

Rice Weekly Research Report

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Outlook and Review:

- Non-basmati rice exporters is aiming to ship 16 million tonnes this fiscal year despite challenges on the
 price and freight front. This is expected to be 15-23 percent higher compared to previous year's 13 million
 tonnes. In the first half of the current fiscal year, non-basmati rice exports registered a 60 percent volume
 growth at 8.19 million tonne compared to 5.11 million tonnes the previous year.
- Telangana government is facing jute gunny bag shortage to pack their paddy. The state currently have only
 12 crores of jute bags left against required 25 crore jute bags. Every year the required bags jute bags
 remains 20 crores but this time it has rose to 25 crores. There is paucity in the availability as there is
 complete dependency on West Bengal and Andhra Pradesh.
- India's 5% broken parboiled rice variety was quoted at \$354-\$360 per tonne this week, their lowest since mid-August which is down from \$359-\$364 last week. Buyers are postponing purchases since prices are falling and is expected to fall further.
- FCI said a target of 23.60 lakh MT of fortified rice to be procured from Andhra Pradesh. Of this Andhra Pradesh civil supplies would procure 9.02 lakh tonnes of fortified rice and remaining by FCI. As on 18th November, Rabi paddy was sown in around 6.33 lakh hectares down by 0.74 lakh hectares from 7.07 lakh hectares last year.
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- FCI has procured 56.46 lakh metric tonnes of rice from Andhra Pradesh till October 2021 against 55.36 lakh tonnes last year. Also, 0.13 lakh tonnes of rice would be more procured in the remainder of the year.
- Iran imported a total of 665,000 tonnes of rice during the current Iranian's first eight months (March 21-November 21) showing a rise of 24 percent compared to similar period last year.
- Farmers in UP were unsatisfied with the current paddy procurement. As the procurement started from
 October 1st, only 4.98 lakh tonnes of paddy has been procured till now against n announced target of 70
 lakh metric tonnes and instead of announced 4,000 procurement centers, only 1712 were running.
- Vietnam's 5% broken rice edged down to \$425-\$430 per tonne from \$430-\$435 per tonne last week. The prices fell following fall in the prices of other exporting countries like India and Pakistan. But lower domestic supplies would prevent further fall in the prices as next harvest is expected only after February or March.
- Thailand's 5% broken rice prices rose to \$385-\$395 per tonne from \$377-\$383 per tonne last week due to strengthening of baht against US dollars and increase in the demand after the prices fell to level last seen in Oct 2017. Rice sale fell due to high logistic costs.
- As per reports, Brazilian rice export should reach 1.2 million tonnes based on overseas sales between January and October which totalles at 958,000 tonnes. In the same period of 2020, around 1.68 million tonnes of rice was exported.

Procurement of paddy in ongoing KMS 2021-22 is going in India at MSP, as was done in previous seasons, and a quantity of over 228.86 LMT of rice was procured as of November 11th 2021. The procurement has started in Southern states and also in Chhattisgarh the procurement will start from December 1. In Punjab, the procurement operations are almost finished.

The Council's forecast for global rice trade in 2021 is fractionally higher m/m, at 48.3m t (44.0m), on stronger than anticipated demand from buyers in Asia. While 2021/22 world production is projected little-changed m/m, at a peak of 513m t (\pm 1% y/y), end-season stocks are lifted from before, to 184m (\pm 3m y/y), on an upward revision for India. The outlook for global import demand in 2022 is maintained and would be steady y/y.

Stronger demand from importers in Asia and Africa is seen pushing up world rice trade to a peak of 48.3m t (44.0m) in 2021. Linked to another record outturn in India, global production in 2021/22 is forecast at a fresh high, while inventories are seen expanding on accumulation in the major exporters. Despite a likely contraction in feed uptake in China, consumption is predicted at a record on continued population growth. Trade is projected little-changed y/y in 2022 as a potential reduction in deliveries to Asia is countered by firmer demand in Africa.
