. The rest of the goods have also started selling back in the mandis due to lack of consumption from the consumers, due to which the market is running slow.
- The two-week stagnation in the southwest monsoon has pushed the area under kharif crops in Maharashtra to 30 per cent behind the five-year average. But now the sowing speed is expected to pick up due to the revival of monsoon activity. The area under Kharif crops in Maharashtra has reached 106 lakh hectares, which is much less than the normal average area of 151 lakh hectares. The sowing of cereal crops has reached only 53 percent. In view of the inactive monsoon, the Agriculture Department had suggested the farmers to postpone the sowing of Kharif crops for some time. Now the rains have started again, so the speed of sowing will also increase. As of July 12, the area under paddy in Maharashtra has reached 2.90 lakh hectares, which is far behind the normal average level of 14.90 lakh hectares.
- Lifting 15.30 lakh tonnes of food grains by the states under the free ration distribution scheme: So far 15.30 lakh tonnes of food grains have been lifted from government godowns for the fourth phase by 31 states & union territories (UTs) of the country for free distribution under the centrally sponsored Pradhan Mantri Garib Kalyan Anna Yojana. It is to be known that this scheme was started in April 2020 and its first phase was till June 2020. The second phase started during July to November 2020. After a gap of few months, the third phase was held in May-June 2021 while now the fourth phase is going on from July to November 2021. A total of 78.26 lakh tonnes of food grains were lifted by all the 36 states and UTs during the third phase. Food Corporation of India (FCI) has loaded food grains in 4005 railway rakes and transported them to different states from 1st April 2021 till now. It is to be known that under this scheme, 5 kg of food grains (rice or wheat) are provided free of cost to the poor people per month, which is different from the ration they get regularly. The government has allocated 198.79 lakh tonnes of food grains under the free distribution scheme for the period July-November 2021.
- On the other hand, rice of 1509 and 1121 varieties are not being raised due to lack of export in Basmati variety of rice, while there is no availability of paddy.
- Punjab government has received a sum of Rs 235 crore from the Centre for management of paddy stubble ahead of the harvest season set to begin in October. The state agriculture department plans to provide crop residue management (CRM) machines to farmers at subsidised rates with the funds received from the Centre. We had planned to give 40,000 machines on subsidy but there is a dearth of funds, we have cut down the number to 25,000.



- India rice exports to China are expected to soar threefold this year going by a spike in orders from the neighboring country for non-basmati broken rice, which they use in making noodles and wine.
- In FY21, China had started sending import queries from November; but in the current fiscal, we are seeing that the country has become active from the very beginning, and they are placing substantial orders with the Indian rice companies.

Weather Watch:

All-India level rainfall cumulative rainfall during Monsoon season, 01 June 2021 to 07 July 2021, has been 5% lower than the LPA. Among the four broad geographical divisions, seen against the LPA the rainfall has been: -

- Equal to LPA in South Peninsula,
- Lower by 13% in North West India,
- Lower by 7% in Central India,
- Lower by 02% in East & North East India.

Rice Production Estimates: Rice production estimate is raised to 119Million tons, based on higher planting and expectation of higher- yields of Kharif rice in India's northern and southern producing states. Field reports suggest that excellent monsoon rains supported the higher planting and improved yield prospects for Kharif rice in MY-2020-21, compared to last year. However, if weather is not conducive at the time of harvest, projections for Kharif production may change.

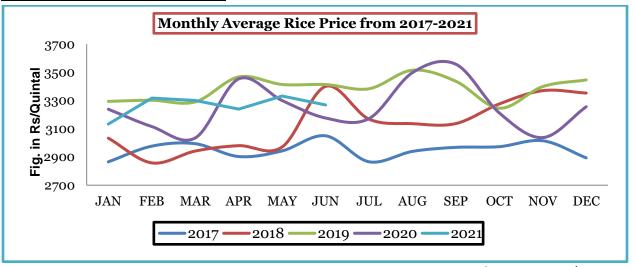

On 1 June, FCI had a stock of 29.92 million tonnes of rice in central pool while buffer norms of 7.6 million tonnes. To reduce the stock, the government approved the purchase of rice for ethanol but distillers retreated due to the current prices. It was believed that about 100 lakh tonnes of rice stock would be reduced from the central pool. The ethanol manufacturers were given a purchase price of Rs 2000 per quintal by the centre. The cost price of rice purchased in 2020-21 has been 2727 rupees, which FCI wanted to sell on 2000. FCI is not willing to sell below 2000 price but this price seems to be high to distiller.

Based on the latest Indian official trade data available from Trade Data Monitor and the Directorate General of Commercial Intelligence, the MY 2019-2020 rice export estimate is marginally raised to a record 12.6 MMT, and CY 2020 exports increased to a record of 14.7 MMT on strong exports continuing since the beginning of CY 2020 based on competitively priced Indian rice outcompeting other origins. Assuming the current price parity for Indian rice in the international market, MY 2020/21 rice exports is forecast to reach 14 MMT on sufficient domestic supplies.

International Market:

- Indian rice export prices hit a nearly 16-month low this week as new supplies come into market but demand remains low, while coronavirus restrictions in Vietnam undercut sales of the staple grain.
- Export demand is weak. Rice supplies have risen after government started distributing rice to poor people.
- Farmers have started harvesting their summer-autumn crop in most of the Mekong Delta area, but sales to traders are slow due to coronavirus movement curbs.
- Traders said domestic unhusked paddy prices may fall over the coming weeks as supplies from the
 harvest build up, while movement curbs are expected to remain in place. Some of the traders have
 stopped buying rice from farmers due to coronavirus.
- Bangladesh has allowed private traders to import 1 million tonnes of rice to tame prices. The country imported 1.3 million tonnes of rice in the year to June, the highest volume in three years.
- Thailand has exported around 1.78 million tonnes of rice between January and May this year, down 31% from the same period a year ago.

Due to bigger harvests in Asia, global **rice** production in 2021/22 is projected to rise by 2% to a fresh high. However, with growth in consumption set to moderate significantly – partly due to the likely scaling-back of COVID-19-related support schemes in Asia – stocks could edge up y/y. Trade in 2022 (Jan/Dec) is anticipated to be little-changed y/y, as a potential reduction in shipments to South Asia is offset by bigger dispatches to Africa. India is set to remain by far the world's leading exporter. Due to an upgraded estimate for India, world **rice** production in 2020/21 is lifted to a record of 504m t (+5m y/y), while total use is raised slightly to reflect increased utilisation of state reserves in leading consumers. The projection for 2021/22 production is marginally higher m/m and, with the increase matched by upgraded use, carryovers are unchanged m/m, at 171m t (+2m). World trade is unchanged m/m, at 47m t, steady y/y.
