



Rice Weekly Research Report

Outlook and Review:

- According to the latest Rice Kharif sowing data, sowing in India reached 114.82 lakh hectares on July 9, 2021, lower 8.93 percent from 126.08 lakh hectares the previous year at the same time. As of Jul 9, 2021, Telangana has a total area of 1.05 lakh hectares, lower from 1.39 lakh hectares the previous year at the same time. It is 0.34 lakh hectares in Rajasthan lower from 0.77 lakh hectares the previous year, and 0.66 lakh hectares in Gujarat up from 0.57 hectares the year before. Paddy sowing in Odisha has reduced by 33.82% from the previous year, reaching 5.83 lakh hectare down from 8.81 lakh hectare the previous year.
- Procurement of paddy in ongoing RMS 2021-22 is continuing smoothly in the procuring States of India at MSP, as was done in previous seasons, and till now (up-to 8.07.2021) a quantity of over 866.05 LMT of rice. About 127.72 lakh farmers have already been benefitted with MSP value of Rs.1, 52,620.82 crore.
- PMGKAY-4 has been approved by the Center. From July to November, this scheme will be in effect. This
 program will provide 5 kg of food grains (wheat/rice) per person per month. In PMGKAY-3, 79 lakh tonnes
 of food grains were allocated for May and June, with 76 lakh tonnes procured in various states so far. In
 May, 35 lakh tonnes of food grains were distributed, followed by 23 lakh tonnes in June. The Center
 allocated 204 lakh tonnes of food grains for the fourth scheme from July to November.
- Due to likely active monsoon trough at lower levels, fairly widespread to widespread rainfall with isolated heavy falls is very likely over plains of northwest India, central & east India and south Peninsula during 15th July to 21st July 2021.
- According to a USDA estimate, Vietnam will likely ship less rice in 2020-21. The USDA has reduced imports by 500,000 tonnes to 6.1 million tonnes. Due to better yields, Vietnam's milled rice production is expected to increase by 1.2 percent to 27.4 million tonnes in 2020-21. Yield increased to nearly 6 tonnes per hectare in 2020-21, up from 5.8 tonnes per hectare the previous year.
- The Centre has allocated approximately 78,000 tonnes of rice from FCI stocks to distilleries for ethanol production during the ethanol supply year (ESY) 2020-21 at a subsidised rate of Rs 20 per kg. By 2025, total ethanol production will be 740 million liters from grain and 760 million liters from sugar.
- Andhra Pradesh's Kharif crop sowing target has been set at 94.20 lakh acres, which is 4% more than last year's production area. The target area for paddy production has been set at 39.50 lakh acres, the same as last year.
- The government raised the minimum support price (MSP) of paddy marginally by Rs 72 per quintal to Rs 1,940 per quintal for the 2021-22 crop year.
- Basmati rice exports were 358,059.45 kgs in April 2021 lower from 421,139.86 kgs in Apr 2020. The Basmati rice export were 1,607,700.92 kgs in Jan- April 2021 lower from 2,033,180.87 kgs in last year during the corresponding period of time.
- Basmati rice exports were 4.6 million tonnes (mt) valued at \$4.01 (31,026 crore) billion in 2020-21, up from 4.45 mt valued at \$4.33 billion in the previous year (Rs 29,849 crore). The per unit value of Basmati exports fell by more than 10% to \$868 (Rs 63,400) per tonne last fiscal year (\$972 or Rs 71,000 in 2019-20).
- Export demand declined in April 2021 in Nepal, Burma, Vietnam, and other countries due to sever impact of Covid-19.
- Rice exports also decreased in this calendar year (Jan to April 2021). Demand may improve in the export market of Basmati rice.
- The Philippines' reduction in rice import duty may benefit Indian rice exports. The Philippines imports 2.5 million tonnes of rice per year, primarily from Vietnam and Thailand. Non-basmati rice exports from India may increase to the Philippines.

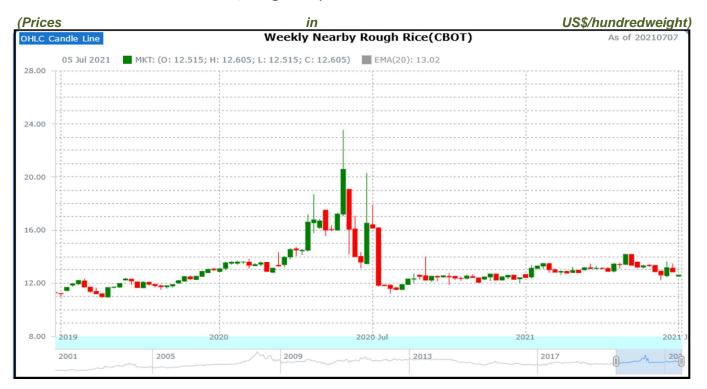

Due to bigger harvests in Asia, global rice production in 2021/22 is projected to rise by 1.59% to a fresh high. Consumption is also set to go up – partly due to the likely scaling-back of COVID-19-related support schemes in Asia – stocks could edge up y/y. Trade in 2022 (Jan/Dec) is anticipated to be little-changed y/y, as a potential reduction in shipments to South Asia is offset by bigger dispatches to Africa. India is set to remain by far the world's leading exporter.
