

Sugar & Gur Domestic & International Fundamentals

Recent Update:

A firm tone was witnessed in Sugar physical markets today in India. Sugar prices were lower in Delhi by Rs.10-50 at Rs. 3200/q. Prices were firm in Kolhapur at Rs. 3075/q.

Bijnor sugar mill will focus on ethanol production. Around five sugar mills in the district have accelerated ethanol production. The mills have produced around 9,60,40,000 litres of ethanol, out of which 8,86,94000 litres of ethanol have been sold, mills have paid 55 per cent of the money earned by selling ethanol to sugarcane farmers. The mills from the district have sold ethanol worth Rs 504.72 crore. Currently, for the coming season 2021-22 ethanol output is likely to increase as the government has emphasized its production.

Weather Forecast:

Thunderstorm accompanied with lightening very likely at isolated places over Uttarakhand, Uttar Pradesh, West Rajasthan, and Telangana. Heavy to very heavy rainfall at isolated places over West Madhya Pradesh, Gujarat region, Konkan & Goa and Heavy rainfalls at isolated places over West Uttar Pradesh, East Rajasthan, East Madhya Pradesh, Odisha, Saurashtra & Kutch, Ghat areas of Madhya Mahrashtra, Telangana, Coastal & South Interior Karantaka, and Kerala & Mahe.

Previous Updates:

India's production is forecasted to reach 35.6 million tonnes by 2030. According to FAO Agricultural Outlook Report, World Sugarcane production is projected to grow by 1 percent per annum and reach 1,960 million tonnes by 2030 with Brazil and India anticipated to contribute 65 percent of the change in global output. Brazil Sugar production is projected to increase to 41.0 ml t, production in India is forecasted to reach 35.6 ml to y 2030.

Sugarcane dues reaches above Rs. 21,000 crore. Sugarcane arrears till May 2021 have reached Rs. 21,321 crore, highest in Uttar Pradesh. The total cane dues of Rs. 18,820 crore is from the current cane crushing season and Rs. 2,501 crore from previous season. For the 2020-21 seasons, around 63 percent of the cane dues are from Uttar Pradesh and rest are from Maharashtra, Karnataka and other states. As per the market the sugar mills said, that the low sugar sales have affected their business and therefore they failed to accumulate the capital and hence affecting the cane dues settlement.

Sugar Industry waits for hike in Minimum Selling Price of Sugar. Domestic sugar prices have been depressed in the wake of surplus sugar production for sugar season 2019-20 and 2020-21. Millers have been liquid-strapped given the depressed ex-mill prices along with harming the capability of paying cane dues in the given time. As per the latest reports, the cane dues for the ongoing season 2020-21 are around ₹18820 crores. The sugar industry has been seeking a hike in the MSP of sugar that would help in covering the cost of production, including interest and maintenance costs. The sugar prices have not been increased from last 2 seasons.

Philippines sugar production reached at 2.13 million metric tonnes. According to the Sugar Regulatory Administration (SRA), Sugar output in Phillippines has reached 2.137 million metric tonnes in the first week of July which is slightly lower around 2.14 million MT during the same period last year. However, despite the

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decline, the sugar output in the country has already exceeded its set target. According to the SRA, the sugar production for the current season has surpassed the government's full-year target. The sugar crop year starts in September and ends in August.

Thailand sugar millers predicts sugar production around 6.6 million tonnes in 2020-21 season. According to the Thai Sugar Millers Corporation, the domestic sugar production for the 2020-21 is around 6.6 million tonnes, which is lowest in the decade. Thailand had received less rainfall this year during the rainy season and also drought in the previous year which has impacted the sugar production. Many farmers are shifting to cassava which is drought resistant.

ISMA has estimated Sugar Production for 2020-21 seasons at 309 lakh tonnes. According to ISMA, opening balance is estimated at 107 lakh tonnes, whereas sugar production for the current sugar season 2020-21 is estimated around 309 lakh tonnes, expected domestic sales of around 260 lakh tonnes and exports are estimated at around 70 lakh tonnes. The opening balance of about 87 lakh tons on 1st Oct. 2021, will be about 20 lakh tonnes less than the opening stock as on 1st Oct 2020.

According to ISMA, sugar mills have produced 307 lakh tonnes of sugar till 14th July 2021: Around 502 sugar mills were operating in the current season as compared to 457 sugar mills in the previous season. Sugar mills have produced around 307 lakh tonnes of sugar till 14th July '2021. Another around 2 lakh tonnes is expected to be produced in the special season till September 2021 in Tamil Nadu and Karnataka, taking the total sugar production in 2020-21 sugar seasons to 309 lakh tonnes.

The Indian government on 14th July 2021 has permitted exports of specified quantities of sugar and other commodities to the Maldives for the financial year 2021-24 under a bilateral trade agreement. The directorate general of foreign trade (DGFT) has issued a notification stating that the exports will be exempted from any existing or future restrictions. Sugar quantity allowed to export for the financial year 2021-22 is 61,423.17 MT, 2022-23 is 61,423.17 MT, and 2023-24 is 61,423.17 MT.

Brazil has witnessed higher sugar output in second half of June month, in the Center-South region. According to data released by trade association UNICA Sugar production in the center-south region of Brazil has recovered from the poor performance in the first half of June 2021 with production around 2.19 million tonnes to 2.89 million tonnes production in second half of June'2021. UNICA stated that the Brazil's CS sugar output late in June was also 5.6 percent better than in the same period last year. The sugar mills in the region have crushed 45 million tonnes of cane which is 4.4 percent more than the last year.
