

Sugar & Gur Domestic & International Fundamentals

Recent updates.

- Most of the Sugar wholesale market prices were witnessed **steady to firm** on Saturday.
- Prices of both the varieties of sugar **weakened at the Dhampur wholesale market** here today due to reduced demand from stockists and bulk consumers amid ample stock positions.

Monsoon Update:

- The India Met Department (IMD) has indicated that the monsoon is bracing for another revival phase from the South Peninsula and Central India, **from July 6 and 8, respectively.**
- This will come about with the likely formation of a cyclonic circulation over the **North-West Bay of Bengal and adjoining Bengal coast around Friday (July 6).** The US Climate Prediction Centre hinted that the 'buzz' due to the churn off the Andhra Pradesh-Odisha coast would continue to hold until July 19.

Previous updates.

- With the minimum selling prices (MSP) of sugar in the domestic market set at Rs 29/kg, mills had to bear **losses of Rs 1-2/kg when they exported.** Now, with domestic prices rising to **Rs 32/kg, the losses on exports** have increased to Rs 4-5/kg.
- The European Commission has cut its forecast for sugar production in the bloc in 2018/19 to **20.1 mln tonnes** from a previous projection of **20.4 mln**, according to its quarterly short-term agricultural outlook report.
- The directorate of sugar under the food ministry has allocated total **sales quota of 11.60 lakh tonnes** to mills in Uttar Pradesh for June and July, while Maharashtra **has got 15.77 lakh tonnes** for these two months, leaving the mills in the largest producer befuddled.
- Brazil exported **only 1.946 million tonnes of sugar**, raw value, in June 2018, **down from 2.120 mln a month earlier and** significantly below 3.128 mln in the same month last year, Trade Ministry data showed.
- In the current season 2017-18, the **total production of molasses stood at over 5.32 million tonnes (MT).** However, only 2.97 MT of the stock was lifted, leaving unsold stock of almost 2.55 MT with mills (total stock includes the opening stock from the previous sugar season).
- The UP Sugar Cane Authority has written to the central government to increase the quota of sugar that mills can sell to **10 lakh tonnes per month** in view of the pending dues of farmers accounting Rs 12000 crores. As per quota fixed by the central government, mills in the state can sell sugar worth **Rs 1,650 crore every month**, thereby making it all more difficult for them to clear dues.
- The total sugarcane sown area as on 29th June 2018, as per reports received from States, stands at **50.01 lakh hectares** as compared to **49.48 lakh hectares** at this time last year.
- The government is considering a proposal to raise the fair and remunerative price (FRP) of cane to **Rs 275 per quintal for the marketing year** starting October, against Rs255 this year.
- After 2.1 million tonnes for June, the government on 29th June allowed mills to sell **1.6 million tonnes** of sugar in July against traders' expectations of over 2 million tonnes, which is equivalent to the monthly average release of nearly 2.13 million tonnes.

- The current month quota is insufficient to meet consumers' demand despite being lean season, with lack of festivals and wedding or any other such occasions in this month. **The release quantity is 23 per cent lower than the average monthly consumption of 2.13 million tonnes,**
