Sugar & Gur Domestic & International Fundamentals

Recent updates.

- The prices of M-30 and and S-30 grades of sugar have witnessed steady to weak across the country on Friday. Sellers notable offload there stock at higher prices.
- Raw sugar futures in New York fell to a 2-1/2-month low on Thursday, pressured by speculative selling early in the session amid concerns about abundant supplies.
- Mexican sugar production in the last week of the season was 2,510 tonnes (up from 2,273 a year ago), which brought final output to 6,009,220 tonnes, which was 52,049 tonnes more than a year ago.
- Ukraine exported 67,600 tonnes of sugar in June 2018, up from 54,000 in May and compared with just 6,355 tonnes in the same month last year, data from the National Association of Sugar Producers (Ukrtsukor) show.

Monsoon Update:

The nationwide rainfall deficit in the season stands at 9%, with the monsoon 16% below normal in the first 10 days of July. UP and Gujarat received just about half the normal rainfall so far, while deficits have opened up in east and northeast India. The south and many parts of central India though have been receiving bountiful rains.

Previous updates.

- A ministerial panel today mooted GST reduction on ethanol from 18 per cent to 12 per cent but did not favour imposing cess on sugar as arrears to cane farmers are already declining. The Group of Ministers, headed by Assam Finance Minister Himanta Biswa Sarma, will also wait for Attorney General's opinion before taking a view on whether cess can be levied at all under the current Goods and Services Tax (GST) regime, according to officials.
- Total ethanol production in Brazil reached 11.06 billion liters, up 44.99% from a year before, with 3.288 billion liters of anhydrous ethanol (+2.06%) and 7.773 billion liters of hydrous ethanol (+76.36%). Meanwhile, sugar production fell 12.10%, totaling 9.747 million tons.
- The government plans to recommend an 8 per cent increase in the fair and remunerative price (FRP) of sugarcane over the previous year, which the industry fears will make their operations unviable. If FRP is raised to Rs 275/quintal for the 2018-19 season beginning October, mills may find it difficult to pay farmers their dues. Official sources said the Prime Minister's Office (PMO) has asked the Food and Consumer Affairs ministry to examine the minimum selling price (MSP) of sugar currently fixed at Rs 29/kg. The industry wants the price to be Rs 33/kg for south and west India and Rs 35/kg in North India.
- The FRP set by the Centre is the minimum price that sugarcane farmers are legally guaranteed. The hike would impact farmers in Andhra Pradesh, Karnataka, Maharashtra, Tamil Nadu, Madhya Pradesh and Gujarat who are paid by mills at FRP rate. In other key growing states of Uttar Pradesh, Punjab, Haryana, Tamil Nadu and Uttarakhand, farmers get the State Advised Price (SAP) fixed by state governments which is usually higher than FRP..
- The total sugarcane sown area as on 06th July 2018, as per reports received from States, stands at 50.44 lakh hectares as compared to 49.64 lakh hectares at this time last year.
- Sugar prices have firmed up about 10% over last week after the central government kept the quantity of sweetener sugar mills can sell in open market in July lower than normal monthly limits and industry expectations



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The European Commission has cut its forecast for sugar production in the bloc in 2018/19 to 20.1 mln tonnes from a previous projection of 20.4 mln, according to its quarterly short-term agricultural outlook report.
