

#### Sugar & Gur Domestic & International Fundamentals

#### **Recent Update:**

**Steady tone was witnessed in Sugar physical markets today in India.** Sugar prices were lower in Delhi and Khatauli at Rs. 3170/q and Rs. 3190/q. Prices were steady in Kolhapur at Rs. 3100/q.

**Farmers to launch agitation in lucknow.** Sugarcane farmers in Uttar Pradesh will launch an agitation in Lucknow if the government fails to declare the price value of sugarcane. Farmers are continuously demanding the government to declare the sugarcane purchase price but still the prices are not announced. Even today, Rs. 4,000 crore are in arrears of sugarcane farmers.

#### Weather Forecast:

Heavy rain/snow very likely at isolated places over Jammu & Kashmir, Ladakh, Gilgit-Balistan, Muzzaffarabad, Uttrakhand and Himachal Pradesh. Thunderstorm and lightening, hail at isolated places very likely over Jammu divison, Himachal Pradesh, Uttrakhand, Punjab, Haryana, Chandigarh and Delhi and North West Uttar Pradesh; with lightening at isolated places over Rajasthan, West Madhya Pradesh, south Coastal Andhra Pradesh, Rayalaseema, South interior Karnataka, Tamilnadu, Puducherry, karikal, Kerala & Mahe and Lakshadweep.

#### Previous Updates:

**Government releases harvesting cost to cane farmers.** Goa government has released harvesting cost of sugarcane after 9 months at the end of the crushing season (2019-20). Earlier, the government had paid Rs 65 lakh out of pending Rs 1.6 crore. The sugar factory's cane rate last year was around Rs 1200 per tonne. The state government has also paid a support price of Rs. 1800 which totaled the amount to Rs 3,000 per tonne for the cane supplied by the farmers to the mill. But the payment of harvesting cost Rs 600 per tonne was pending which has been cleared now.

**Mohiuddinpur sugar mill clears pending cane dues.** All the five sugar mills from the district have cleared the pending cane dues for the season 2019-20, worth Rs 199.92 crore has been cleared and only Kinauni sugar mill is yet to clear the pending cane dues to the farmers.

**Government fixes 20 LMT Monthly sugar quota for January 2021.** The food ministry has allocated 20 LMT monthly sugar quota for January 2021 which is 2 LMT lower than that of January 2020 which stood at 22 LMT. In the previous month the government allocated 21.5 LMT monthly sugar quota for December 2020 to 548 mills in India.

**Sugar mills in Kolhapur produced around 100 lakh quintals of sugar.** Around 37 sugar mills have started cane crushing operation in Kolhapur and have produced around 100.48 lakh quintals sugar by crushing 91.53 lakh tonnes of sugarcane. Kolhapur division has recorded sugar recovery of 11 percent.

**Food ministry notifies scheme for sugar millers for exports in sugar season 2020-21.** The Central government and food ministry has notified scheme for providing assistance to sugar mills for expenses on marketing costs including handling, upgrading and other processing costs and cost of international and internal transport and freight charges on export of sugar for the sugar season 2020-21.

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**Uttar Pradesh government will soon announce the State advised price for sugarcane.** The government assured farmers that they will soon announce the SAP of sugarcane. About 92 percent of the last season's payment has been made in the state. The government has paid Rs. 1.12 lakh crore to cane growers in the past three and a half years.

**117 sugar mills are engaged in crushing operations in Maharashtra.** Majority of sugar mills in Maharashtra have started cane crushing operations, till 24<sup>th</sup> December 2020 about 177 mills are engaged in crushing operations and have produced around 343.86 lakh quintal of sugar by crushing 367.9 lakh tonne sugarcane. The state has recorded average sugar recovery percentage of about 9.35 percent. Solapur is leading in the state with 38 sugar mills in operation.

**Uttar Pradesh Farmers urged the government to declare State Advised Price for sugarcane.** More than two months have passed since the starting of new crushing season, but the government has yet not announced the SAP for sugarcane. The Centre has already announced the Fair and Remunerative Price (FRP) for sugarcane for 2020-21 season with a hike of Rs 10 to Rs 285 per quintal for a basic recovery of 10 percent. The farmers are also expecting a hike in SAP as it has not been increased from three seasons.

**ISMA has requested to extend the duration for sales quota for December 2020.** ISMA has requested Department of Food & Public Distribution to extend the duration for sale of allocated sugar quota for December 2020. ISMA has also requested to reduce the allocation of sugar quota for January 2021. Mills have already been constrained to sell their sugar stocks below Minimum support price (MSP) and U.P state sugar prices are also on the verge of breaching MSP. If the situation keeps moving in the same direction then it would be extremely tough for sugar millers to survive in the ongoing crushing season.
