

RED CHILLI

Fundamentals:

Today's Update:

- Continued steady sentiment was witnessed in Red Chilli spot market on Friday.
- Buyers reported inactive as Red Chilli prices trading at all-time high also export demand reported lower current year. Financial crisis in major exporting countries also added the sentiments.
- As per Govt. data, in August 2022, 26,795 MT exports were reported down by 24.43% from the previous July month. Overall exports from January 2022 to August 2022 is reported at 265,907 MT which is down by 27.78% from the same period last year as a result of lower availability of premium quality, Sri Lanka economic crisis, lockdown in China during early months of the current year. From January 2021 to August 2021 total exports were 368,213 MT.
- Currently heavy rainfall reported in Chilli growing states like Andhra Pradesh, Telangana and Karnataka is also a major concern for standing crops. Continuous rainfall may affect the standing crops as plants are in the growth stage.

Previous Update:

- As per Andhra Pradesh agricultural department, as on 28th September 2022 Red Chilli sowing activity completed around 172,775 hectares as compared to last year same period 138,357 hectares, up by 24.88%. In AP, Chilli crops are at transplantation to vegetative stage.
- As per AgriWatch revised estimates, Red Chilli all India sowing area for 2022 is estimated at 9.21 lakh hectares as compared to last year 9.03 lakh hectares, up by 2.03%.
- Due to good rainfall and higher prices compared to last year farmers are showing more interest for Red Chilli crop and some new areas also come up current year in Andhra Pradesh. Earlier farmers had sowed very less areas due to fear of virus infection (last year mostly crop damaged) but now standing crop quality looks healthy so they are interested in sowing in the rest of the areas also. So, Red Chilli sowing area is likely to increase considerably under prevailing weather conditions and farmers' interest.
- As per AgriWatch sources, mites have been seen in some parts of Karnataka key growing regions as crops are in flowering stage right now. However, farmers are hoping that this situation may recover soon as it is a curable pests.
- As per AgriWatch estimates, Red Chilli all India production for 2022 marketing year is estimated at 14.07 lakh MT, revised after rainfall in Karnataka and virus affected in AP and Telangana, earlier it was estimated 15.93 lakh MT. Last year's production was 13.84 lakh MT.

TURMERIC

Fundamentals:

Today's Update:

- Continued steady sentiment was witnessed in Turmeric spot market on Friday.
- AgriWatch expects stockists to be active at lower prices on expectations of further increase in prices.
- Farmers and stockists has started to release their stocks in the fear of further decline in prices.

Previous Update:

- As per Andhra Pradesh agricultural department, as on 28th September 2022 Turmeric sowing activity completed around 16,639 hectares as compared to last year same period 17,569 hectares, marginally down by 5.29% till date.
- As per AgriWatch revised estimates, Turmeric all India sowing area for 2022 is estimated at 1.70 lakh hectares as compared to last year 1.66 lakh hectares, up by 2.44%.
- As per AgriWatch revised estimates, current year Turmeric sowing area likely to go up in Maharashtra key growing regions and as of now standing crops are reported in good condition.
- As per AgriWatch intention, current year Turmeric sowing area may go down in AP and Telangana as other competitive crops like Cotton and Maize prices are comparatively higher and both crops are short duration crops.
- AgriWatch estimates, Turmeric (Dry) all India production for 2022 is revised lower at 4.67 lakh MT compared to last year's 4.89 lakh MT. Crop damage reports due to excessive rainfall during October and November in AP and Telangana remain the key reason for revising production downwards.

BLACK PEPPER

Fundamentals:

Today's Update:

- Steady to weak sentiment was witnessed in Black pepper spot market on Friday.
- Vietnam Pepper price as on last trade in the domestic market is also maintaining stable compared to previous day. Currently, the domestic pepper market is kept at 61,500 - 64,500 VND/kg. Specifically, the price of pepper in Dak Lak and Dak Nong today was purchased at 63,000 VND/kg. In Gia Lai continues to be purchased at 61,500 VND/kg. In Dong Nai remained stable, trading at 63,000 VND/kg; In Ba Ria - Vung Tau was flat, staying at 64,500 VND/kg, the highest pepper purchase level in the country; and Binh Phuoc pepper price traded at 64,000 VND/kg, reported steady.

Previous Update:

- Vietnam exported 160,891 tons in the past 8 months, but over the same period Vietnam's exports have dropped sharply by 18.6%. Similarly, the pepper exports of Brazil and Indonesia also decreased by 7.4% and 12.5%, respectively.
- In August, the top importers of Brazilian pepper include Vietnam (1,482 tons), Egypt (826 tons), the United Arab Emirates (754 tons) and India (513 tons). By the end of August, Vietnam had imported a record 10,732 tons of pepper from Brazil increasing 2.2 times in volume over the same period.
- Currently, Brazil is entering the pepper harvest, output is expected to increase by 10% compared to 2021 to 98,000 tons in 2022. Indian pepper production is expected to increase slightly. However, Vietnam's pepper production is expected to decrease due to unfavorable weather factors, while it is expected to be stable in other pepper producing countries.
- India imported around 7,866.68 MT garbled black pepper from January 2022 to July 2022 highest from Brazil- 3,894 MT followed by Vietnam- 2,347.60 MT.
- However, it is up by 10.63% from the same period last year. During the last year from January 21 to July 21, total imports were 7110.97 MT, highest from Vietnam- 3,038 MT followed by Brazil- 2,816.78 MT.
- India imported around 236.80 MT ungarbled black pepper, down by 80.97% from the same period last year, at 1,244.19 MT.
- As per current situations, AgriWatch expected India's pepper productions for 2021-22 likely to go down by 8 to 10% compared to last year. Last year (2020-21) India's Pepper production was 62,000 MT.

- AgriWatch expects demand likely to be good in the spot market and buyers will be active in coming months as ending stocks for 2022-23 Marketing Year reported lower by 50.79%.

Previous Update

- Current year Jeera sowing is likely to start from October last week or November first week in Gujarat growing regions. Due to moisture conditions as a result of higher rainfall sowing may delayed by 10 to 15 days current year.
- As per the AgriWatch production estimate, Jeera production for 2022-23 (Marketing Year) is estimated at 316,281 MT (around 58 lakh bags each of 55 kg) compared to last year's 391,801 MT (71 lakh bags).

Previous Update:

- New Small Cardamom supply continuing to the Kochi spot market. Buyers are reported active for new crop supply.
- As per initial report AgriWatch estimates India's production for the marketing year 2022-23 is expected to be around 30,000 metric tonne (MT). Last year it was 27,000 MT. Favorable weather condition in Kerala growing regions is the main reason for higher production expectations.
- AgriWatch expect, Cardamom planters and stockists may hold their stocks in coming months if prices go down from current levels.

CORIANDER SEED

Fundamentals:

Today's Update:

- By and large steady sentiment was witnessed in Coriander spot market on Friday.
- Coriander growing regions in Rajasthan, Madhya Pradesh and Gujarat sowing activity likely to get delayed by 10 to 15 days and may start from end of October or first week of November due to higher moisture condition.
- AgriWatch expects Coriander sowing area may increase current year as prices are trading at an all-time high position. Area may shift from other competitive crops like Mustard and Garlic in Rajasthan and Gujarat.

Previous Update:

- Imports from other producing countries like Bulgaria, Turkey and Russia likely keep the adequate supply in India due to which prices may cap at higher levels.
- As per the AgriWatch second advance production estimate, Coriander production for 2022-23 (Marketing Year) is estimated at 310,371 MT (around 77.6 lakh bags, 1 bag = 40 kg) compared to last year's 342,435 MT (85 lakh bags).
