

Rice Weekly Research Report

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Outlook and Review:

- Paddy procurement has started in Telangana at 1033 paddy purchasing centers in the state at a brisk pace without any hitch.
- AP government has directed authorities to bring a strict policy for paddy procurement and ensure it through Rythu Bharosa Kendras (RBK). The official expects a yield of 87 lakh tonnes from 15.66 lakh hectares from which 50 lakh tonnes will be procured from 6884 RBKs.
- Paddy procurement center was inaugurated at Siddipet district of Telangana. A total of 396 procurement centers are established and 7.5 lakh tonnes of paddy is expected from 3.03 lakh acres cultivated in the district.
- The central government has introduced 'mixed indicator' test for determining the age of milled rice. The
 test will be used by FCI now in Punjab as they start receiving custom milled rice. The FCI has given Punjab
 the target of producing 40 lakh MT of fortified rice out of 113 lakh MT expected as CMR.
- Chhattisgarh government has decided to check the illegal entry of paddy in the state which is going to begin the procurement from December 1. The procurement will take place in 2,311 cooperative society centers across the state and 105 lakh tonnes of paddy is expected to be procured.
- India's rice export prices hit 4-month high last week due to limited supplies and a strong rupee. India's 5
 % broken parboiled rice variety was quoted at \$364 to \$369 per tonne highest since July 8 up from last
 week's \$363 to \$367 per tonne.
- In Karnataka, farmers are anxious about fall in the price of paddy with bumper yield expected in the state
 due to good rains. The farmers are demanding government to establish procurement centers announcing
 the support prices.
- After procuring over 80 percent of the expected paddy which includes non-basmati arrivals in Punjab's grain market this season, the government has decided to shut all the mandis/purchase centers by November 10 owing to lower arrivals seen in the mandi.
- As of 5th November, Rabi paddy sowing was done in 5.62 lakh hectares down by 2.8 lakh hectares from 8.42 lakh hectares the previous year.
- In Amritsar, paddy arrival has crossed 4.74 lakh MT up from 4.56 lakh MT last year. The crop arrivals are
 also higher than 2019-20. There is ambiguity in the arrivals as the area has not been increased while
 increase in the yield is yet to be confirmed. The other reason may be due to illegal selling of paddy from
 nearby state of UP.
- Rice imports from India through Benapole ports in Bangladesh were suspended on 31st October and will
 progress after further notice. Due to the situation, Importers were seen rushing to complete the imports
 of rice on 30th October. This has led to long waiting period for trucks to enter through Benapole port.

Procurement of paddy in ongoing KMS 2021-22 is going in India at MSP, as was done in previous seasons, and a quantity of over 8.53 LMT of rice was procured as of October 7th 2021. The procurement has started in Telangana and also in Chhattisgarh the procurement will start from December 1. In Punjab, around 80 percent of paddy has arrived in the mandis.

With increase in shipment to Asia, the forecast for world rice trade in 2021 is lifted to a new high of 48m t (+4m y/y). Reflecting an upgrade for India, the projection for global production in 2021/22 is raised by 1m t, to a peak of 513m (507m), with the net increase in supplies channeled to an increased figure for utilization, leaving carryovers steady m/m, at 182m (+3m). Trade in 2022 is predicted to be little-changed y/y, at close to a new peak.

With increase in freight costs and logistics difficulties in some exporters, world rice import demand in 2020/21 is forecast to expand to a record of 48m t (+4m y/y) on firmer demand from buyers in Africa and Asia. Tied to acreage gains and improved yields, 2021/22 production is predicted at a new peak, including a sizeable main crop in India. While population growth will boost consumption, inventories are seen rising to a high of 182m t (+3m), with major exporters' reserves at a record of 50m. Trade in 2022 is seen remaining high, mostly on African demand.
