

# Rice Weekly Research Report

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#### Outlook and Review:

- Paddy procurement in the ongoing kharif marketing season beginning October 2020, by FCI and state agencies has been 375.72 lakh tonnes of paddy till December 16 as against 310.71 lakh tonnes in the year-ago period, up 21%. Out of the total purchase of 375.72 lakh tonnes, Punjab has contributed 202.77 lakh tonnes, which is almost 54%.
- About 80,000 hectares out of the total 1,33,000 hectares of paddy crop in Nagapattinam district in Tamil
   Nadu are inundated. Though water is receding, crops in milky stage and panicle initiation stage are highly vulnerable to Grain Discoloration Disease which could affect yield by 10 to 30 percent.
- Govind Bhog rice prices in Bengal rose due to strong domestic and export demand, especially from Dubai and West Asia. The production of this fragrant rice is increasing gradually with the increasing returns. The farmers of Bengal had been increasing the production of Swarna rice, which is a common grade, until recently. Last year, the average market price of Govind Bhog paddy was Rs 3200 per quintal, which has increased by 10-15 per cent to Rs 3500 per quintal in the current year. The mill price of rice is running around Rs 6000 per quintal and the retail market price is around Rs 7500 per quintal.
- Prices of Vietnam's 5% broken rice rose to USD 500 per tonne, their highest since December 2011, from last week's USD 470-USD 490.A shortage of containers has made it difficult for traders to ship rice to their customers, For instance, freight rates for a 20-feet container to Africa has risen to USD 5,000 from USD 1,500 a couple of months ago. Vietnam is not likely to meet its target of exporting 6.5 million tonnes of rice this year. Government customs data showed exports in the January-November period slid 2.9% year-on-year to 5.7 million tonnes.
- Thailand's benchmark 5% broken rice prices rose to USD 500-USD 519 from USD 485-USD 516 last week
  due to concerns over supplies and logistics. As new rice supplies have not arrived yet, while existing
  supplies could not be shipped due to the shortage of shipping containers. Meanwhile, exports fell to 4.49
  million tonnes from January to October, down 31% from a year earlier, according to the Thai Rice
  Exporters Association.
- India's 5% broken parboiled variety extended gains to USD 380-USD 385 per tonne from USD 378-USD 383 last week on strong demand and as the rupee jumped to its highest level in nearly two-months.
   Traditional buyers of Thai rice are moving to India due to lower prices.
- Bangladesh issued a new tender to purchase 50,000 tonnes of rice closing on Dec. 28, while another tender for a similar volume is due to open on Dec. 22. Indian exporters have opportunity for Bangladesh tender due to competitive price.

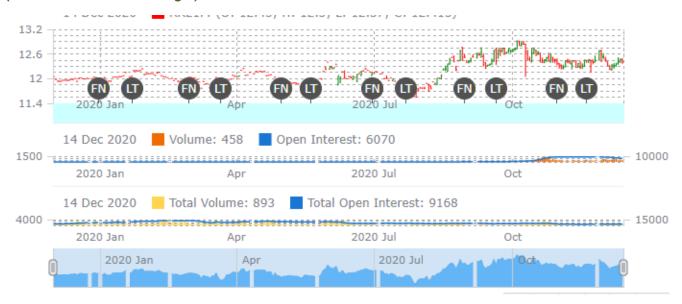
