

Sugar &Gur Domestic & International Fundamentals

Recent Update:

Steady tone was witnessed in Sugar physical markets today in India. Sugar prices were lower in Delhi by 50-70 at Rs. 3130/q. Prices were lower in Kolhapur at Rs. 3100/q.

41 Sugar mills in Maharashtra are likely to end their cane crushing operation. The sugarcane crushing season is at the final phase in Maharashtra and till March 11, 41 sugar mills have ended cane crushing operations. Around 187 sugar mills had participated in the on-going cane crushing season and they have produced 918.55 lakh quintal sugars by crushing 886.52 lakh tonne sugarcane with a recovery of 10.36%. Till date, 29 sugar mills from Solapur have closed their operations followed by 7 mills from the Kolhapur division and from Pune, Aurangabad and Nanded division each sugar mill has stopped operations and two mills from the Amravati division have closed the cane crushing operations.

Weather Forecast:

Thunderstorm with lightening very likely in isolated places over Jammu & Kashmir, Ladakh, Gilgit-Balistan & Muzaffarabad, Assam & Meghalaya and Arunachal Pradesh.

Previous Updates:

According to Indian Sugar Mills Association, India's sugar production is expected to be around 30.2 million tonnes in the ongoing 2020-21 marketing year, about 800,000 tonne lower than the initial estimate, because of damage caused by unseasonal rains in some parts of Uttar Pradesh. However, the sugar production is estimated to be higher than 27.4 million tonne achieved during the 2019-20 marketing year (October-September). Mills have manufactured about 23.4 million tonnes of sugar. Also, crushing operation is expected to get over in Maharashtra and Karnataka this month and in Uttar Pradesh by May. The sugar production would be slightly lower than the initial estimate in both Uttar Pradesh and Maharashtra. Production in Uttar Pradesh is expected to be 10.2 million tonnes in the current 2020-21 year, lower than 12.6 million tonnes last year. Similarly, the output in Maharashtra is expected to be 10.2 million tonnes this year compared with 6.1 million tonnes last year. The initial sugar production estimate for each of these two states was 10.5 million tonne for the current year, Where else production in Karnataka, is expected to increase to 4.7 million tonne in the 2020-21 marketing year from 3.45 million tonne last year, and is likely to be more than the annual requirement of 26 million tonne. Besides sugar, mills are manufacturing ethanol used for blending with petrol. Mills are also undertaking export of sugar under a quota fixed by the government.

Sugar mills produce 222 lakh MT of sugar till February'21. Sugar output in India has estimated to be around 310 lakh Metric Tonnes for 2020-21 season and domestic consumption is around 260 lakh Metric Tonnes. Sugar mills in India have produced 222 lakh Metric Tonnes of Sugar till last month. The government has allocated a mill-wise export quota of 60 Lakh Metric Tonnes for exporting the sugar in the current season to reduce the surplus stock of sugar. The government is also encouraging sugar mills to produce ethanol from sugarcane juice, sugar, B-Heavy molasses and sugar syrup to divert excess sugar.

Sugar mills from Uttar Pradesh earns from ethanol production. Sugar mills from Uttar Pradesh are getting benefitted by increasing ethanol production in their respective plants. Sugar mill Sathiaon has earned Rs 3 crore through ethanol by distributing it to oil companies, Although, the Sugar mill Sathiaon is yet to achieve

its set target of crushing 45.5 lakh quintal sugarcane and has till now crushed 24 lakh quintal sugarcane with a recovery rate of 8.67 per cent.

Karnataka farmers demand higher FRP for sugarcane. Sugarcane farmers from the Mysuru region are demanding the hike in fair and remunerative price for sugarcane considering the input cost of cultivation. The cost of sugarcane cultivation has been increased but the FRP fixed by the government has remained the same and farmers are unable to recover the money they have spent for cultivation of the sugarcane crop. As a result the farmers are requesting the government to increase the FRP.

Maharashtra sugar mills produces 839.81 lakh quintals of sugar till 27th February'21. Sugar mills in Maharashtra have produced 839.81 lakh quintals of sugar by crushing 818.48 lakh tonne sugarcane with 10.26 per cent recovery till 27th February 2021. As many as 187 sugar mills took part in cane crushing operations in the current season. In the Kolhapur division total 37 sugar mills took part in cane crushing operations and out of these one has ended the season. Maximum sugar mills were operating from the Solapur division and eight out of 41 mills from the division have stopped operations.

Daurala sugar mill has cleared cane dues of Rs. 25.79 crore. The mill has cleared cane dues of the farmers that have sent their cane to the mill between January 21st to 27th. The mill has till date crushed 138.31 lakh quintals of sugarcane which is higher than the cane crushed during the last crushing season 131.25 lakh quintals.
