

## Sugar &Gur Domestic & International Fundamentals

### Recent Update:

**Steady tone was witnessed in Sugar physical markets today in India.** Sugar prices were lower in Delhi and Khatuli by 10-30 at Rs. 3120/q each. Prices were lower in Kolhapur at Rs. 3100/q.

**Sugar Production in Maharashtra is estimated at 102 lakh tonnes.** Sugar production in Maharashtra is estimated at 102 lakh tonnes for the crushing season as against estimate of 95 lakh tonnes. The mills in Solapur have closed operations and more mills will follow soon. The mills in Ahmednagar and Marathwada will end operations in March. Mills in Sangli, Satara, Pune and Kolhapur will end their season by end of April.

### Weather Forecast:

Thunderstorm with lightening & hail very likely accompanied with lightening & hail very likely in isolated places over Jammu & Kashmir, Ladakh, Gilgit & Muzaffarabad, Himachal Pradesh and Uttarakhand and with lightening Arunachal Pradesh.

### Previous Updates:

**Sugar Production is likely to fall in Uttar Pradesh by 20 percent.** Uttar Pradesh is likely to witness 20 per cent lower sugar production for the on-going cane crushing season compared with the previous season. Uttar Pradesh is likely to produce 100 lakh tonne sugar as against 126 lakh tonne in the last season. The lower sugar production is attributed to the diversion of cane for ethanol production and damage of crops due to pest infection following the rainwater stagnation in sugarcane fields in central and eastern parts of the state.

**India's annual export to china increases in 2020.** India's annual export to china has crossed the 20-billion mark for the first time in 2020 with shipments rising 16.15 percent to \$20.87 billion. Although, imports from china during the last calendar year shrunk 10.87 percent to \$66.78 billion resulting in narrowing of trade deficit by 19.39 percent to \$45.91 billion. India china bilateral trade during the year has also declined 5.64 percent to \$ 87.65 billion.

**Sugarcane farmers are demanding hike in minimum support price to Rs. 450 per quintal.** The sugarcane farmers have urged the government to increase the State Advisory Price of sugarcane to Rs. 450 per quintal and have also asked the government to ensure that the sugar mills will clear the cane dues to the farmers within 14 days of crushing their cane.

**Antyodaya card holders will receive sugar for 3 months.** The administration has decided to distribute sugar at a rate of Rs 18 per kg to the antyodaya card holders for three months, every family holding the antyodaya card will get one kg of sugar for three months. The distribution of sugar at ration shops will start from March.

**Sugar mills in Maharashtra have cleared 82 per cent of the FRP dues.** Sugar mills have paid farmers FRP Rs 11,630.25 crore which is around 82.09% of the total dues till 15<sup>th</sup> February'21. The millers had cleared FRP dues worth Rs 6,780.59 crore amounting to 88.82% during the same period last season. During last season, around 140 sugar mills participated in the cane crushing season and crushed 332 lakh tonne of sugarcane.

**Sugarcane farmers from Kendrapara are switching to other crops.** The sugarcane cultivators from Kendrapara district are switching from sugarcane cultivation as the sugar mills in the district have been

closed. This has led to a decline in cultivation area in the region. The area under cane cultivation has been also been reduced to 5000 hectares. Marsaghai, Pattamundai, Rajkanika, Mahakalapada, Garadapur, Aul and Derabishi are the blocks where cash crop was grown in the region.

**Sugarcane SAP remains unchanged in Uttar Pradesh.** State Advisory Price for sugarcane has remained the same in Uttar Pradesh again. The farmers were expecting a hike this year in sugarcane prices but the government has made no such changes. The rates of three different varieties of sugarcane have remained unchanged at Rs 315 per quintal for common variety, Rs 325 for early variety and Rs 310 for rejected varieties.

**Sugar Production has decreased in Uttar Pradesh this year.** Sugar mills in Uttar Pradesh have produced 63 lakh tonnes of sugar after crushing 611 lakh tonnes of sugarcane till 15<sup>th</sup> February '21. The mills during the same period last year had produced 64 lakh tonnes of sugar by crushing 584 lakh tonnes of sugarcane. The sugarcane recovery reported this season is 10.29 % as against 10.96% last season.

**Kolhapur region has recorded 12 percent sugar recovery rate.** About 37 sugar mills are operating in the Kolhapur division in the current crushing season. Around 183 sugar mills have participated in the cane crushing operation in Maharashtra and have produced 724 lakh quintal of sugar by crushing 717 lakh tonne sugarcane. Although, Solapur division is leading in the state with a maximum of 41 sugar mills operating in the current season.
