Sugar & Gur Domestic & International Fundamentals

Recent Update:

Steady tone was witnessed in Sugar physical markets today in India. Sugar prices were lower in Delhi and Mumbai by 10-30 at Rs. 3120/q and Rs. 3332/q. Prices were lower in Kolhapur at Rs. 3100/q.

Sugarcane farmers are demanding hike in minimum support price to Rs. 450 per quintal. The sugarcane farmers have urged the government to increase the State Advisory Price of sugarcane to Rs. 450 per quintal and have also asked the government to ensure that the sugar mills will clear the cane dues to the farmers within 14 days of crushing their cane.

Weather Forecast:

Previous Updates:

Antyodaya card holders will receive sugar for 3 months. The administration has decided to distribute sugar at a rate of Rs 18 per kg to the antyodaya card holders for three months, every family holding the antyodaya card will get one kg of sugar for three months. The distribution of sugar at ration shops will start from March.

Sugar mills in Maharashtra have cleared 82 per cent of the FRP dues. Sugar mills have paid farmers FRP Rs 11,630.25 crore which is around 82.09% of the total dues till 15th February'21. The millers had cleared FRP dues worth Rs 6,780.59 crore amounting to 88.82% during the same period last season. During last season, around 140 sugar mills participated in the cane crushing season and crushed 332 lakh tonne of sugarcane.

Sugarcane farmers from Kendrapara are switching to other crops. The sugarcane cultivators from Kendrapara district are switching from sugarcane cultivation as the sugar mills in the district have been closed. This has led to a decline in cultivation area in the region. The area under cane cultivation has been also been reduced to 5000 hectares. Marsaghai, Pattamundai, Rajkanika, Mahakalapada, Garadapur, Aul and Derabishi are the blocks where cash crop was grown in the region.

Sugarcane SAP remains unchanged in Uttar Pradesh. State Advisory Price for sugarcane has remained the same in Uttar Pradesh again. The farmers were expecting a hike this year in sugarcane prices but the government has made no such changes. The rates of three different varieties of sugarcane have remained unchanged at Rs 315 per quintal for common variety, Rs 325 for early variety and Rs 310 for rejected varieties.

Sugar Production has decreased in Uttar Pradesh this year. Sugar mills in Uttar Pradesh have produced 63 lakh tonnes of sugar after crushing 611 lakh tonnes of sugarcane till 15th February '21. The mills during the same period last year had produced 64 lakh tonnes of sugar by crushing 584 lakh tonnes of sugarcane. The sugarcane recovery reported this season is 10.29 % as against 10.96% last season.

Kolhapur region has recorded 12 percent sugar recovery rate. About 37 sugar mills are operating in the Kolhapur division in the current crushing season. Around 183 sugar mills have participated in the cane crushing operation in Maharashtra and have produced 724 lakh quintal of sugar by crushing 717 lakh tonne



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sugarcane. Although, Solapur division is leading in the state with a maximum of 41 sugar mills operating in the current season.

India's sugar exports are likely to decrease more than 24 percent in the current season till September 2020-21 due to the logistical constraints such as shortage of containers and congestion at the country's ports. Also, Brazil is likely to export 4.3 million tonnes during 2020-21 season against 5.7 million tonnes shipped in previous year.

Sugarcane farmer's demands hike in sugar prices. Sugarcane farmers from Bijnor are demanding increase in sugarcane prices to Rs. 450 per quintal. Government had not increased the prices till date and farmers are continuously demanding the price hike in sugarcane. Government should consider the farmer's demand keeping in view the increase in the input cost for sugarcane cultivation and hike the cane purchase price.

Around 31 mills in Uttar Pradesh are yet to clear the cane dues. The sugarcane crushing season is half-way down but still around 31 sugar mills in Uttar Pradesh have failed to clear the sugarcane dues. Total 120 sugar mills have been participated in the cane crushing activity for this season, till 2nd February the pending arrears are around Rs. 7,979. The cane dues during the same period last season were around Rs 5,948 crore.

Brahmavar sugar factory has started producing organic jaggery. The factory has prepared jaggery without using chemicals and has also received good response from the consumers; the jaggery is directly sold to the consumers without any intermediary. The factory with the capacity to grinding 15 tonnes of sugarcane per day has produced around 450 kg of jaggery.
