

Sugar & Gur Domestic & International Fundamentals

Recent Update:

Steady tone was witnessed in Sugar physical markets today in India. Sugar prices were lower in Delhi by 10-20 at Rs. 3230/q. Prices were lower in Kolhapur at Rs. 3000/q.

Sugar production has fallen from previous season in Uttar Pradesh. According to the Indian Sugar Mills Association, In U.P., 120 sugar mills which were in operation have produced 93.71 lakh tonnes of sugar till 31st March 2021. Out of 120 sugar mills, 39 sugar mills have stopped crushing operations, where else 113 mills were in operation last year and the sugar production was 97.20 lakh tonnes, upto 31st March 2020. The lower sugar production is attributed to the diversion of cane for ethanol production and damage of crops due to pest infection following the rainwater stagnation in sugarcane fields in central and eastern parts of the state.

Weather Forecast:

Thunderstorm with lightening & gusty winds very likely at isolated places over Himachal Pradesh and with lightening & gusty winds at isolated pockets very likely Jammu & Kashmir, Ladakh, Gilgit-Baltistan & Muzzafrabad, Uttrakhand and Kerala and with lightening at isolated pockets over Andaman & Nicobar Islands, Andhra Pradesh, Coastal Andhra Pradesh & Yanam and Telangana. Heat Wave Conditions very likely in isolated pockets over southwest and northeast Rajasthan and east Vidarbha.

Previous Updates:

Sugarcane arrears have risen in the current season as compared to previous season. About Rs. 22,900 Crore of pending cane dues are in the current season. It is higher as compared to arrears one year back when it was around Rs. 19,200 Crore. The prevailing low ex- mill sugar prices for last several months, has adversely affected the liquidity of mills and their ability to pay the FRP to cane farmers. The mills are expecting that the government would increase the minimum selling price (MSP) to help mills increase revenue and clear the cane dues to the farmers. The current sugar prices are around Rs. 3100/q.

Government has fixed 22 LMT Monthly Sugar Quota for sale in April 2021. The Food ministry has allocated 22 LMT monthly sugar quota for April 2021 which is 4 LMT higher than the quota released in April 2020. In the previous month (March) government has released 21 LMT of monthly sugar sales quota to 552 mills in the country.

Sugar mills in Mahrashtra had produced around 997.12 lakh quintals of sugar till 28th March'21. About 187 sugar mills have participated in the crushing season and have crushed around 954.91 lakh tonnes sugarcane with a recovery rate of 10.44 percent.

Sugar mills clears cane dues of worth Rs 1.98 crore. Uttar Pradesh sugar mill has cleared cane dues worth Rs 1.98 crore of the 680 sugarcane farmers associated with the mill. However, the sugar mill is yet to clear arrears worth Rs 31.95 crore to the cane farmers.

Sugarcane crushing season is likely to end in March'21. Sugarcane crushing operations in Thailand are likely to end by March-end with the country expecting to complete crushing of around 66.5 million MT of sugarcane. The mills in the country had crushed 66.48 million MT sugarcane till March 22 this year which

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was down by 13% from the same period during the last year. Usually the cane crushing activities continues till April-May but due to the shortage of cane, the crushing is expected to end by March 31.

Bilai sugar mill has recorded the highest recovery rate of more than 13 percent. Bilai suagr mills from Madhya Pradesh have recorded the highest recovery rate of 13.25. In the current season, the sugar mills in the district have started cane crushing operations on time and that has helped in increasing the sugar recovery in the district.

Sugar mills from Maharashtra have cleared 87 percent of the Fair and Remunerative price (FRP) to the cane farmers. Sugar mills have cleared Rs. 15,836 crore which is around 86.91 percent of the total FRP for this season, the mills are expected to clear the remaining Rs. 2,385 crore dues in the coming weeks. Around 187 sugar mills have participated in the crushing operations this season and out of that 86 mills have cleared 100 percent of the FRP while 65 cleared 60-69 percent of FRP. Sugar mills in India have signed contracts to export 43 lakh tonnes of sugar which include contract of 20 lakh tonne from Maharashtra sugar mills.

Mahrashtra Sugar mills produces around 957.57 lakh quintals of sugar. Sugar mills in Maharashtra have produced 957.57 lakh quintal sugars after crushing 920.23 lakh tonne sugarcane with a sugar recovery rate of 10.41 percent. The sugarcane crushing season is in the final phase and about 52 sugar mills have closed their crushing operations. 28 sugar mills are operating in Kolhapur division and 9 have stopped operations, where else in Solapur division out of 41 sugar mills, 31 mills have closed operations and 10 are operating. In Pune and Ahmednagar division, 3 each sugar mills have ended the operations whereas 2 each sugar mills in Aurangabad, Nanded, and Amravati division have shut their operations.

About 76 percent of the sugarcane has been harvested till 19th March 21. About 48.51 lakh hectares was the estimated total coverage under sugarcane in the rabi season of 2020-21 and around 76 percent harvesting has been done till 19th March'21. In some parts of the country, the sugar mills have closed their crushing operations while some are at their final phase of crushing.
