

# Rice Monthly Research Report

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#### Outlook and Review (Domestic Front)

- **Price:** Average monthly wholesale monthly rice prices in India stood at around Rs.3239.51 per quintal in August- 2021, up by 1.46% from Rs.3192.74 per quintal in July-2021 and down by 7.18% from Rs.3490.16 per quintal a year ago. The increase in the average price of rice is due to talks of lower crop on account of a likely lower acreage has fuelled an upward trend in the price of rice compared to last month.
- **Procurement:** Government rice procurement as on Sep-05, 2021, is estimated at 889.62 LMT, up by 125.23 LMT from the same period in 2020. Procurement at this pace is surpassing last year's record-breaking MSP procurement of 764.39 Lakhs metric tons. Paddy procurement has reached all time high level, surpassing previous high of 773.45 LMT in KMS 2019-20. This has benefitted 130.47 lakh farmers with the MSP value of Rs. 1,67,960.77 crore.
- Export: Based on reports, India has expanded its record setting rice exports due to high export pace and competitive prices. Vietnam is surprisingly added to India's export list. India's milled rice export to Iraq has also increased by almost 40%. Non-PDS, private-sector rice imports have been rising, and private sector buyers have been attracted to India's competitive prices for basmati. MY 2020-2021 rice export estimate is raised higher to 14.45 million metric tons.
- Stock Position: Till August, FCI had a stock of 291.08 lakh tonnes of rice in central pool while buffer norms of 7.6 million tonnes. To reduce the stock, the government approved the purchase of rice for ethanol but distillers retreated due to the current prices.
- **UP and Haryana Government to start the procurement of rice**: Paddy procurement in Uttar Pradesh will start from October 1 under the Minimum support Price scheme for the year 2021-22. The procurement will continue till January 31, 2022 in western UP and Bundelkhand region while in eastern UP the purchase will start from November 1 to February 28, 2022. Haryana government has decided to start the procurement of paddy from 25<sup>th</sup> September and the procurement will continue till 15<sup>th</sup> November. This year around 200 procurement centres have been set up for paddy procurement by the Haryana government.
- **Punjab set to decrease acreage**: Punjab has set to bring the acreage of rice below 2 million marks which includes both basmati and non basmati rice. The decision came up due to water table that has come up to dark zone in 85% of the agricultural blocks. The area has been diverted to cotton and maize in order to stop overexploitation of ground water.

#### Weather Watch:

Fairly widespread to widespread rainfall activity will likely over Telangana, coastal & north interior Karnataka, Vidarbha and Marathwada on 07<sup>th</sup> September and reduction thereafter and over Madhya Maharashtra, Konkan, Gujarat state during 07<sup>th</sup>-11<sup>th</sup> September. Isolated extensive rainfall is also likely over Madhya Maharashtra & Konkan on 07<sup>th</sup> & 08<sup>th</sup>, Gujarat on 08<sup>th</sup>-09<sup>th</sup> September. Rainfall is likely to continue with fairly widespread to widespread rainfall over most parts of northwest India 11<sup>th</sup> September 2021.

The export quantity of rice is expected to be 14.45 million tonnes, the huge demand from international market and good competitive price are the reason for higher exports.



### International Market:

- Thailand's 5% broken rice was quoted at \$390-\$400 per tonne down from \$390-\$403 per tonne last week. The decrease in the price has attracted buyers from Middle East but the scarcity of ships at Thai ports remains a challenge. The export of rice during January to July this year was 2.59 million tonnes down by 22% from last year.
- Nepal has imported rice worth Rs 50.48 billion in the last fiscal year up by 51.4% than the previous year. The import expense on rice has increased by Rs 17 billion during the fiscal year 2020/21 and this amount to 3.3% of total expense on imports. Nepal imports rice mainly from India, China, Japan and Thailand.
- Bangladesh starts importing from India despite having 1.7 million tons of rice and wheat reserves. The Indian rice cost Tk 40-42 per kg compared to home grown rice of price Tk 50 per kg. The reduction of import duty from 62.5% to 25% has resulted in increased imports of rice. Last fiscal year Bangladesh has imported 0.78 million tons of rice while this fiscal year within 2 months the government has approved import of 1.2 million from private players.



- Cambodia earned \$685 million from rice export to international market in first eight months of the year as the volume of rice sold abroad doubled year to year. According to agriculture ministry 2.7 million tonnes of rice are shipped to international market. The rough grain made up of 57.39 % and 87.40 % of all rice exports in terms of value and volume.
- In Iraq traditional suppliers lost market share in 2020, India milled rice exports to Iraq increased by almost 40 percent. The Government of Iraq has traditionally been a major buyer for its Public Distribution System (PDS), buying mainly from approved origins including the United States. Non PDS, private-sector rice imports have been rising, and private-sector buyers have been attracted to India's competitive prices for basmati in 2020. Almost all India rice exports to Iraq are milled rice, with the majority being basmati rice.

Global trade of rice in 2021 is marginally higher m/m, at around 47m t (+3m y/y), on an upgrade for shipments to Asia, including to Bangladesh. Reflecting higher figures for carry-ins and production, the outlook for world supplies in 2021/22 is lifted slightly m/m, feeding through to a 1m t increase for inventories, to 172m (+1m y/y). Global trade in 2022 is little-changed m/m and unchanged y/y.

Against the backdrop of demand from buyers in Africa and Asia, global rice trade in 2021 is seen up by 7% y/y, to 47m t, with Indian exports rising sharply to a peak of 18.5m. Tied to bigger harvests in Asia's key producers, world output in 2021/22 is forecast to increase by 1% y/y, to a peak of 512m t, with consumption and stocks predicted to edge up. While trade in 2022 is likely to be little-changed y/y, the Council expects India's sales to contract as shipments by Thailand recover amid assumed ample and competitively priced supplies.
